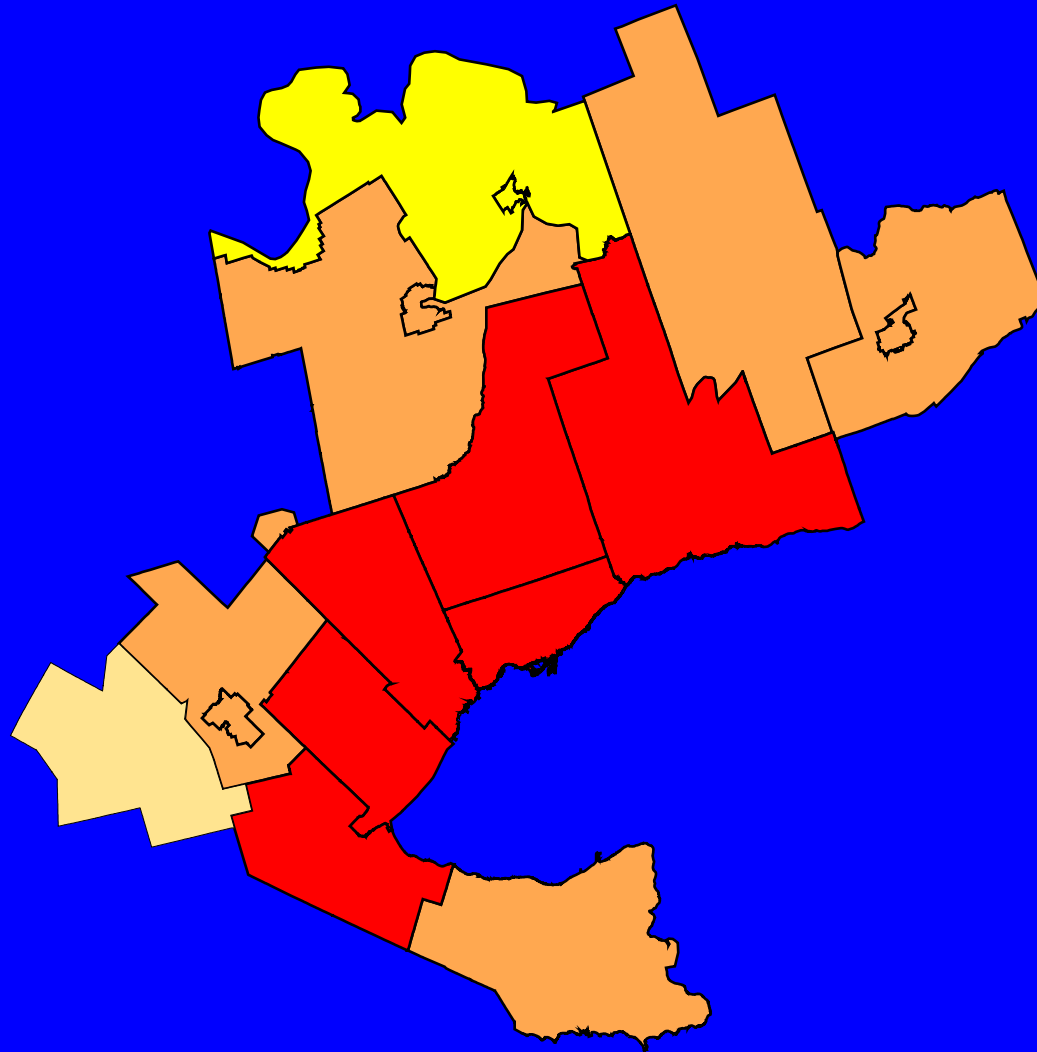

- Call Back if Necessary

Telephone Listings from Cornerstone List Managers

- August - Preliminary List of Survey Area
- October - Complete Listing to Cover 5% Sample
- Supplementary Lists as Necessary

Uniform 5% Sample Across Survey Area Controlled by Canada Post's Forward Sortation Areas

Preliminary Data expanded to 2001 Census Dwelling Units by Forward Sortation Area (where possible)

Final Data Base to be expanded to 2001 Census Occupied Dwelling Units by Forward Sortation Area

Interview Process in 2001

Equipment

- 120 interview stations, 8 monitoring stations, 12 coding stations on a local area network

Four Interview Teams in the Evening (5:30 - 9:30 p.m.)

Daytime Interview Team

- scheduled call-backs
- respondent call-ins
- visual editing of completed interviews

Geocoding Process in 2001

All Location Data

- home address
- usual place of work and school
- location of every trip origin and trip destination

Quality Control

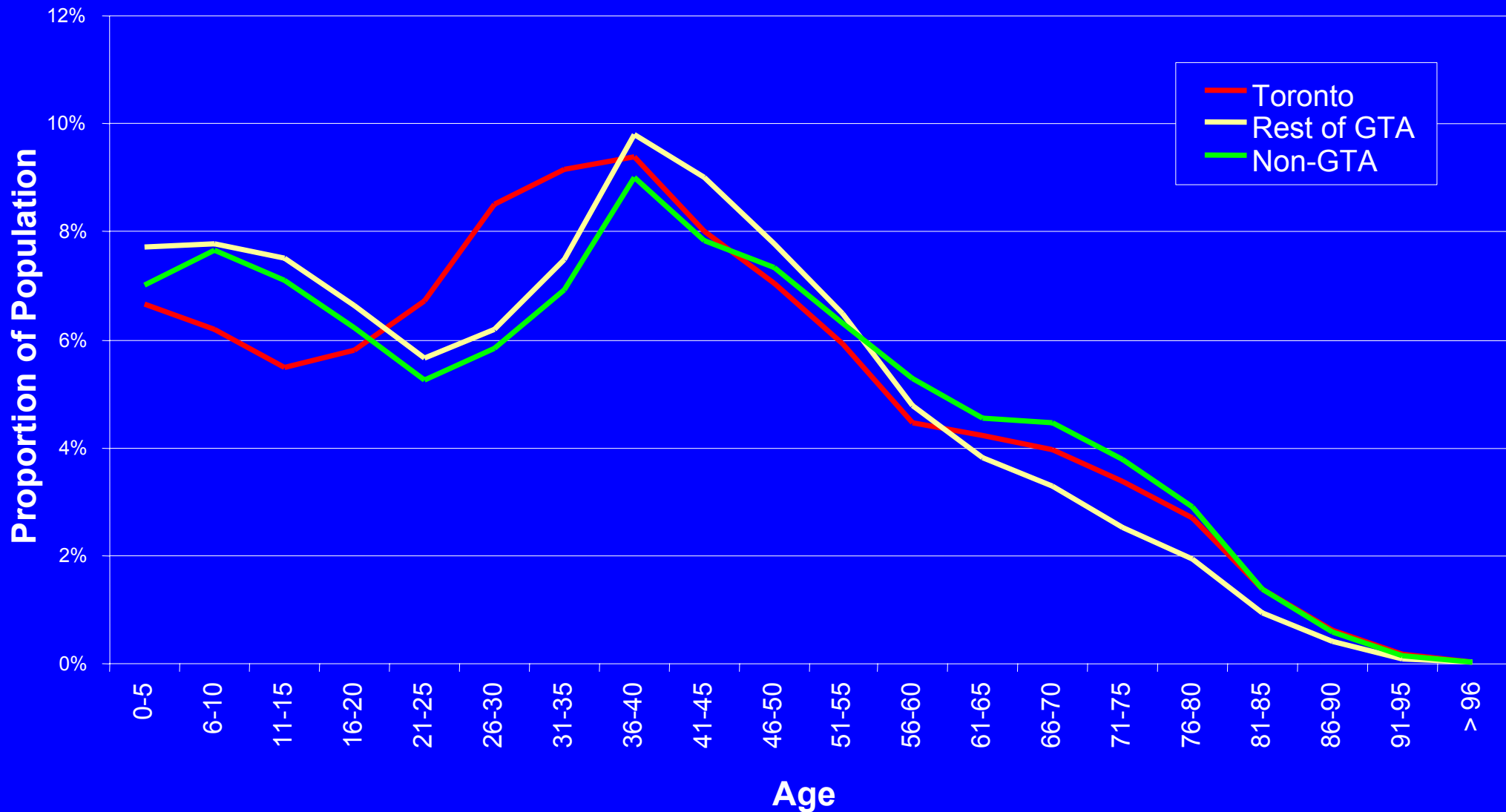
- Logic Checks in Direct Data Entry Software

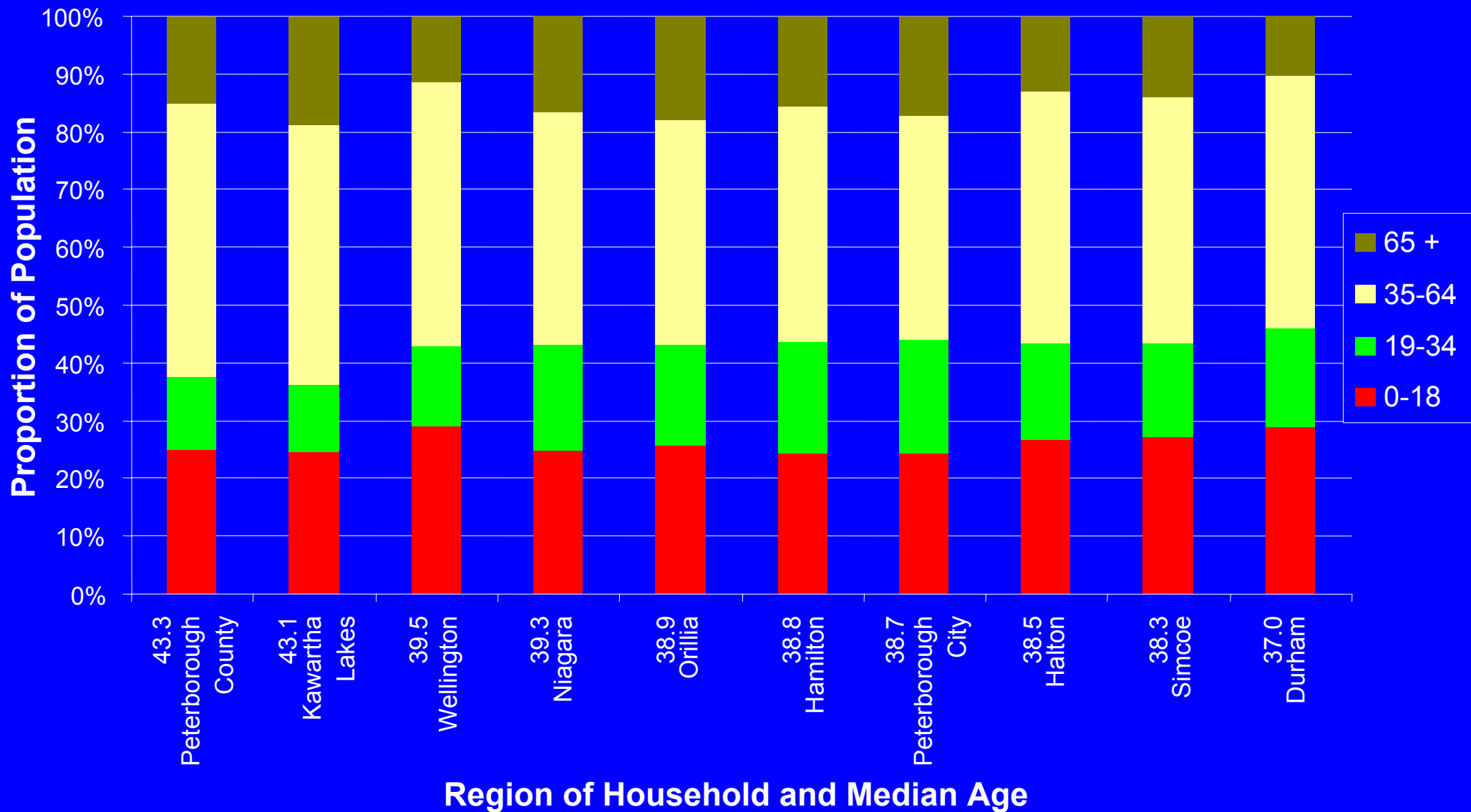

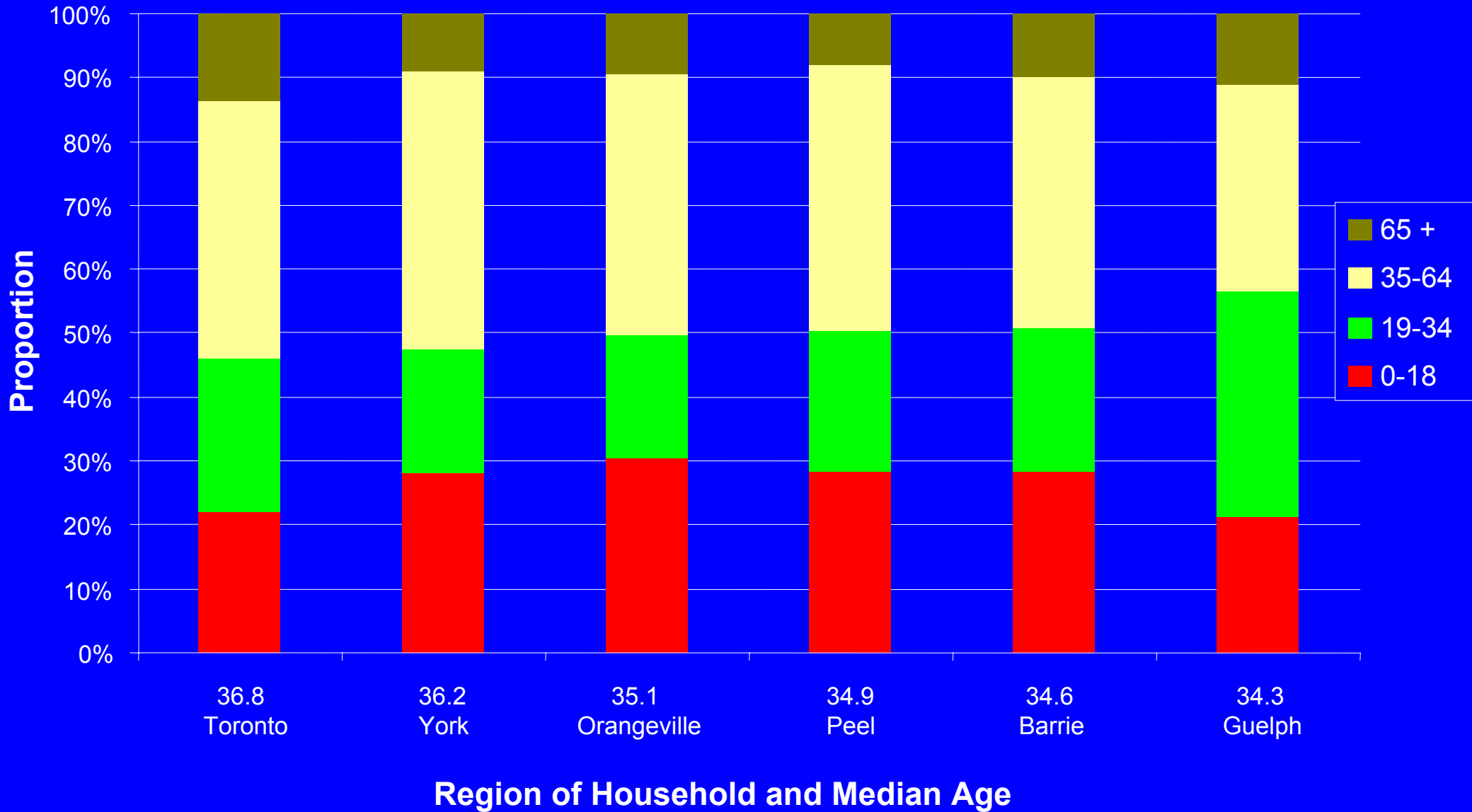
Population Distribution by Age Group



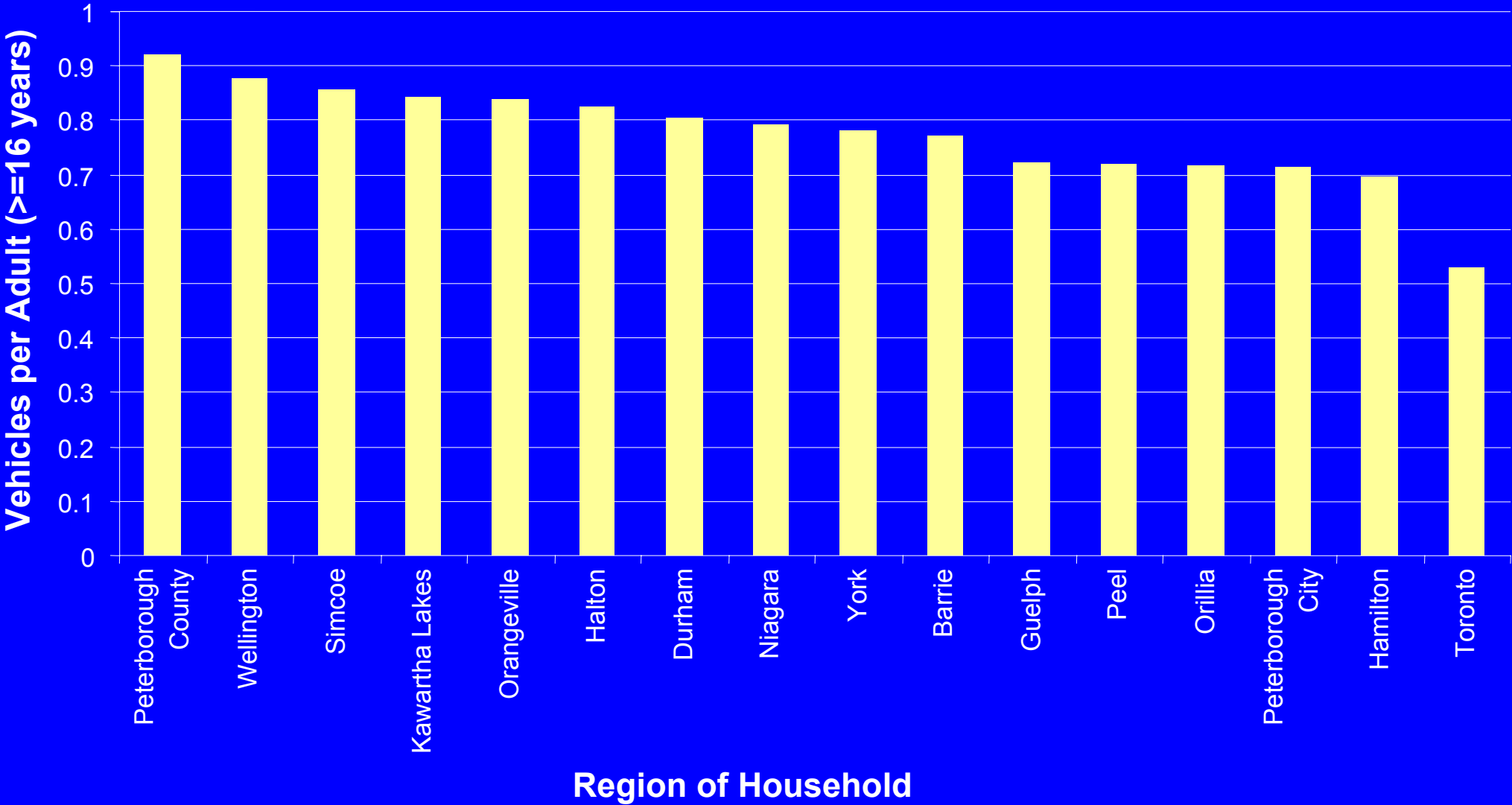
Areas With Median Age > 36.9 Years



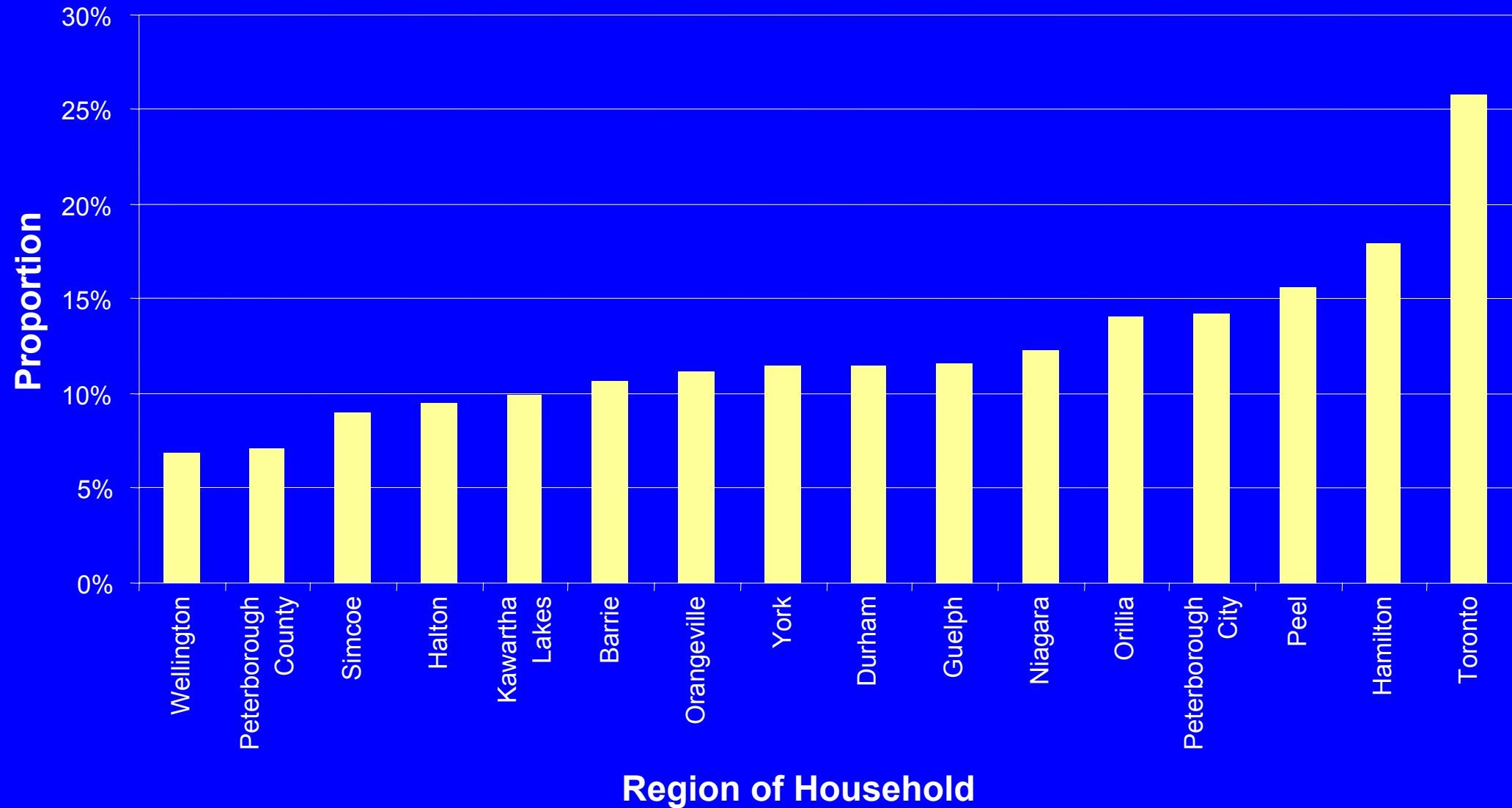

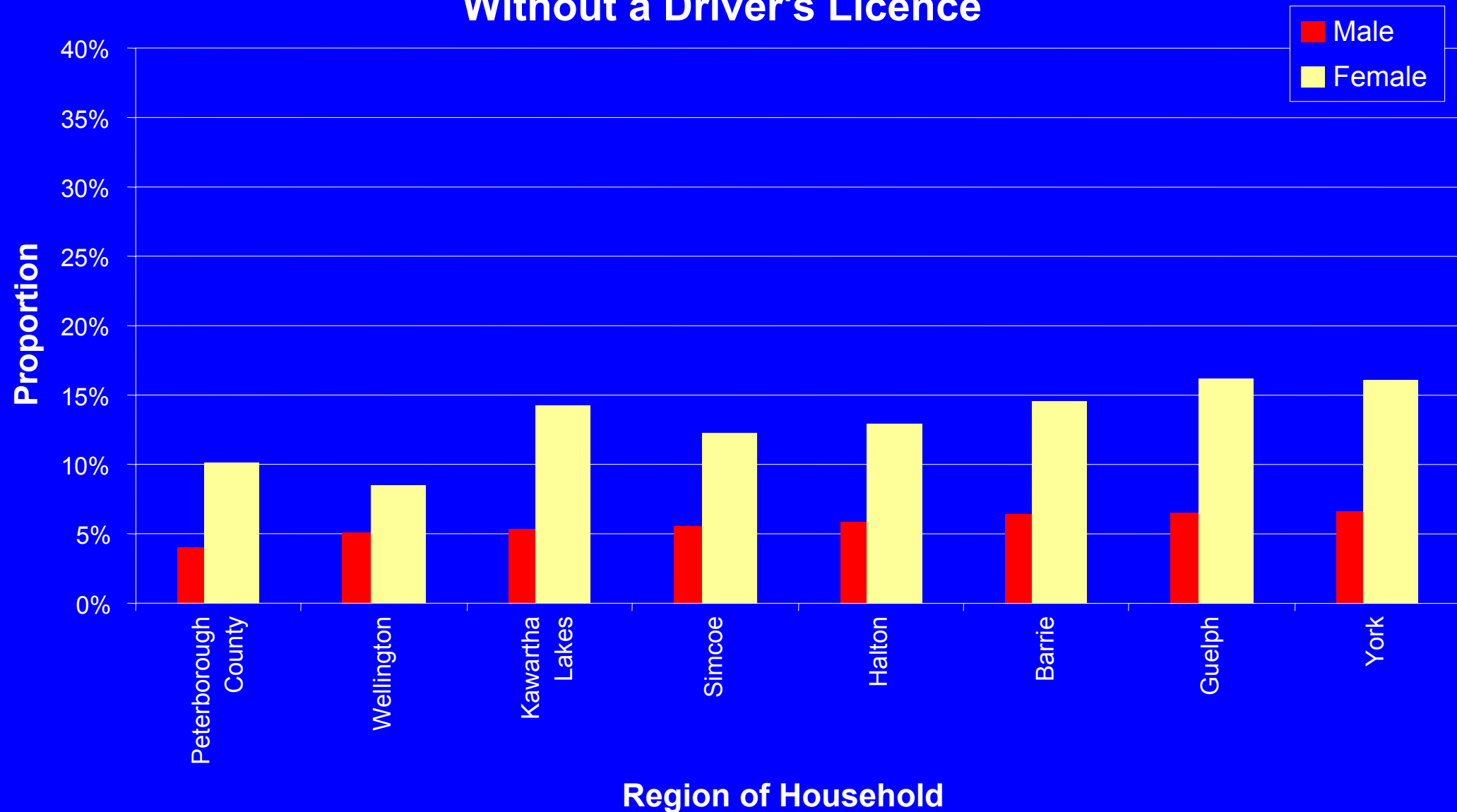

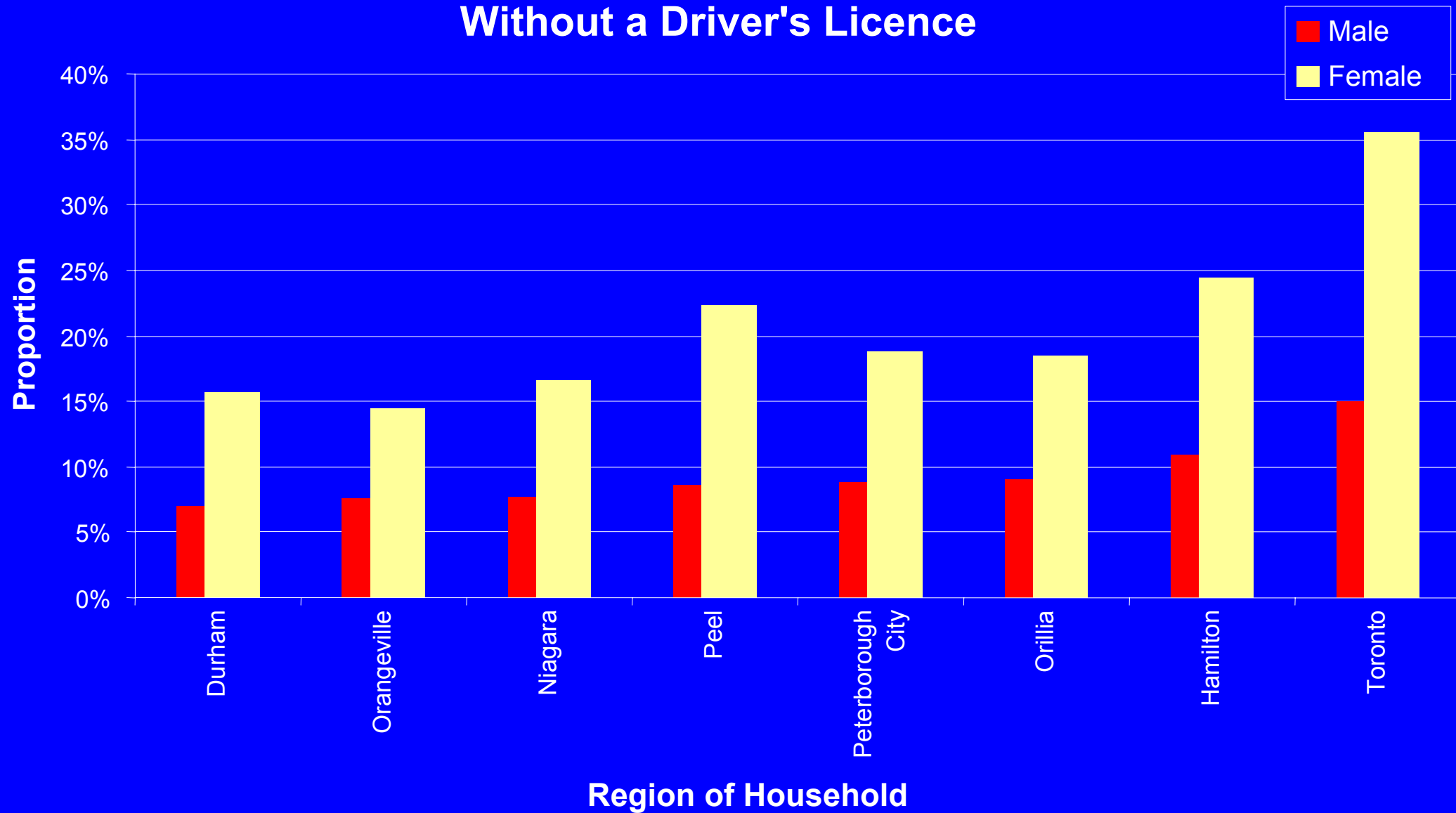
Proportion of Adults (≥ 16 yrs) Without a Driver's Licence



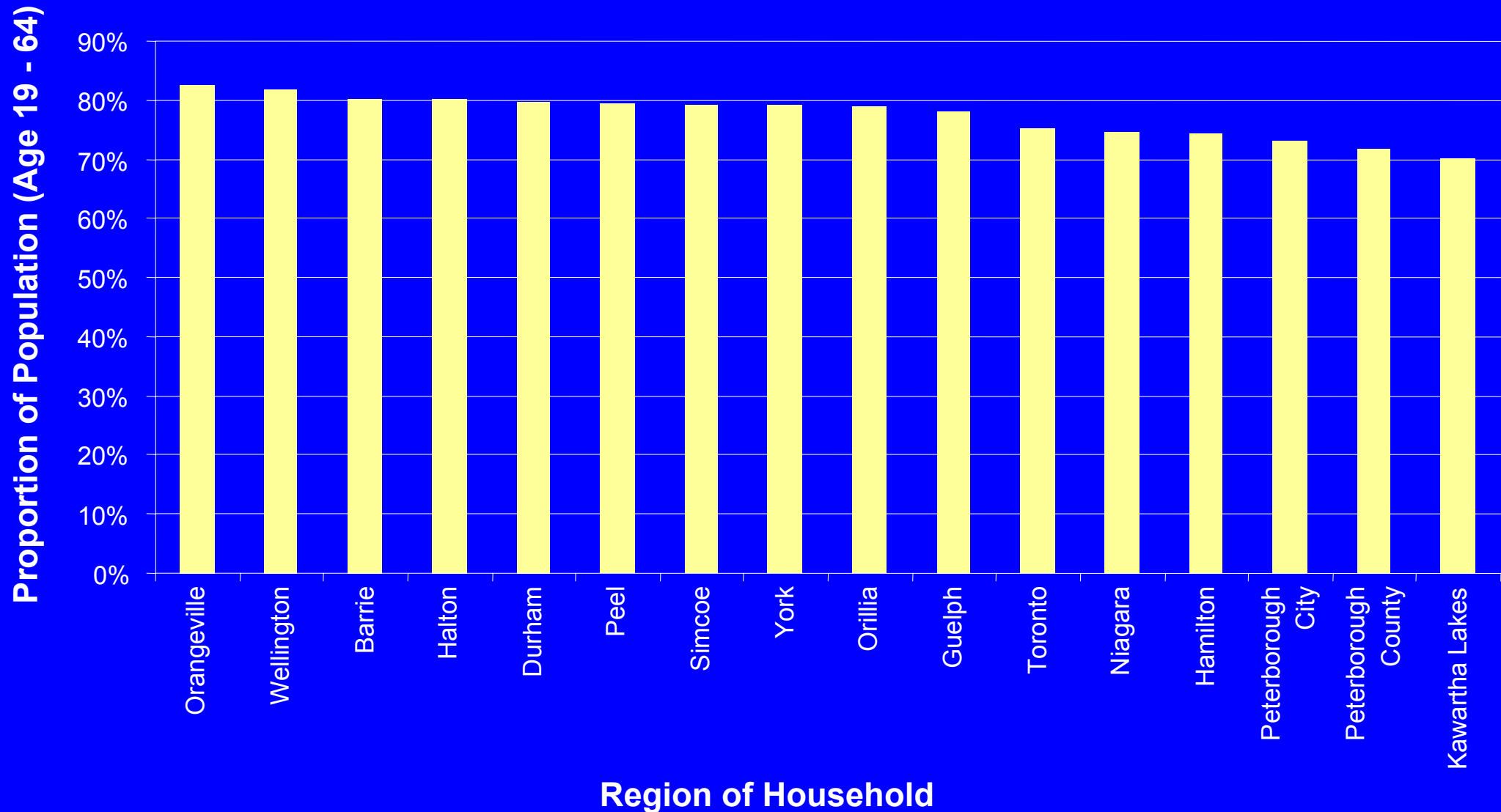

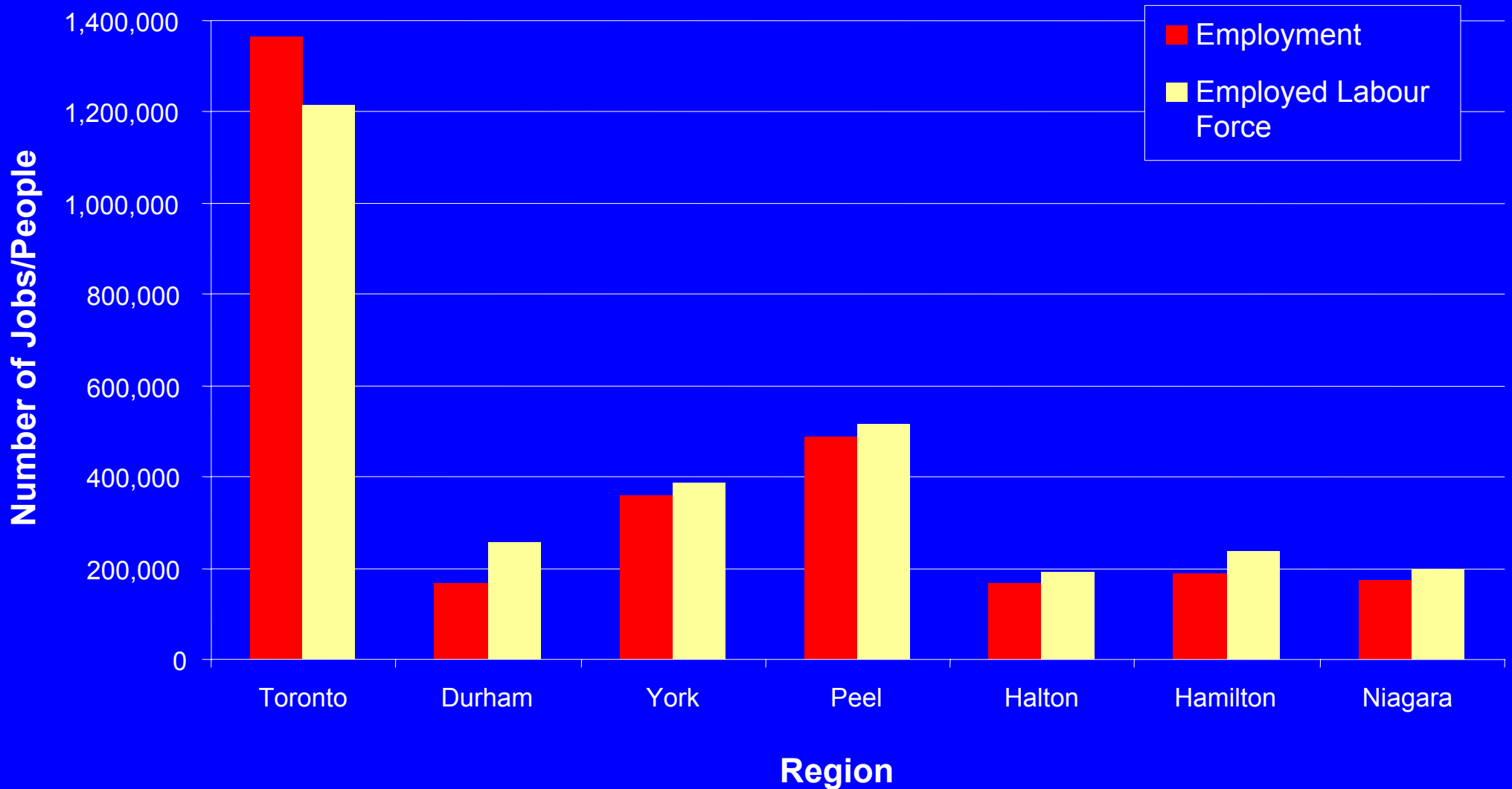

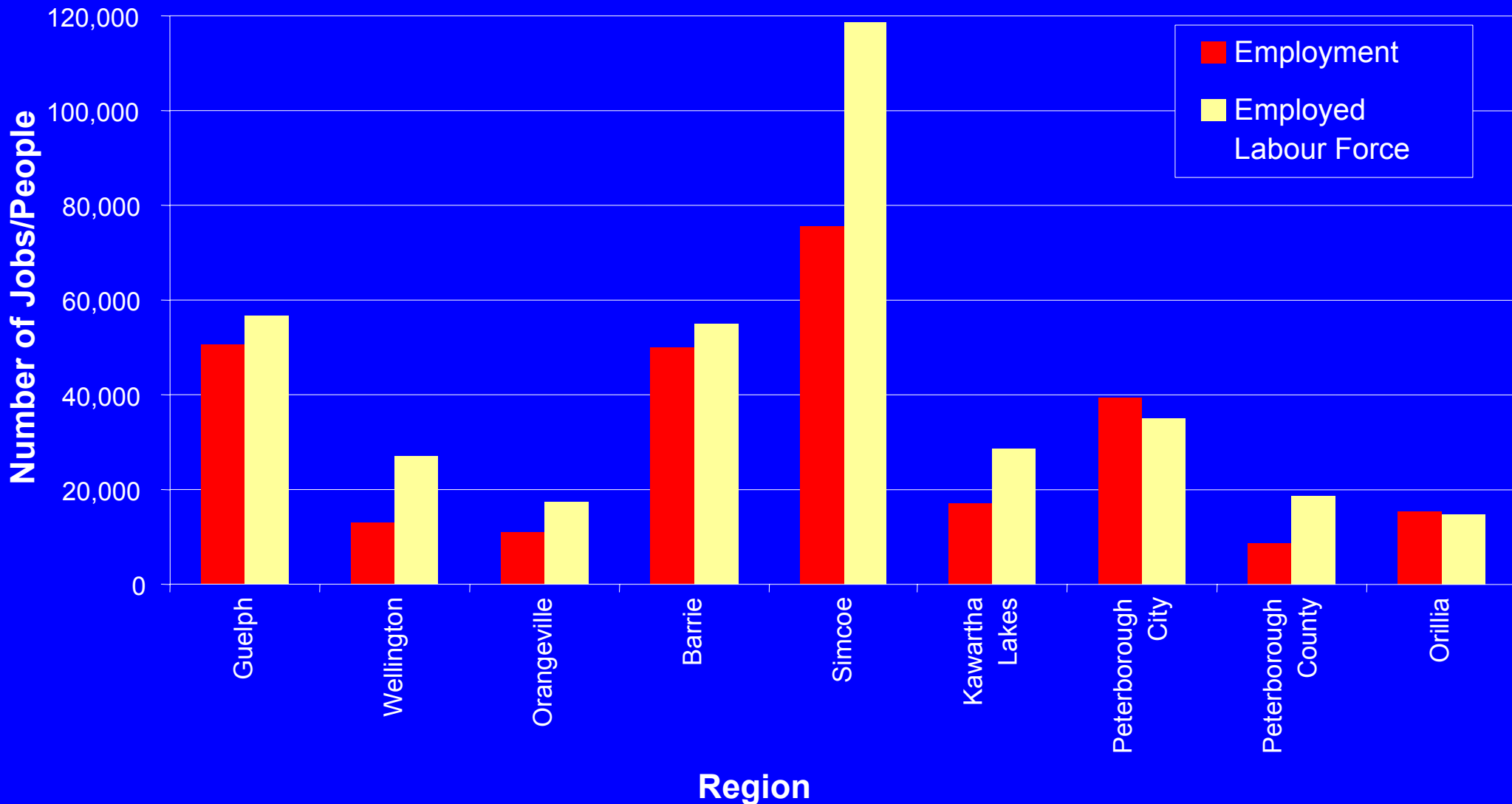
Employed Labour Force Participation Rate



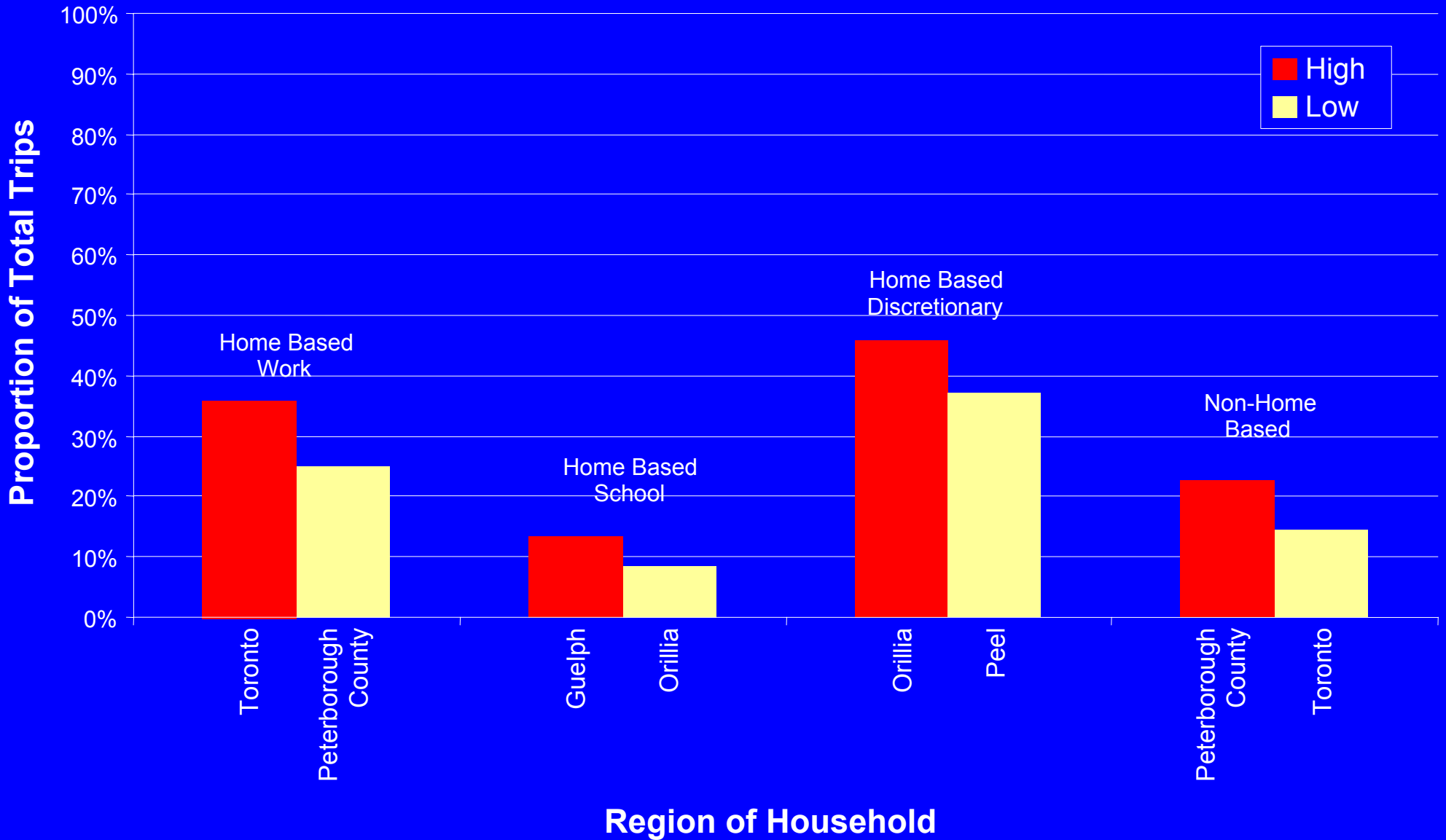
Employment vs. Employed Labour Force



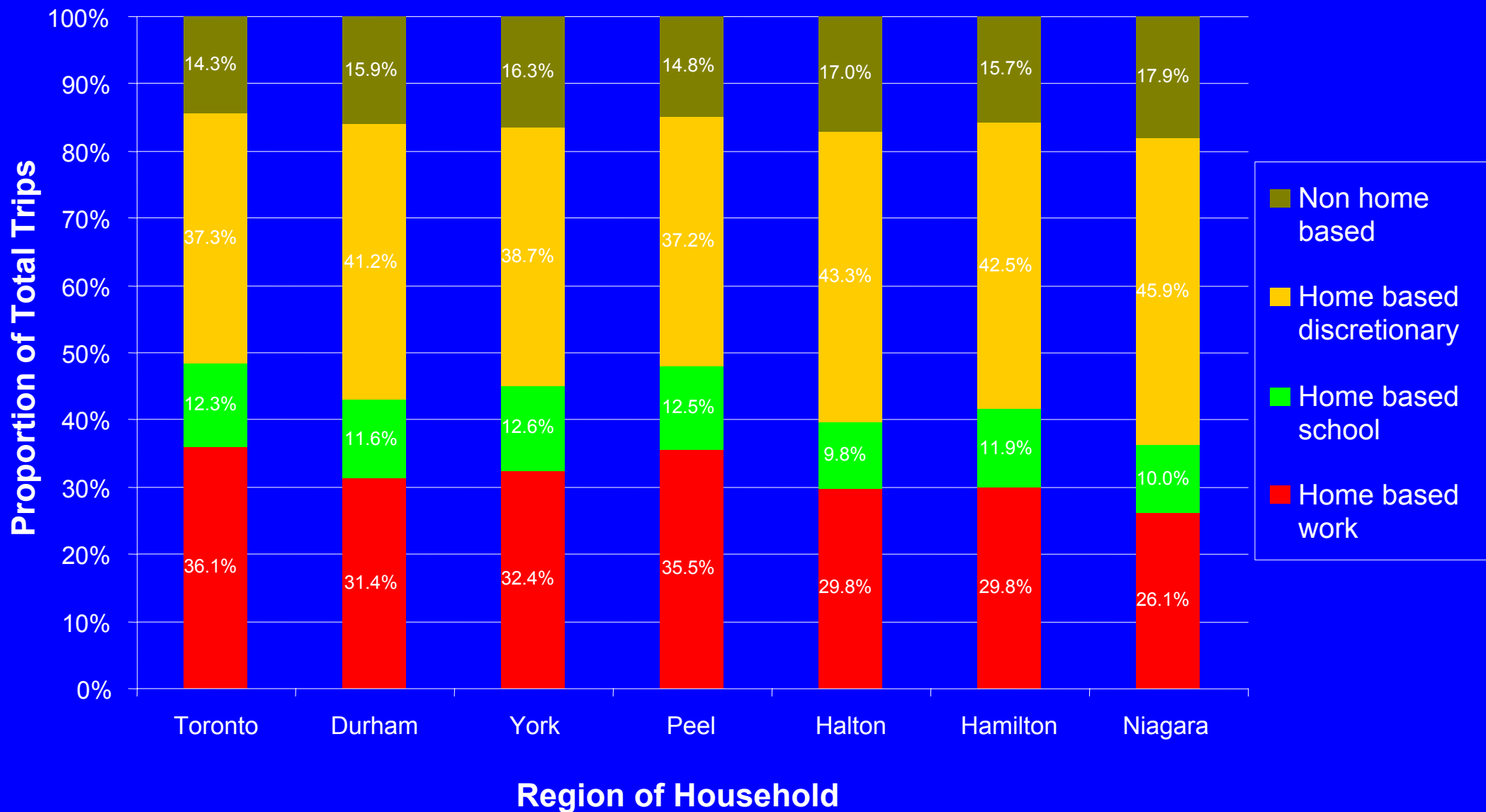

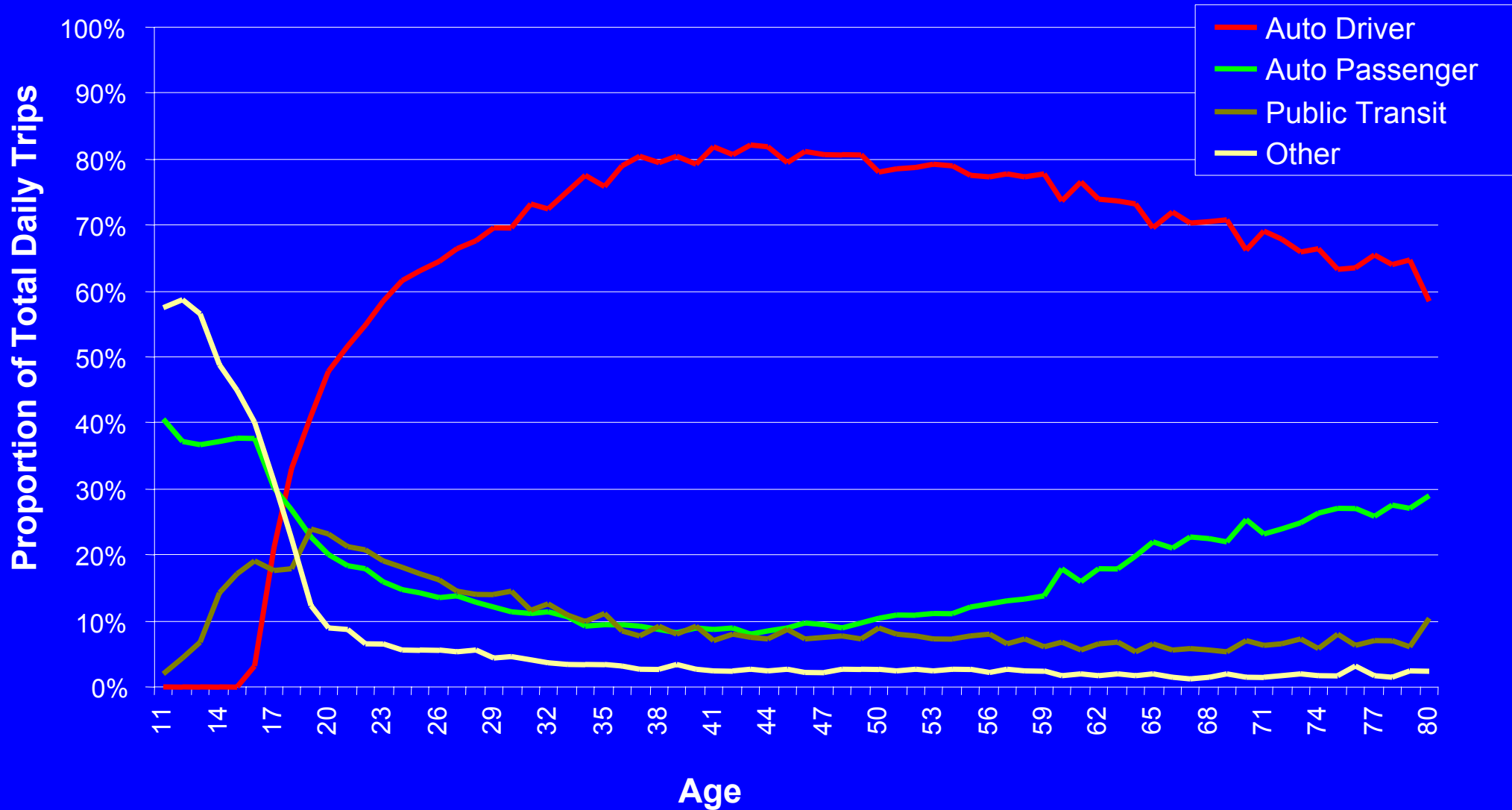
Mode Splits All Trips



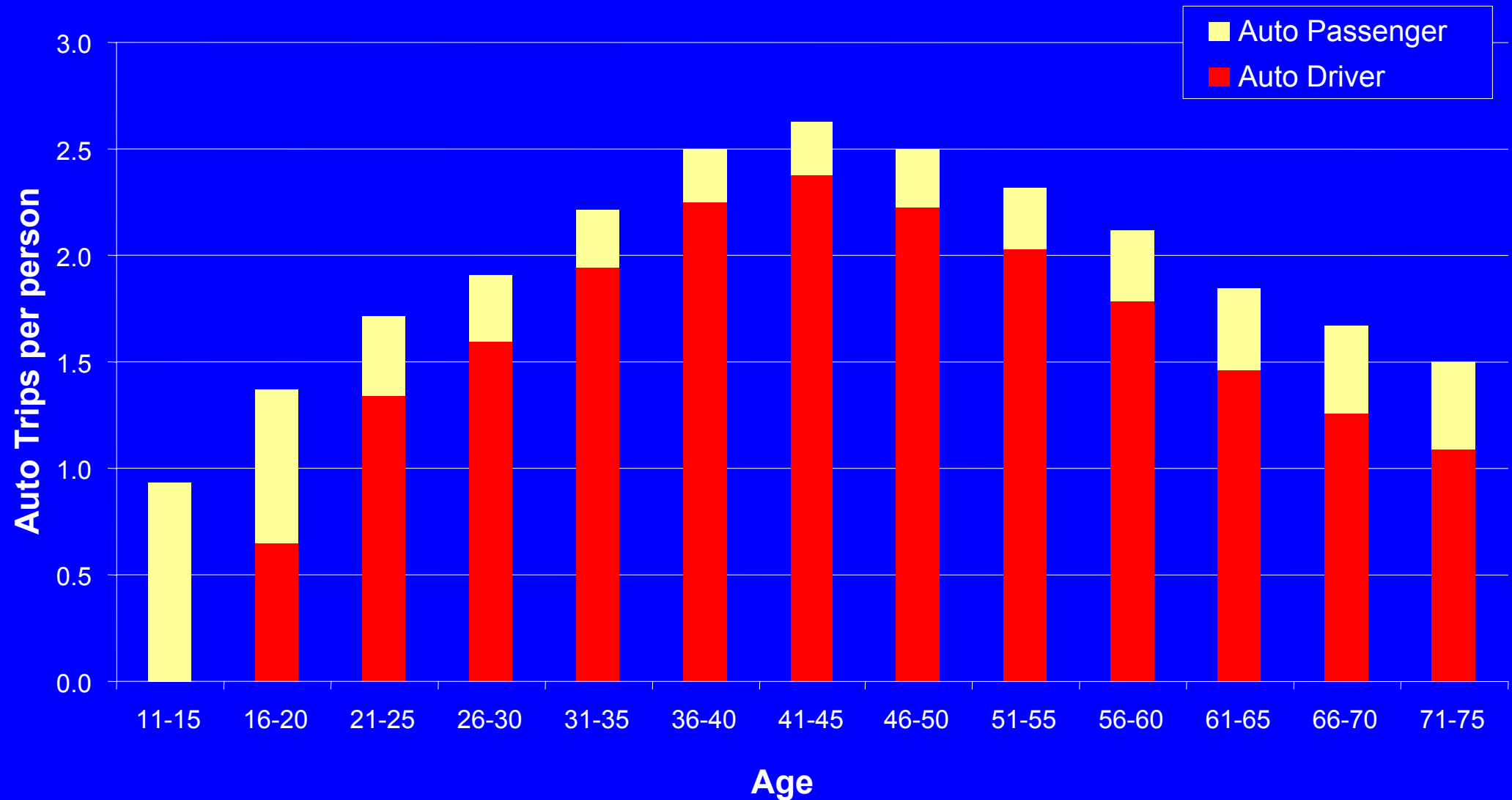

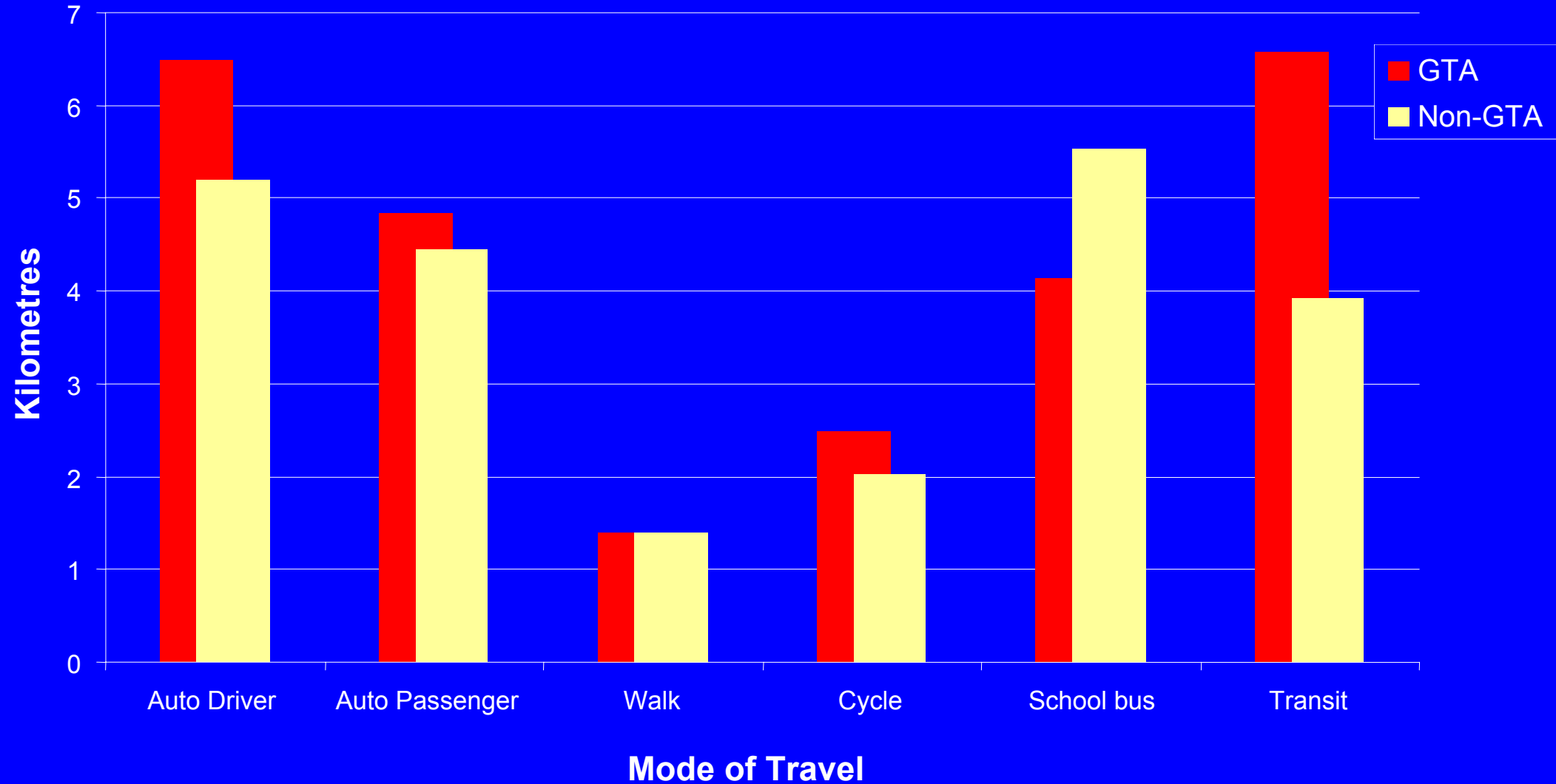
Total Survey Area Mode Split



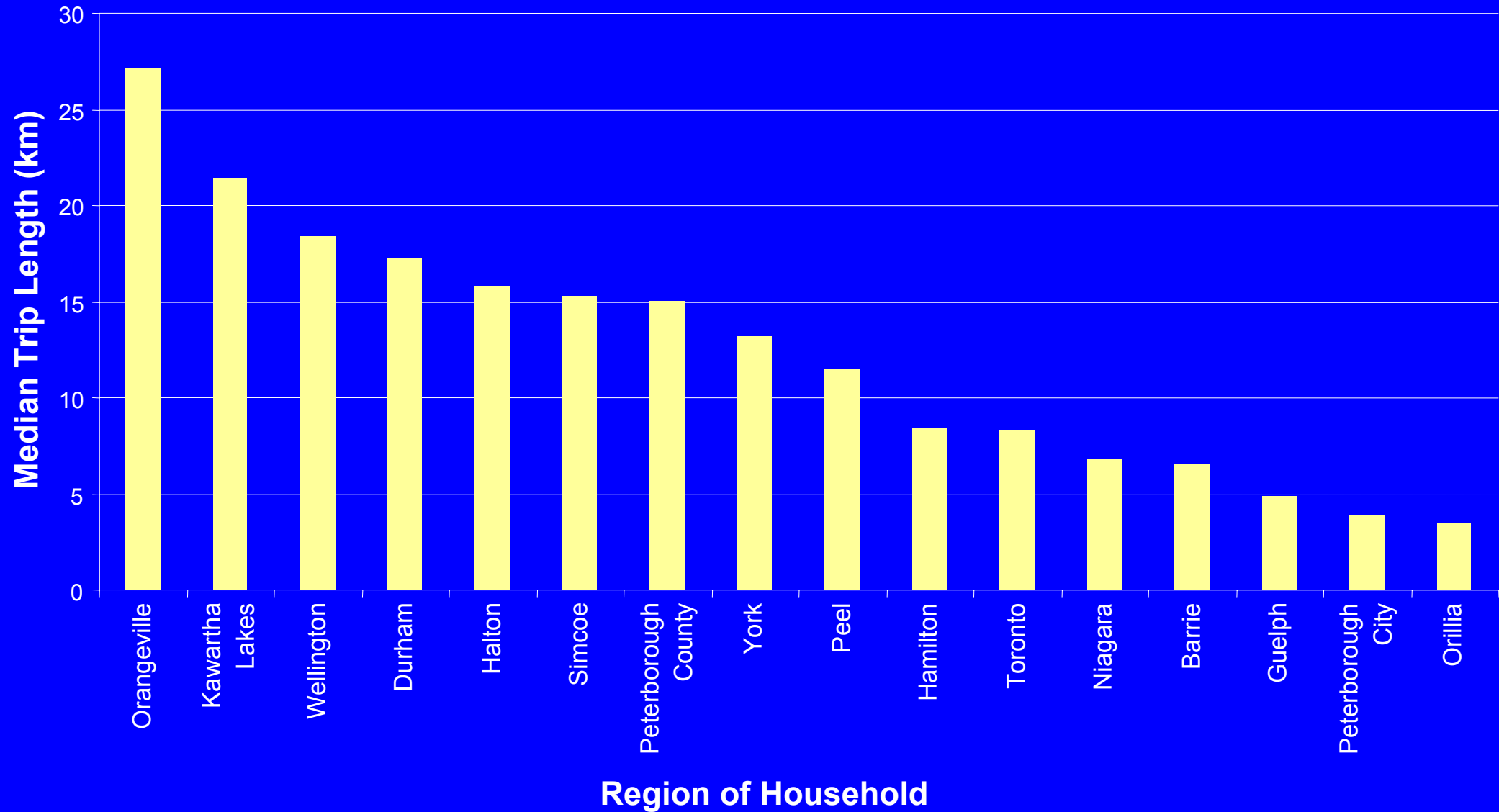

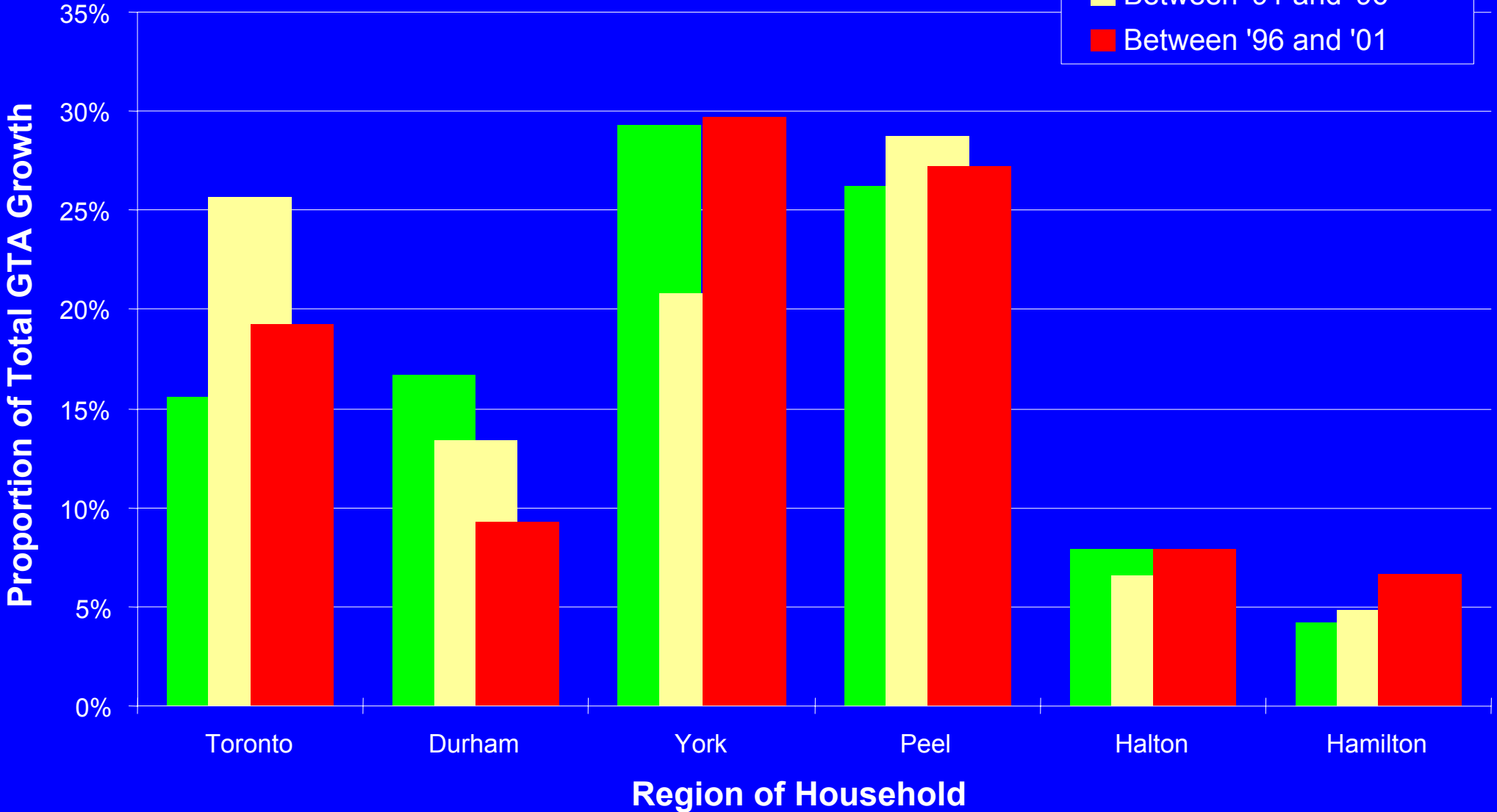


Five-Year Population Growth

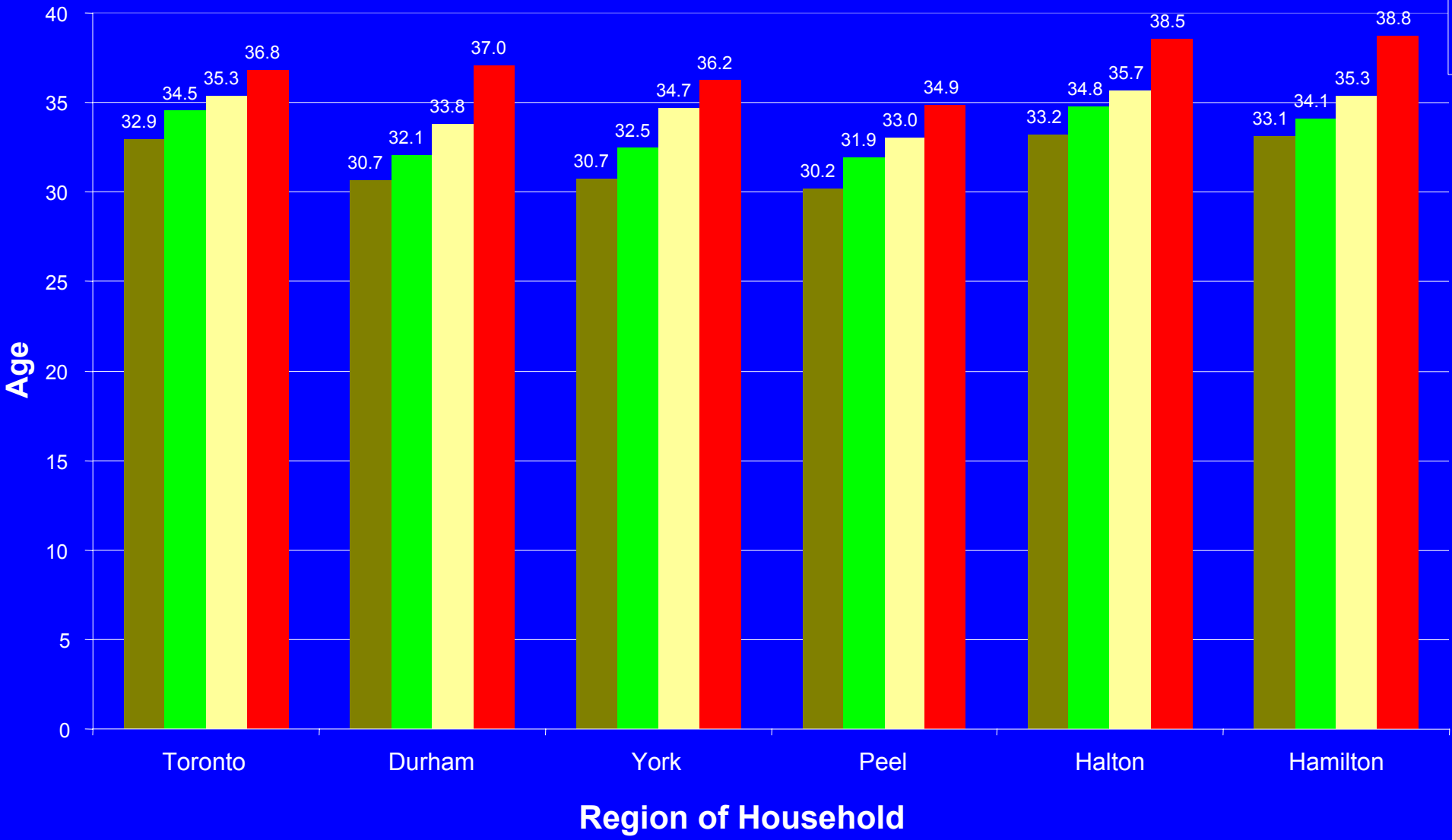

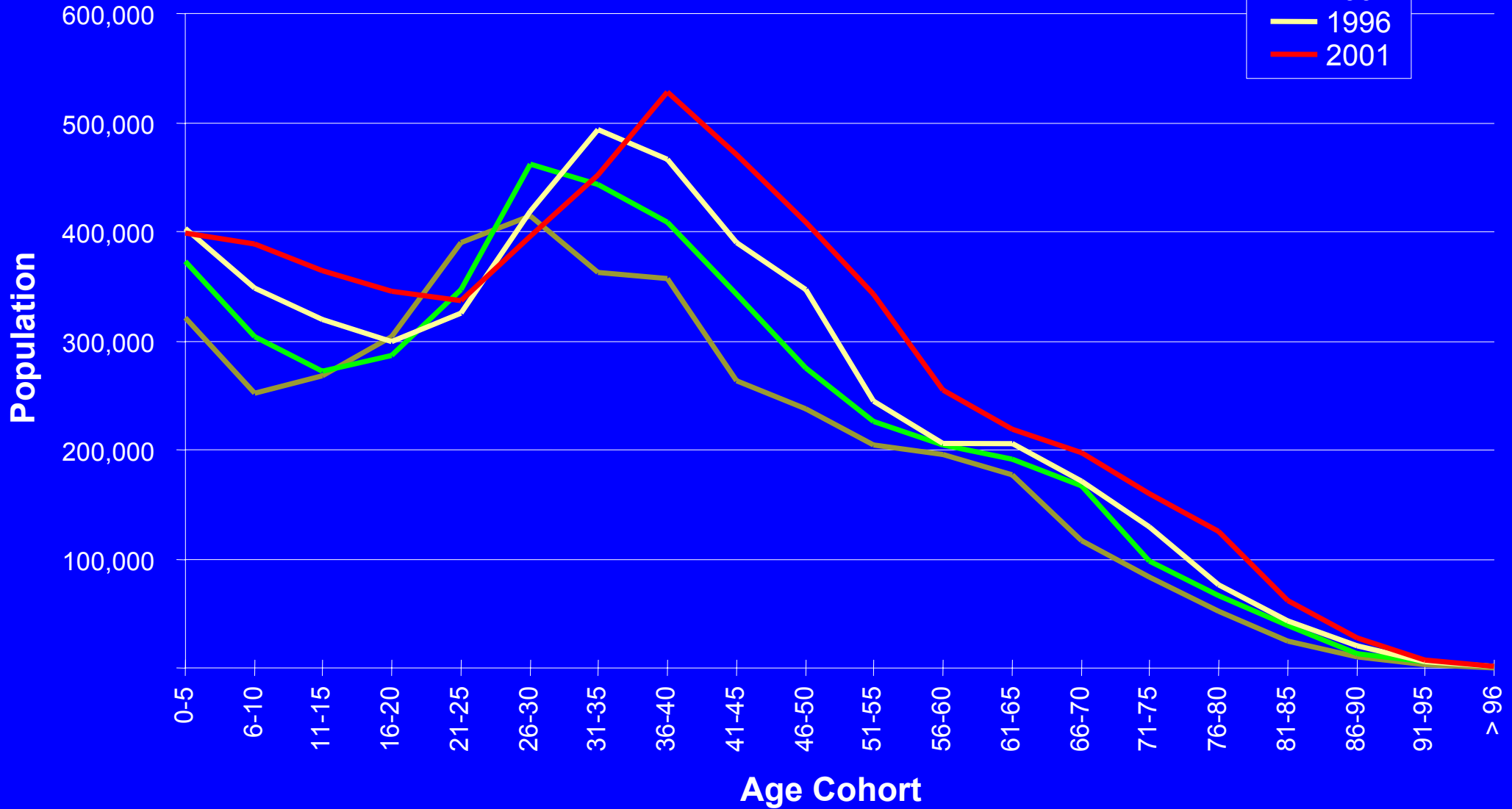
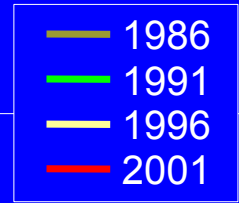

GTA Residents Age Distribution

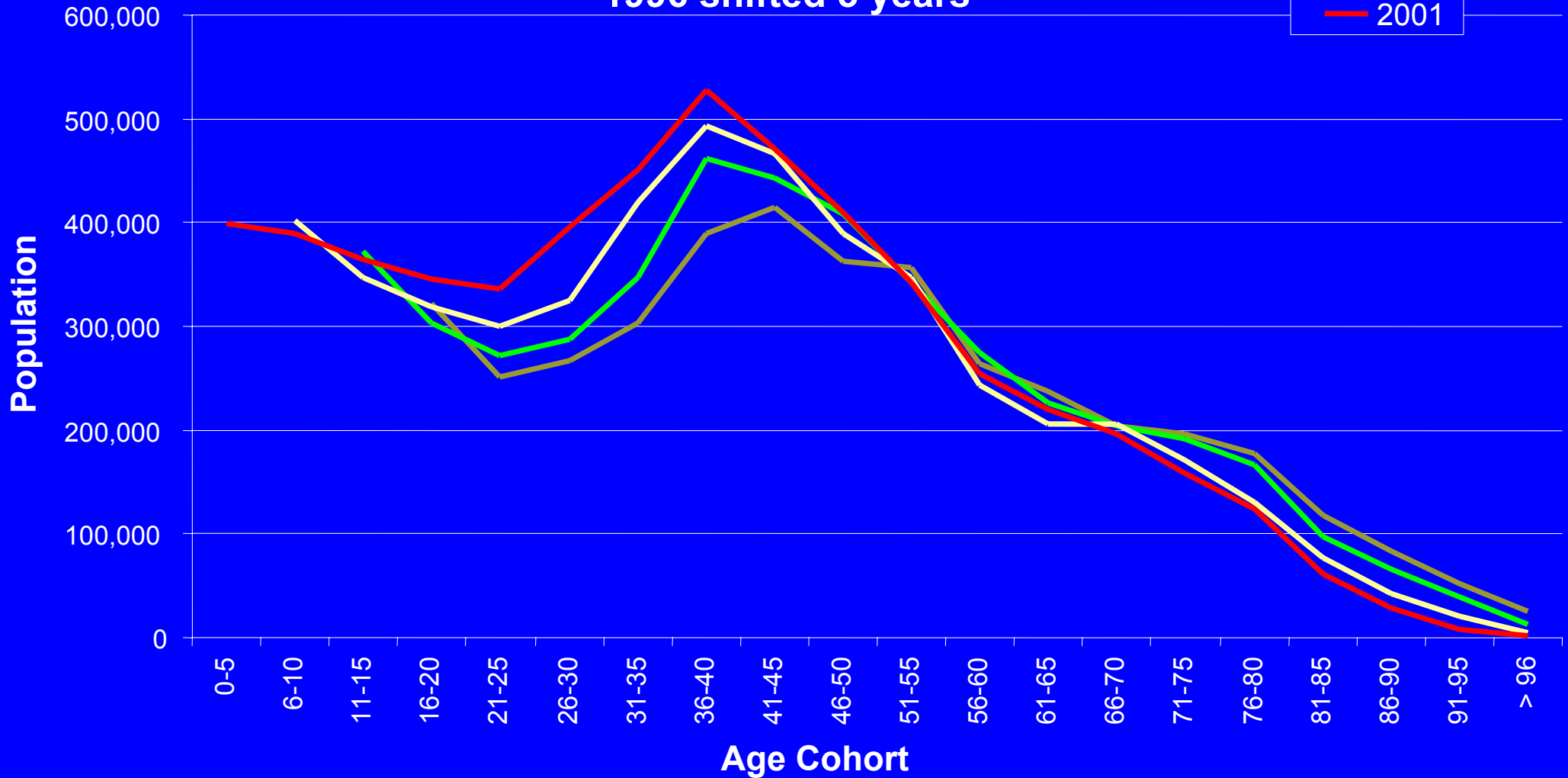

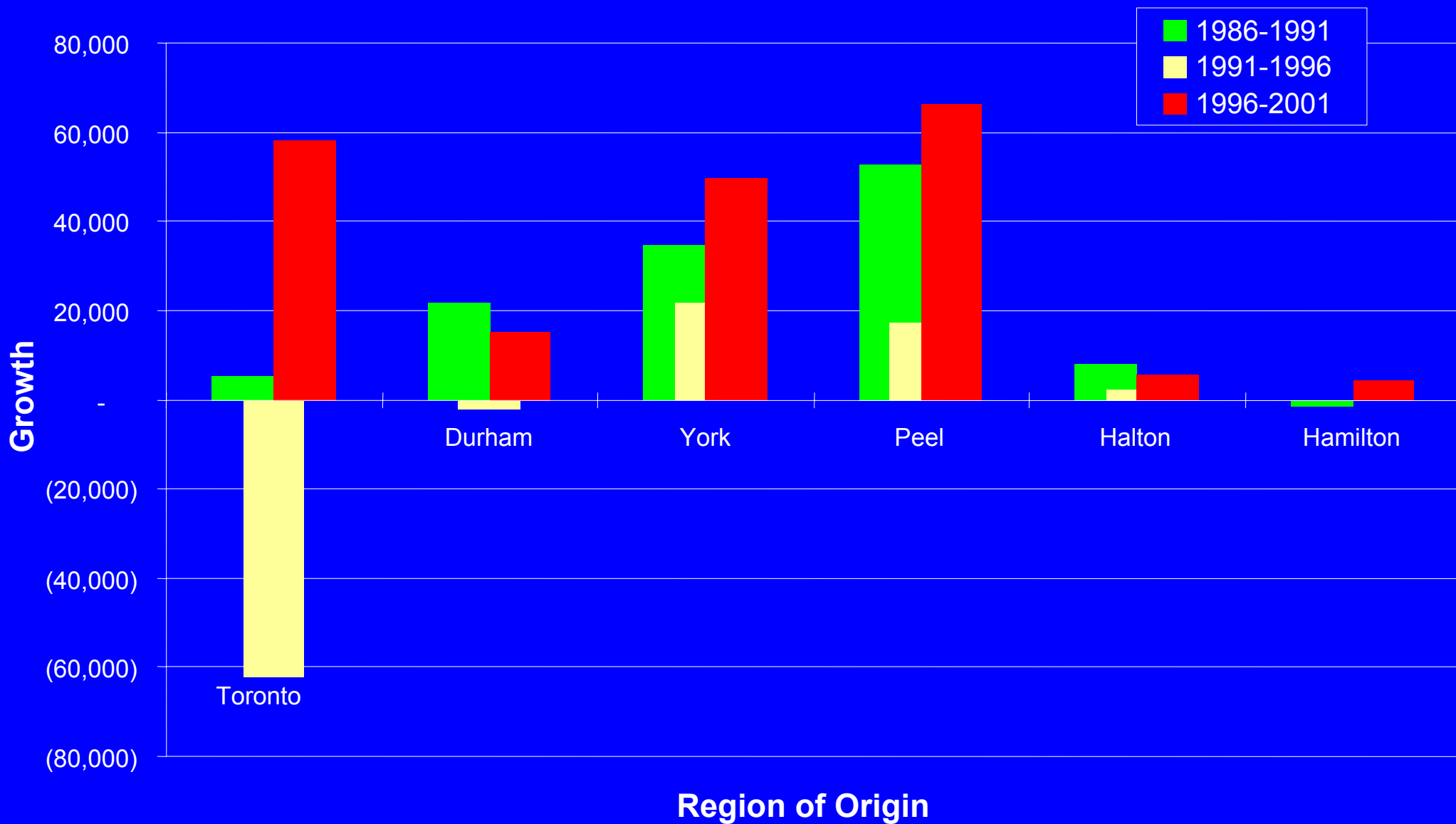
Employment (GTA Residents)



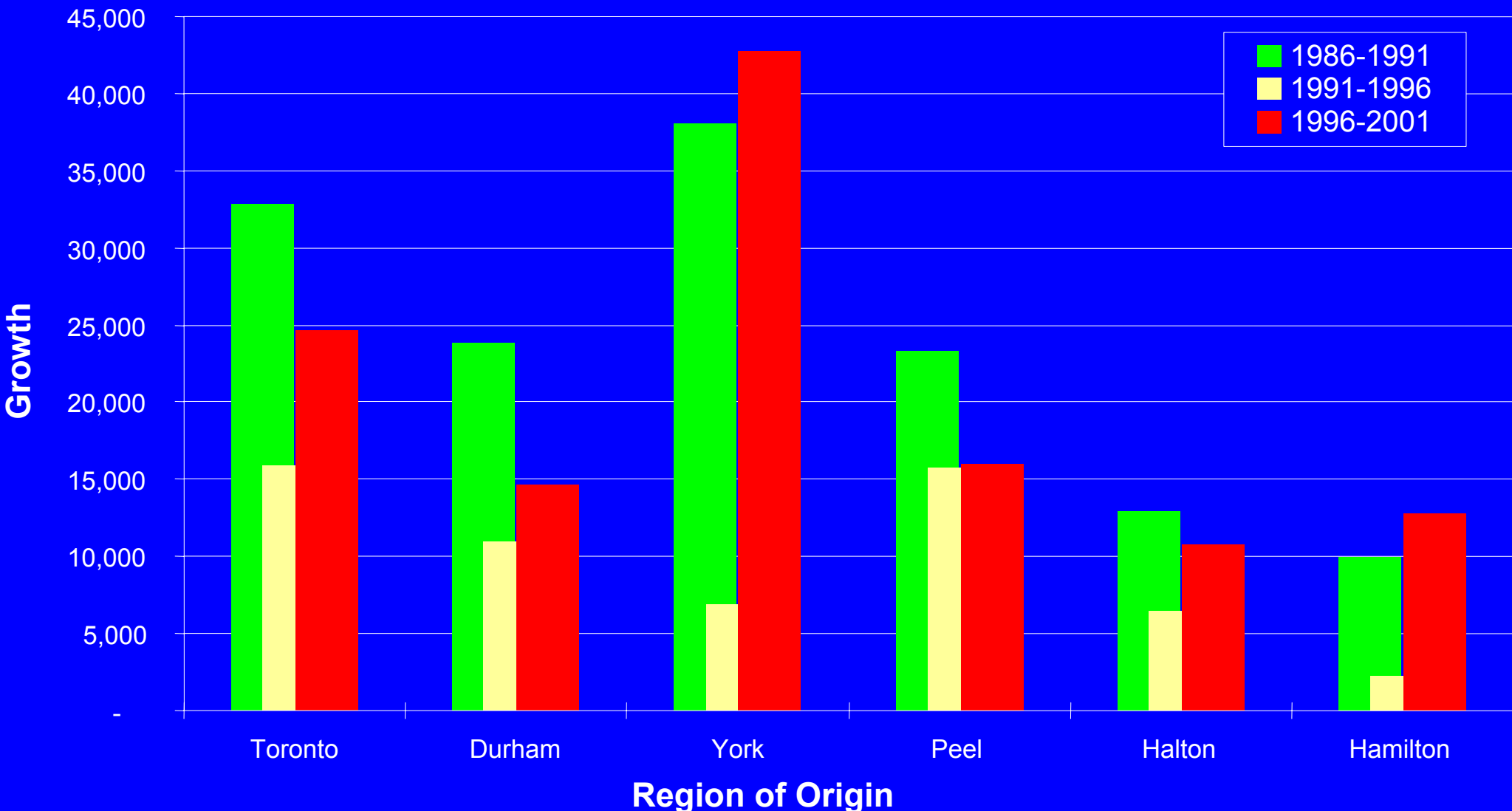
Employment Minus Employed Labour Force (GTA Residents to GTA Employment)



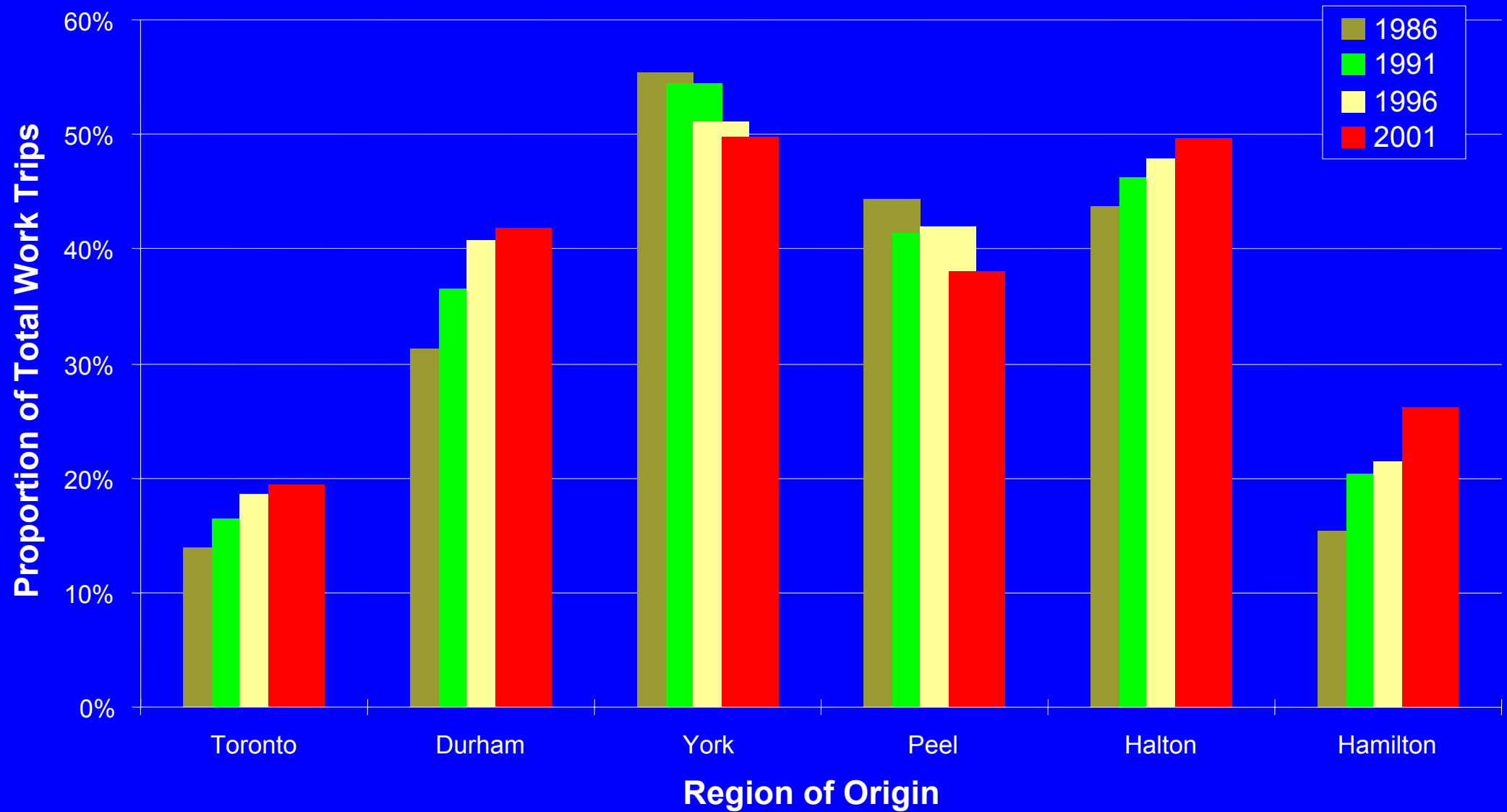
Intra-Regional Work Trips



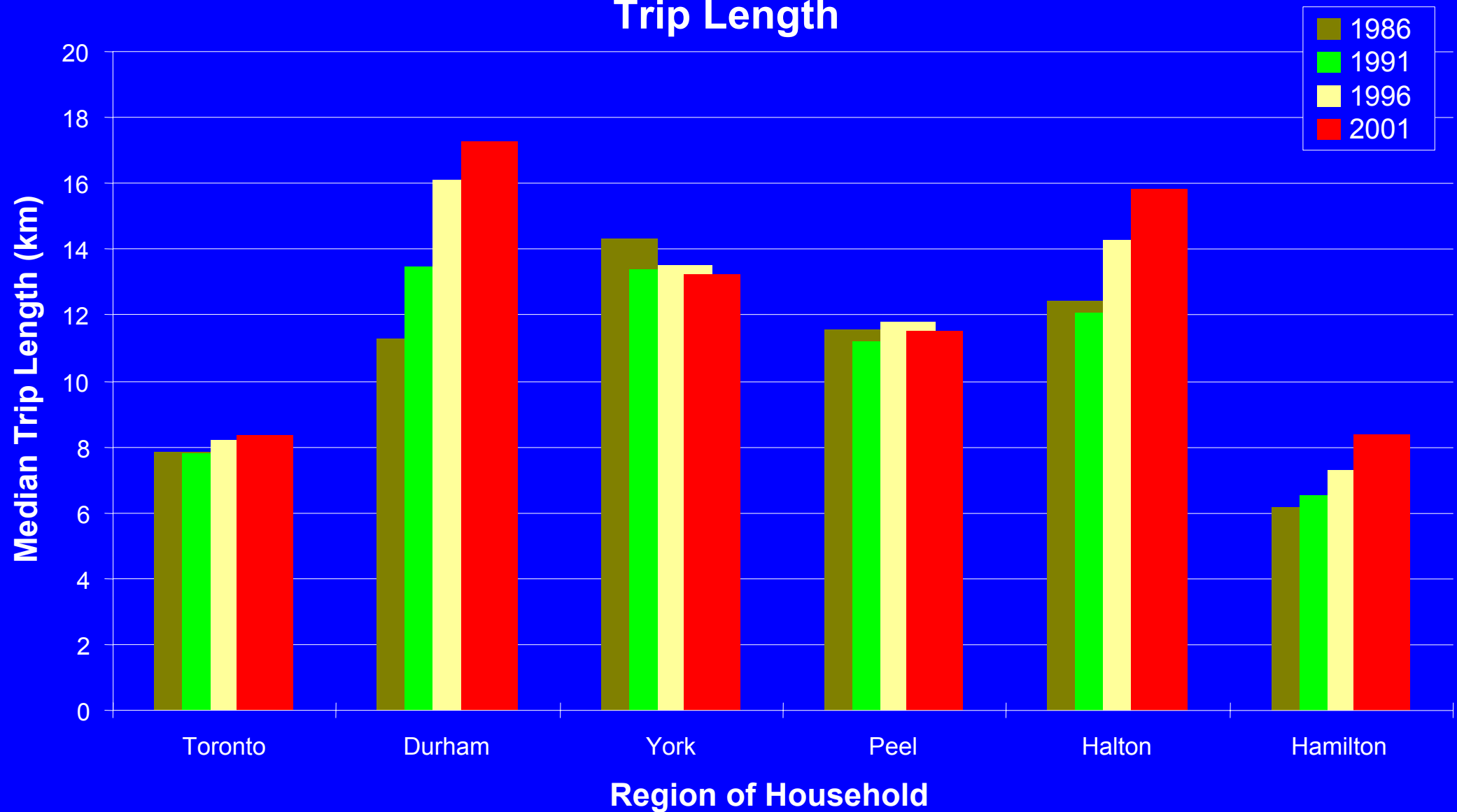

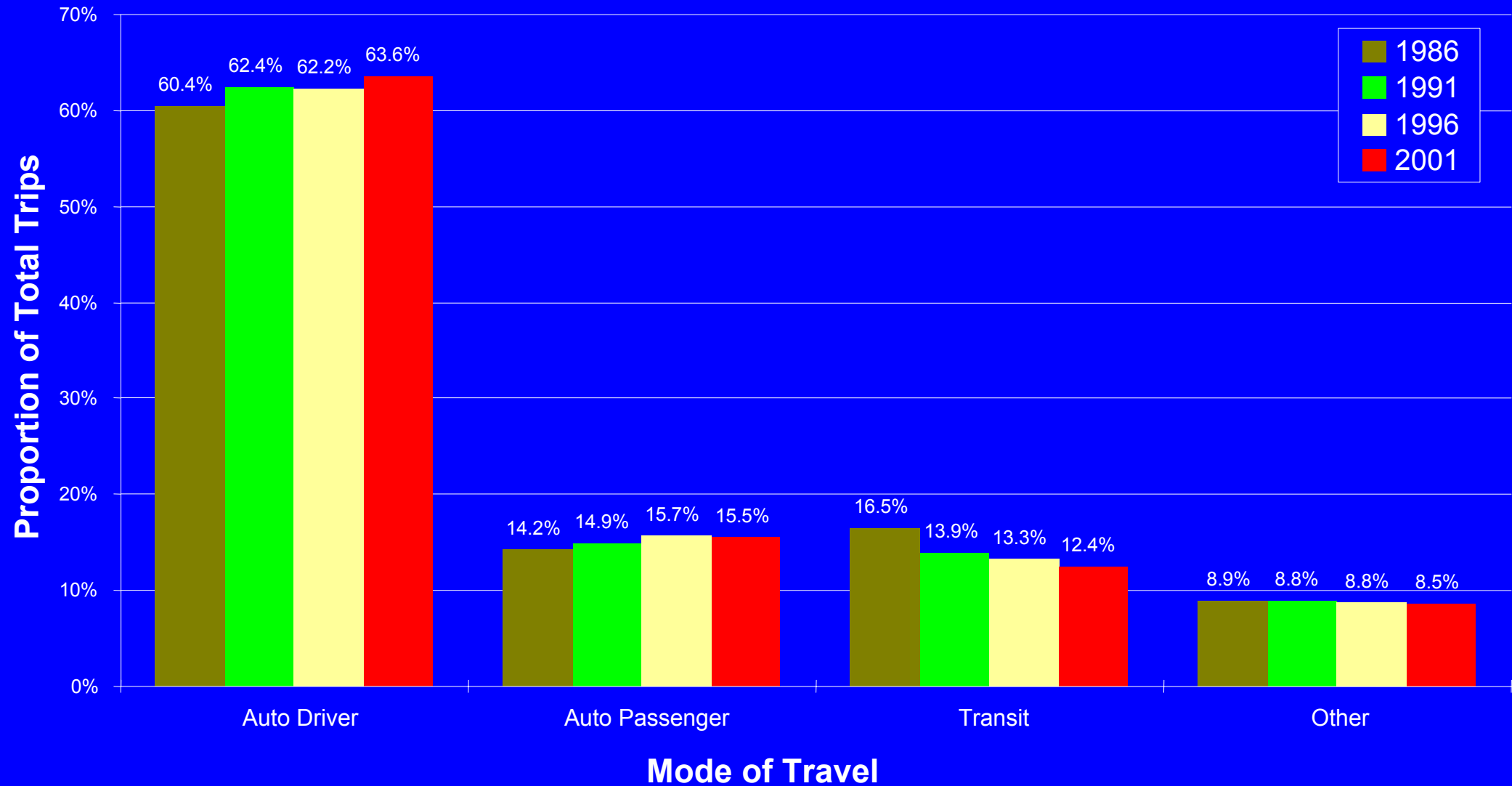
Males (16-21 yrs.) Without a Licence



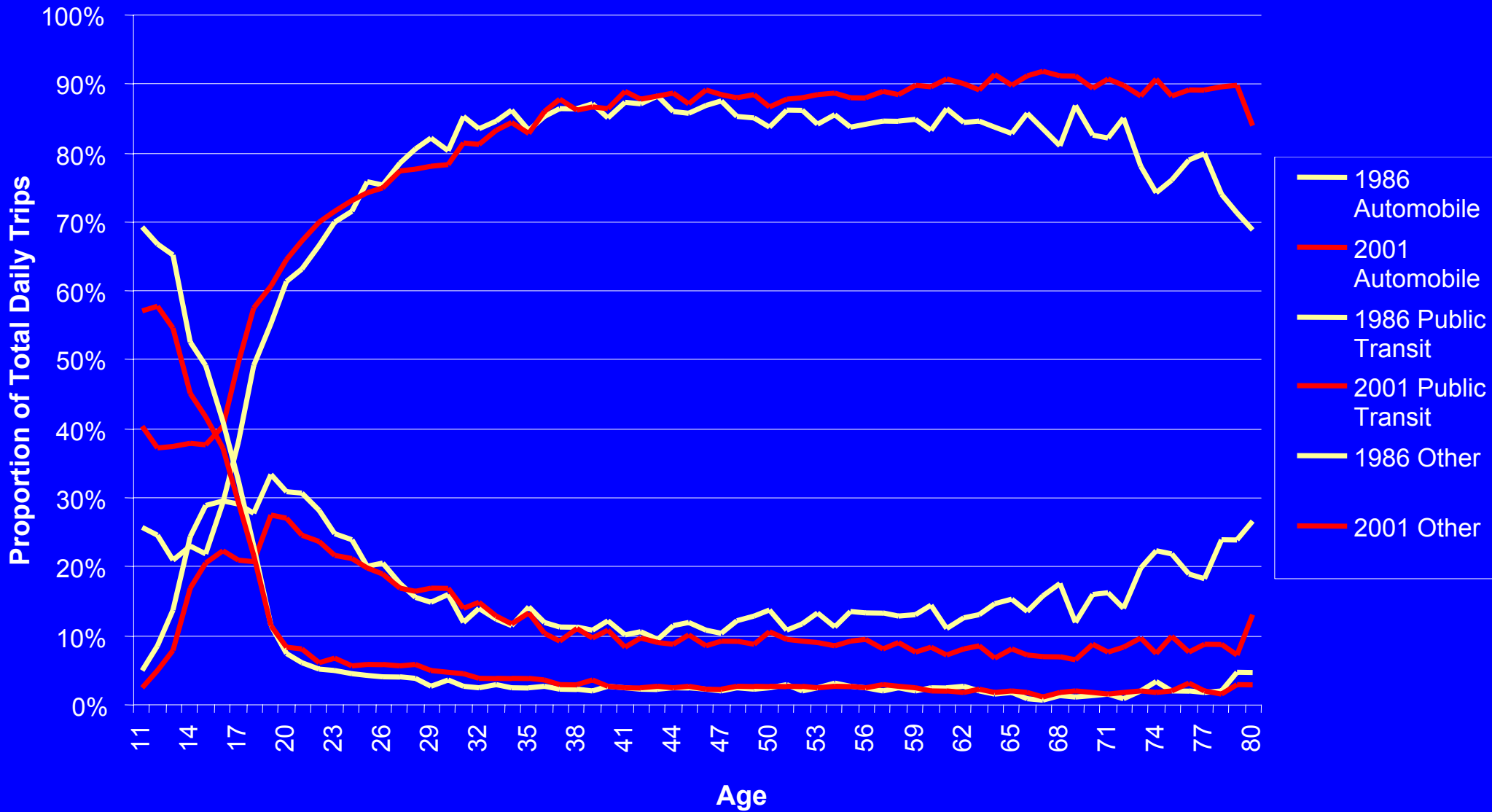

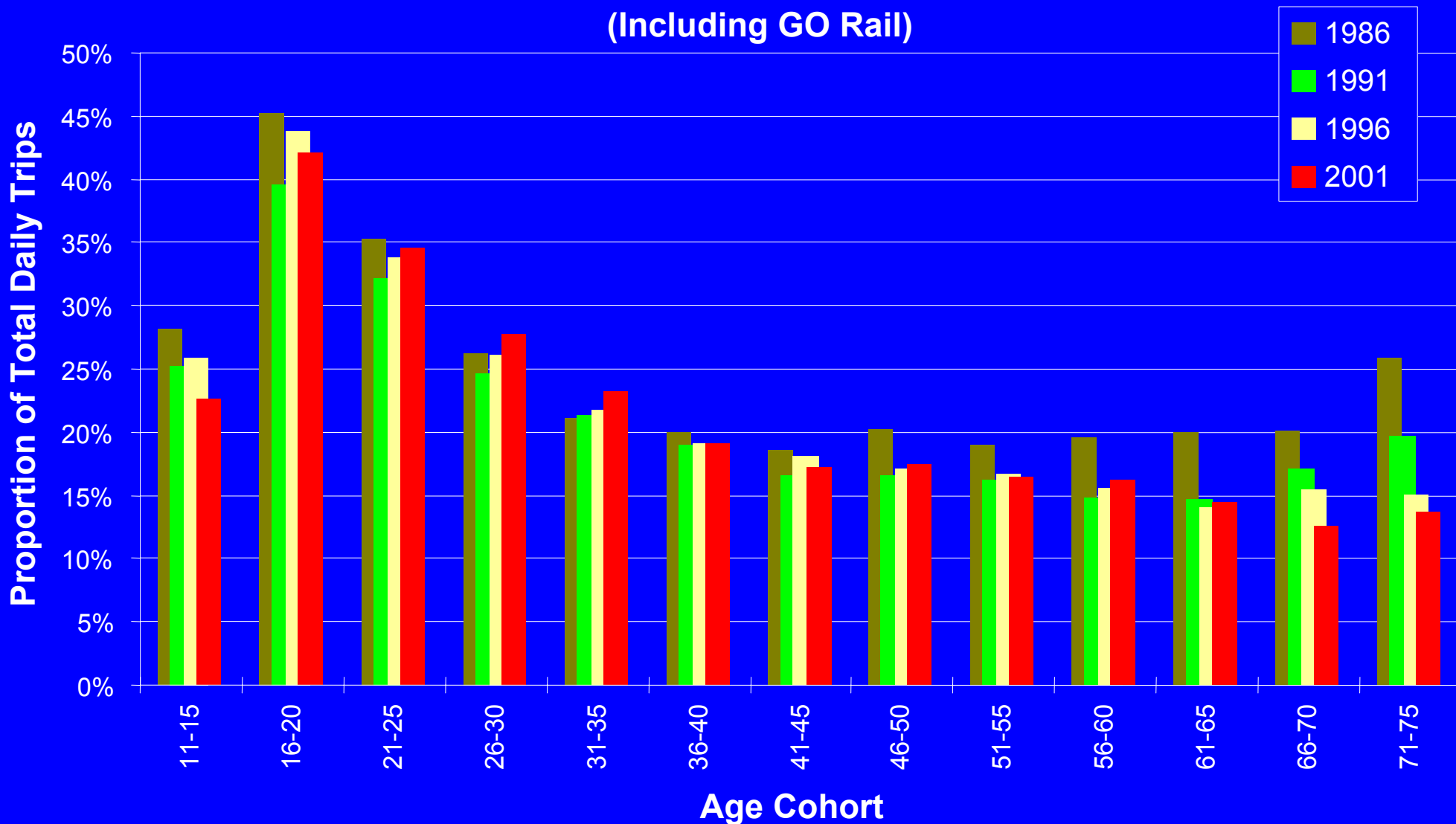

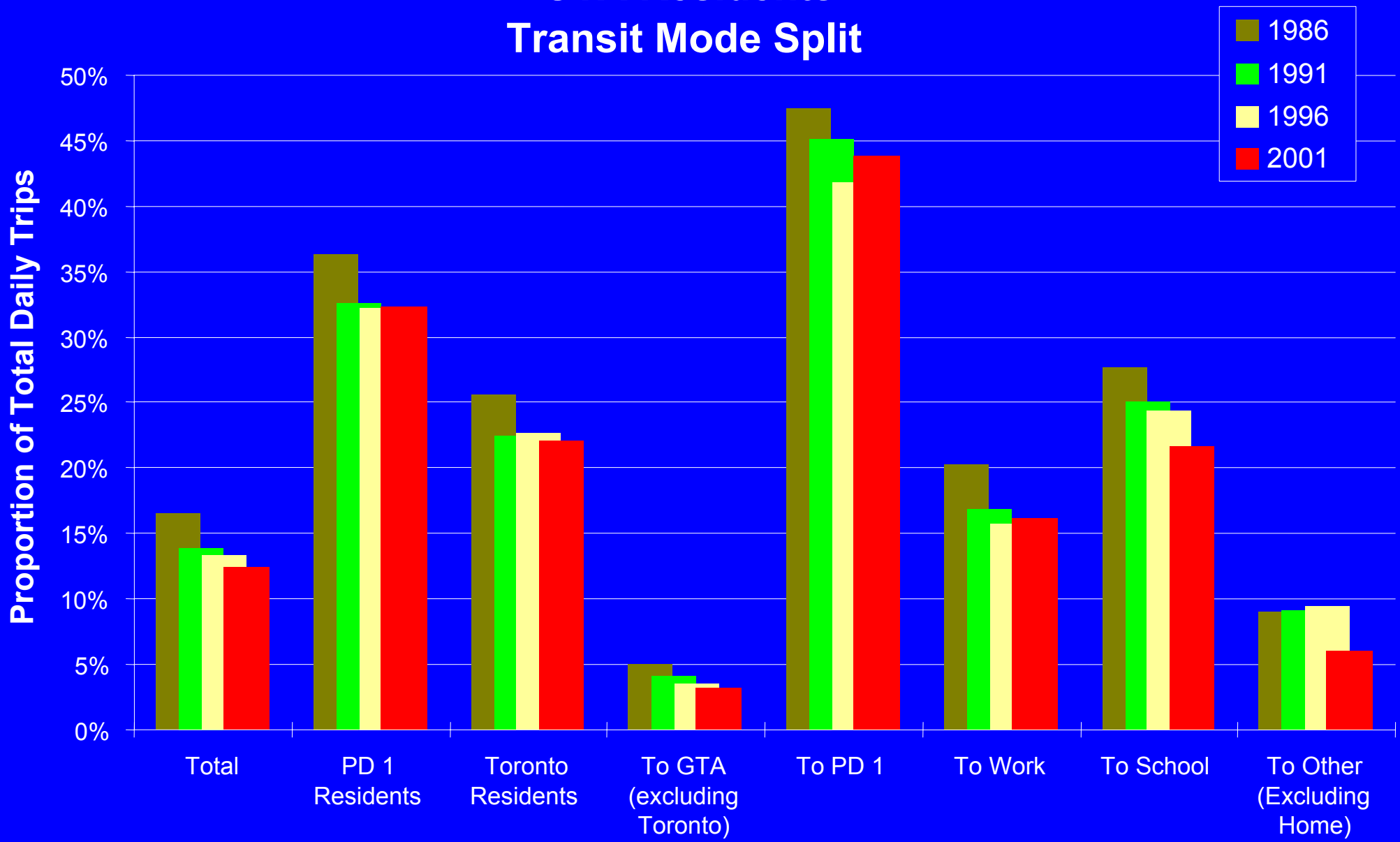
GTA MODE SPLIT



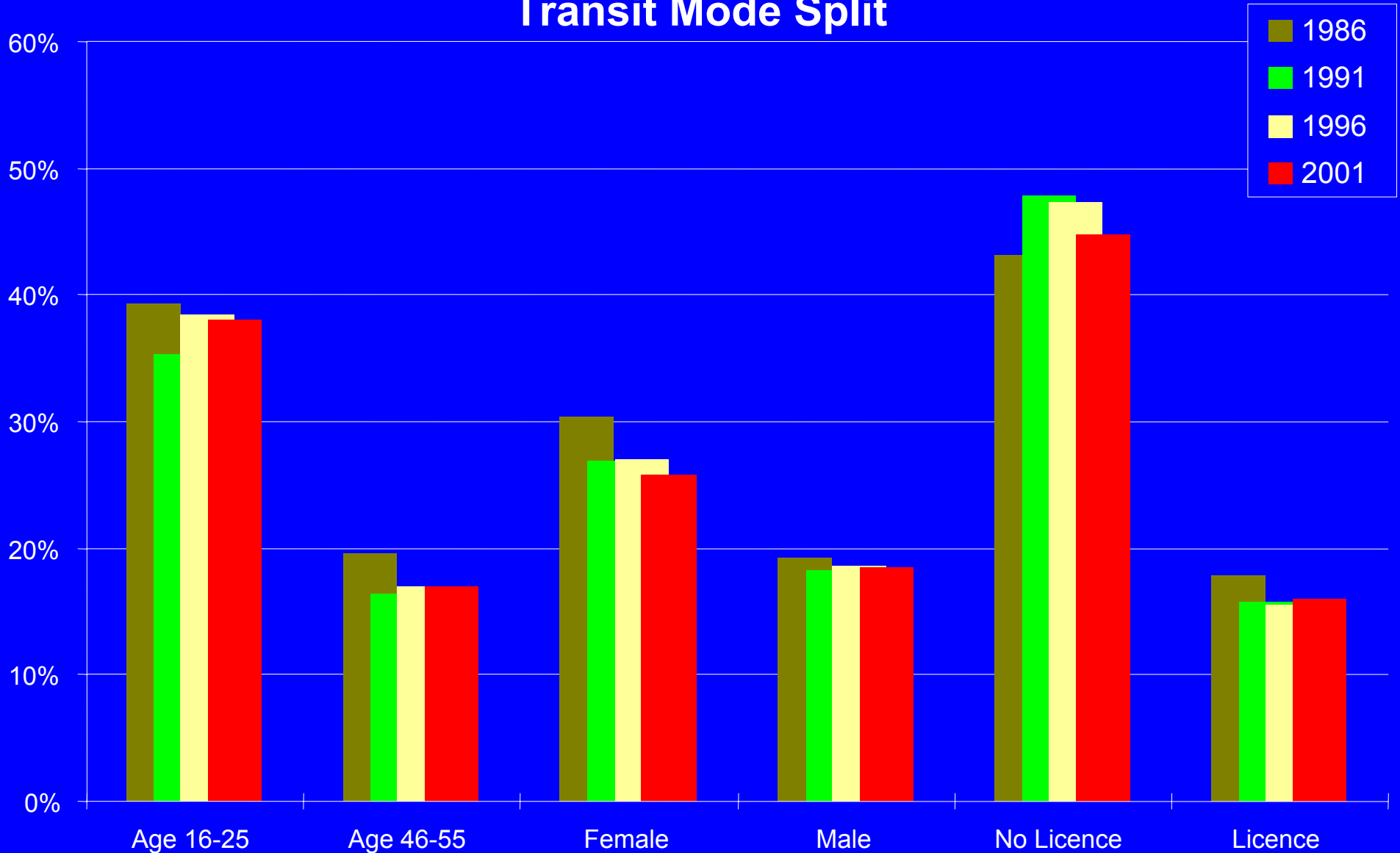
Toronto Residents Transit Mode Split (Including GO Rail)



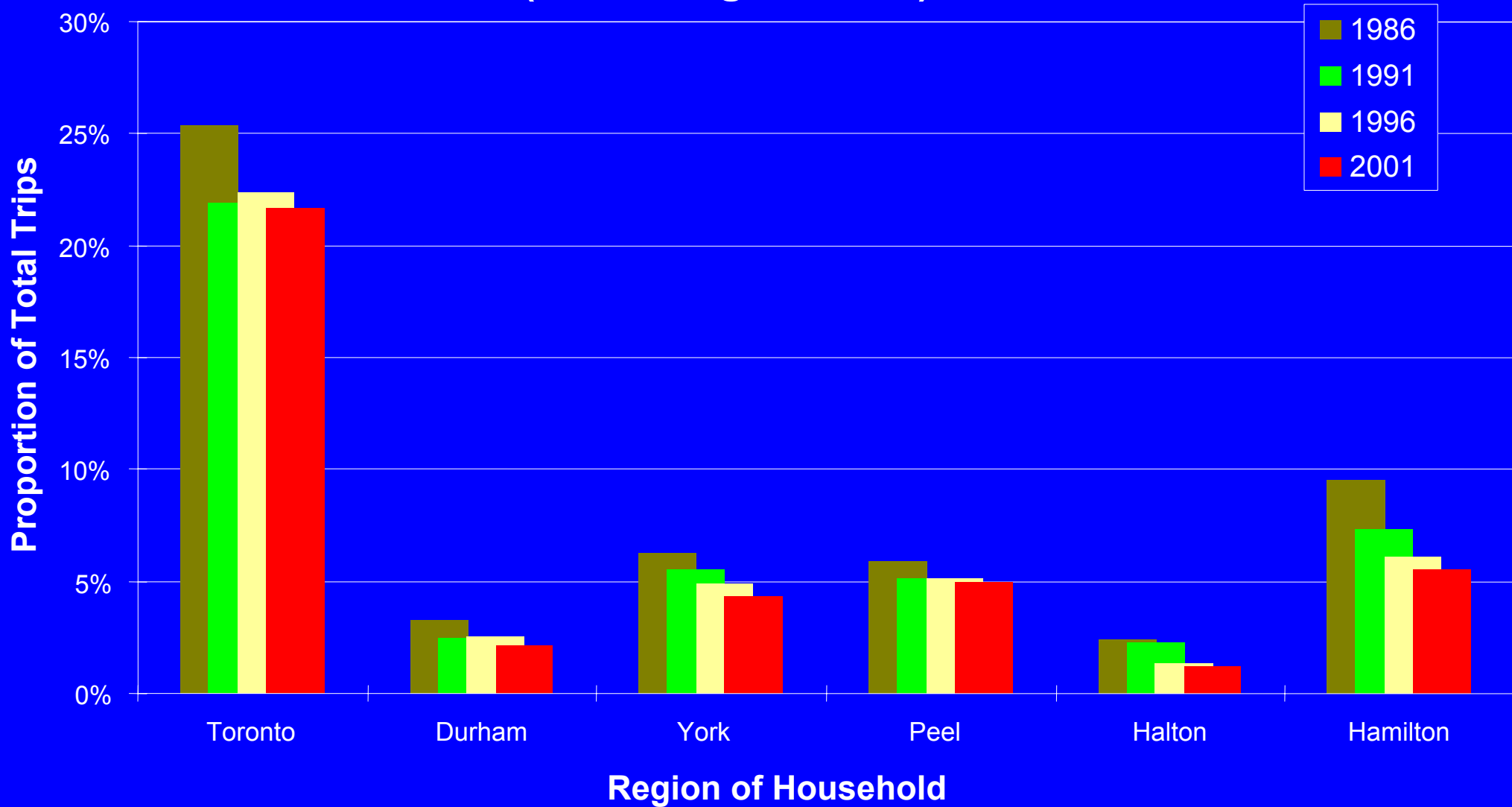

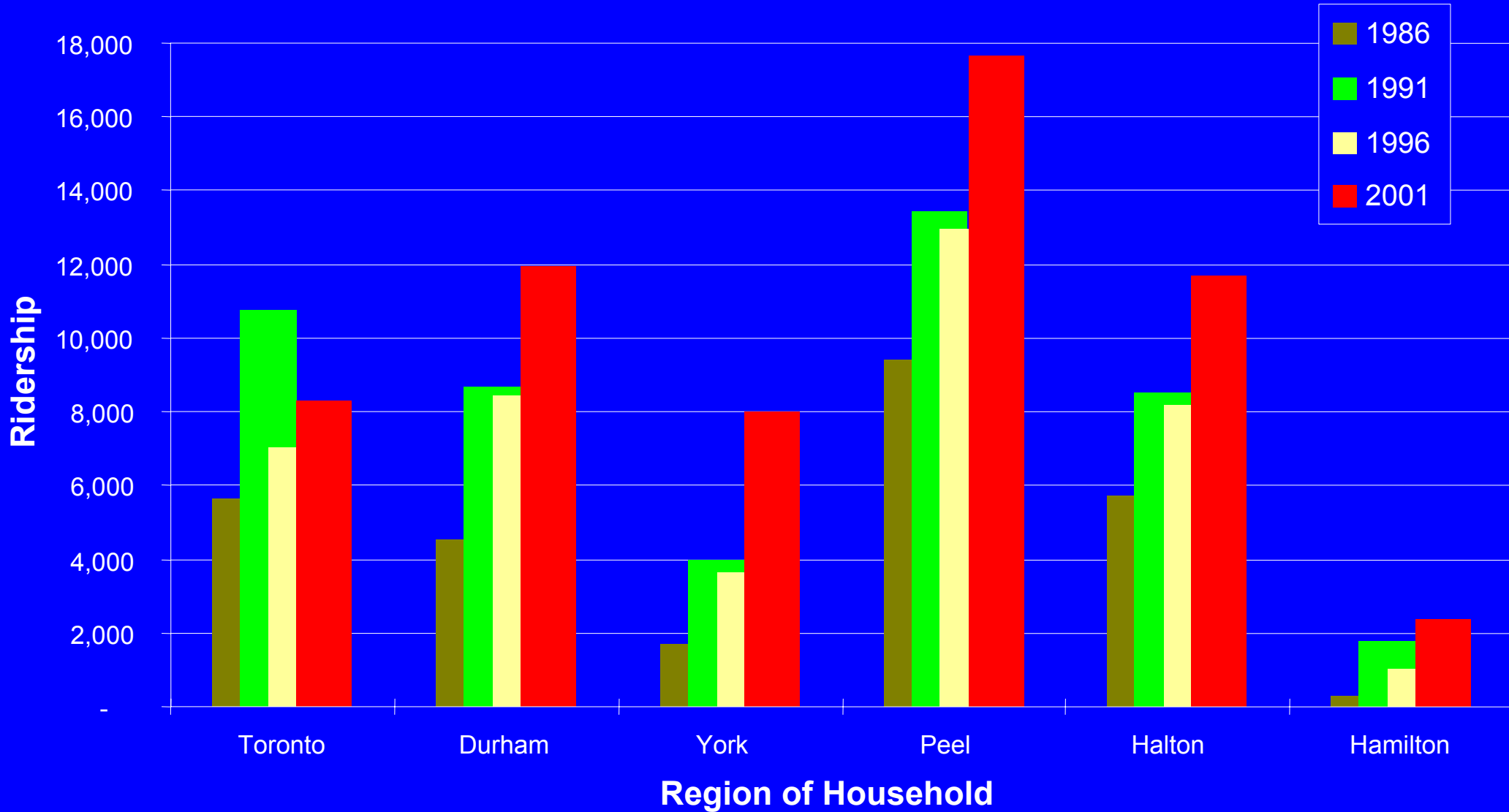

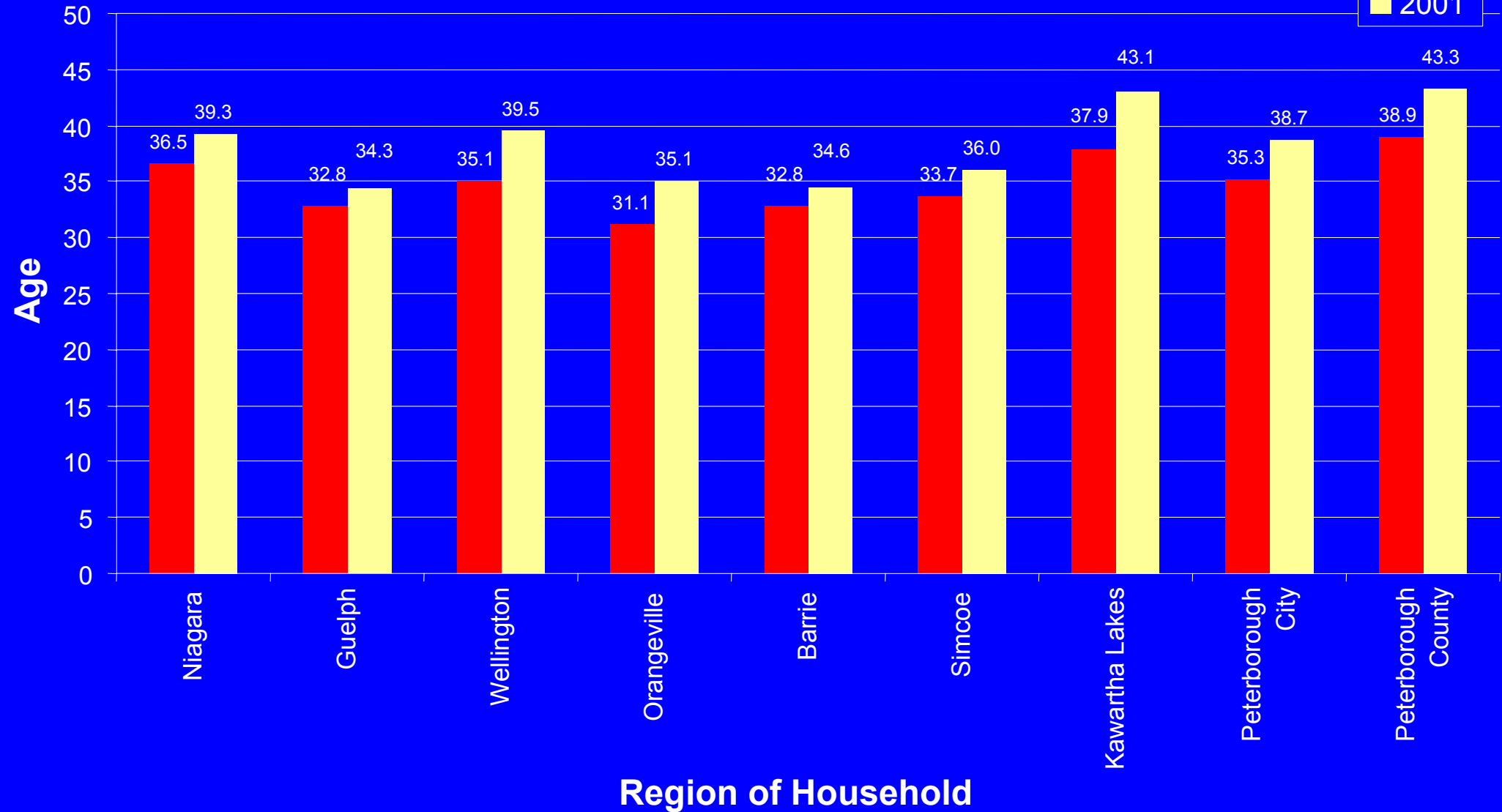
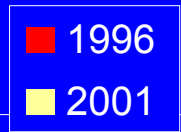
Non-GTA Residents Age Distribution



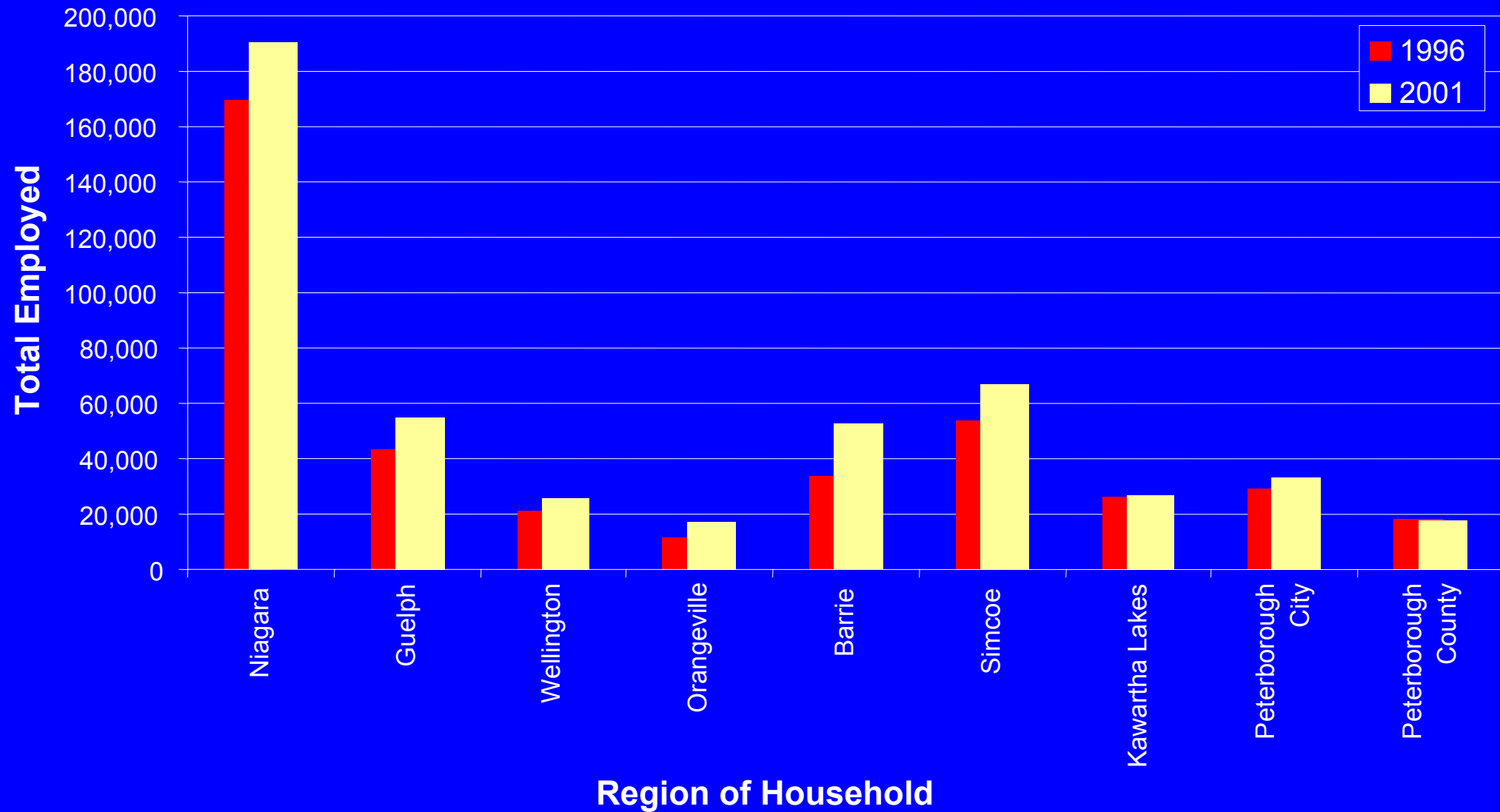

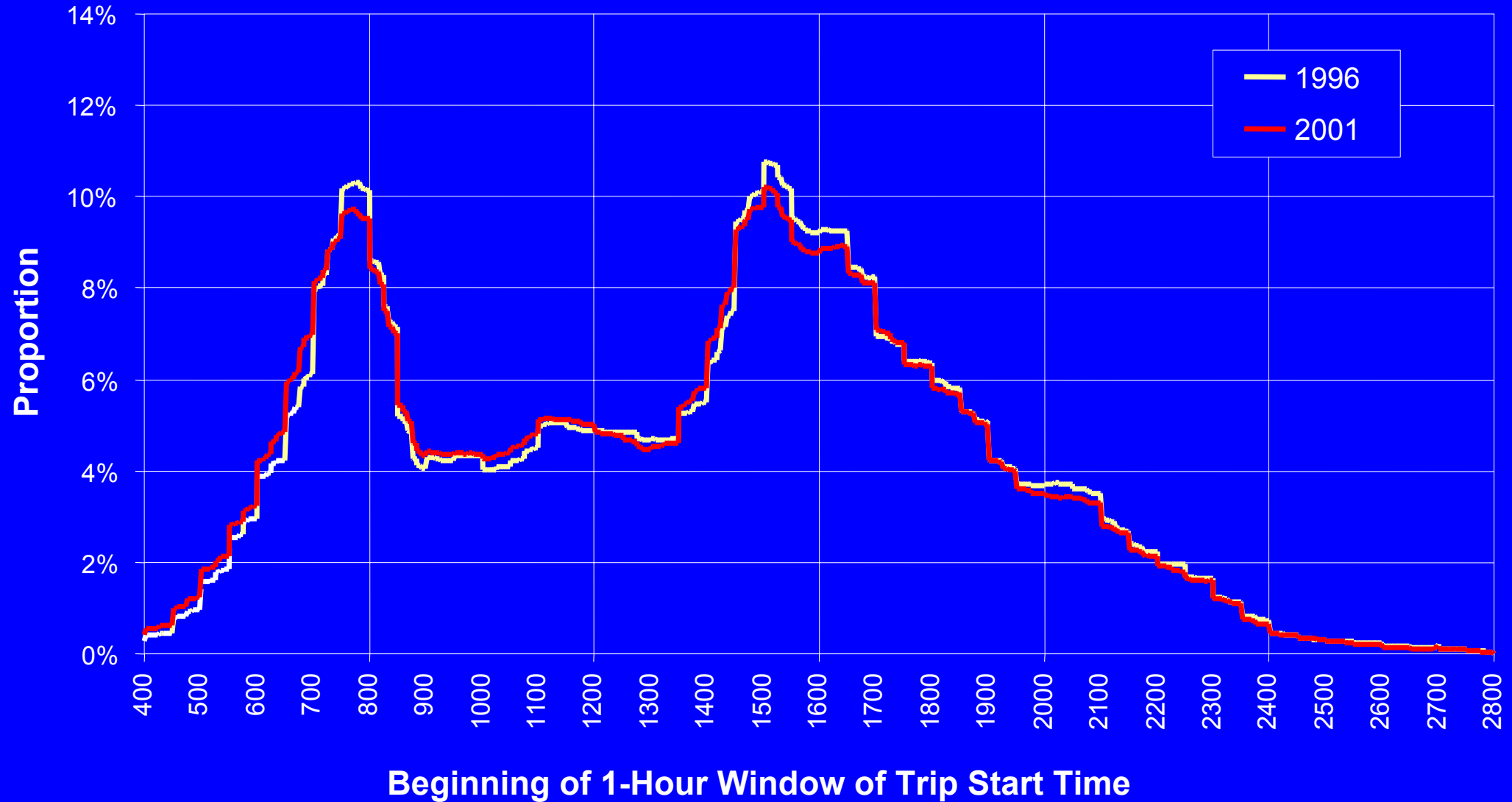
Employment Minus Employed Labour Force



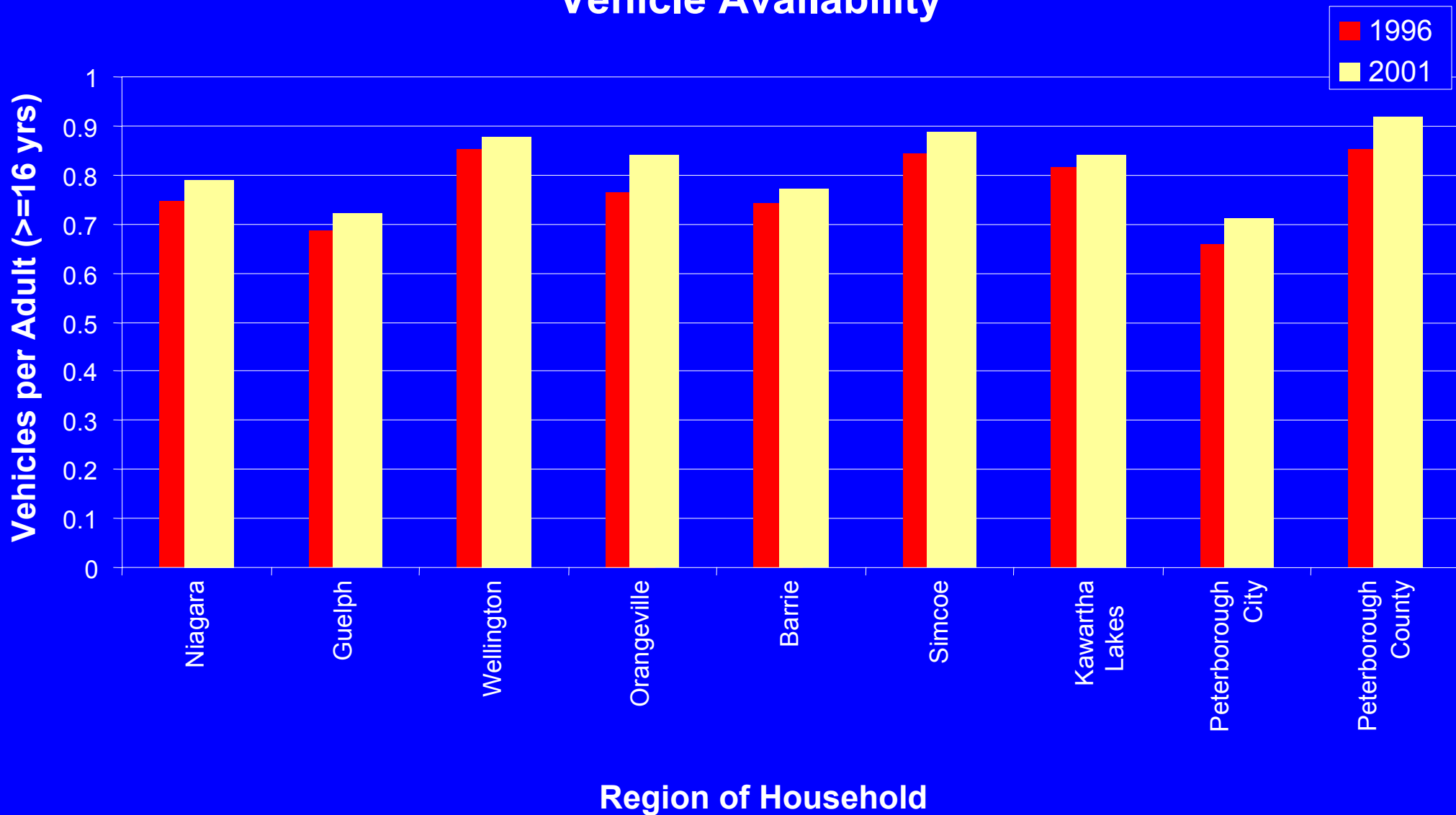

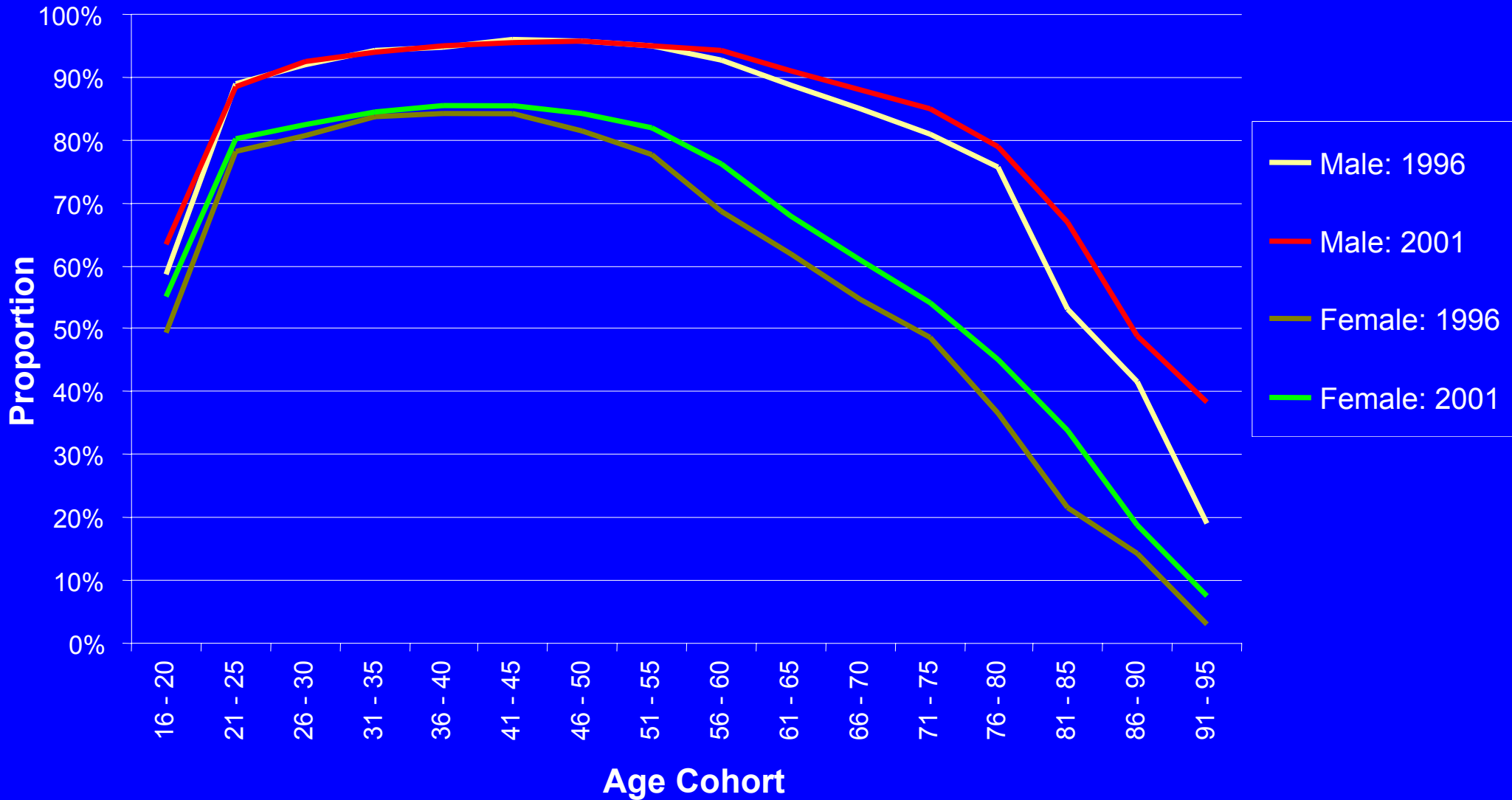

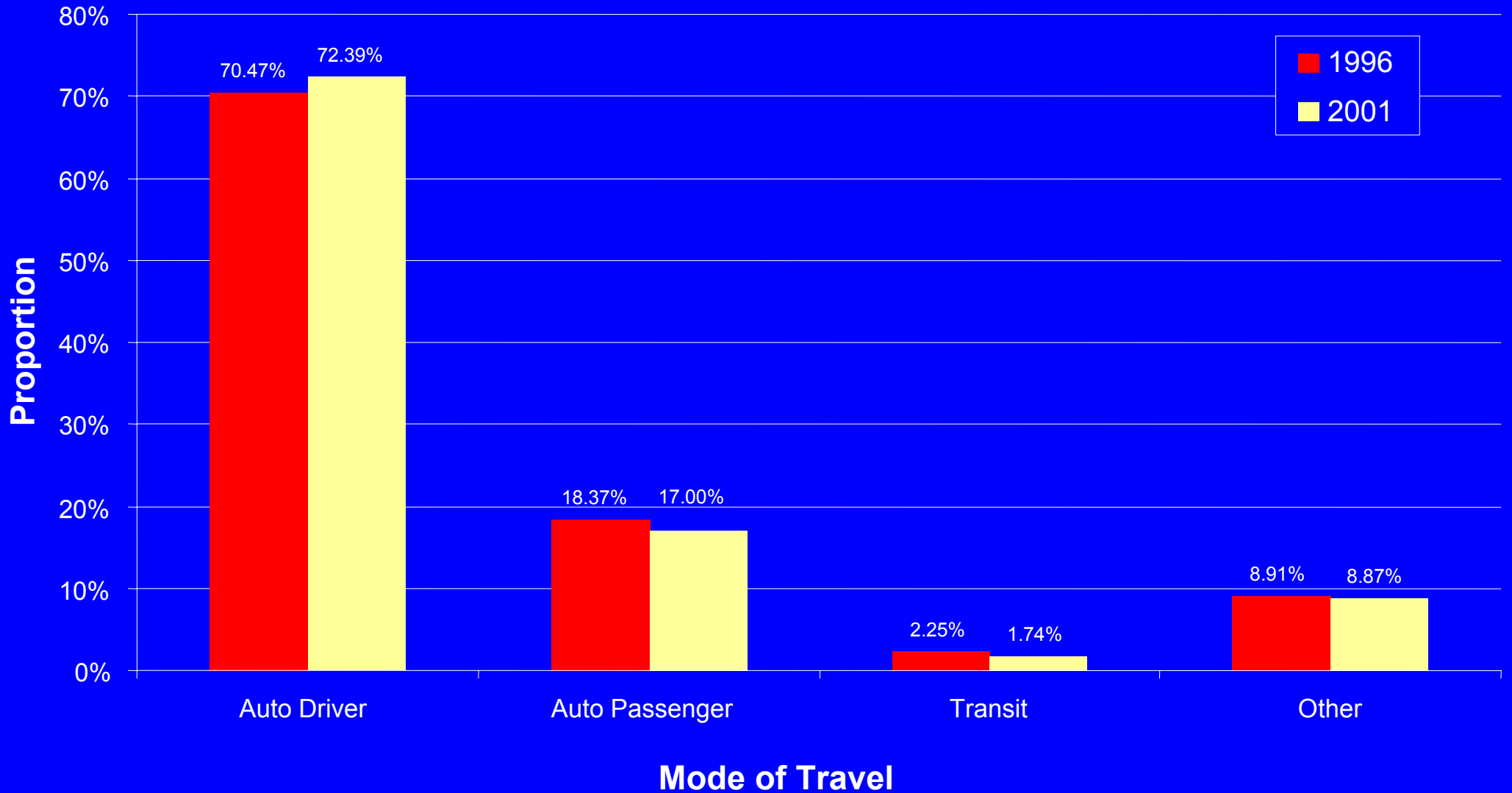

Proportion of Adults (≥ 16 yrs) With a Driver's Licence

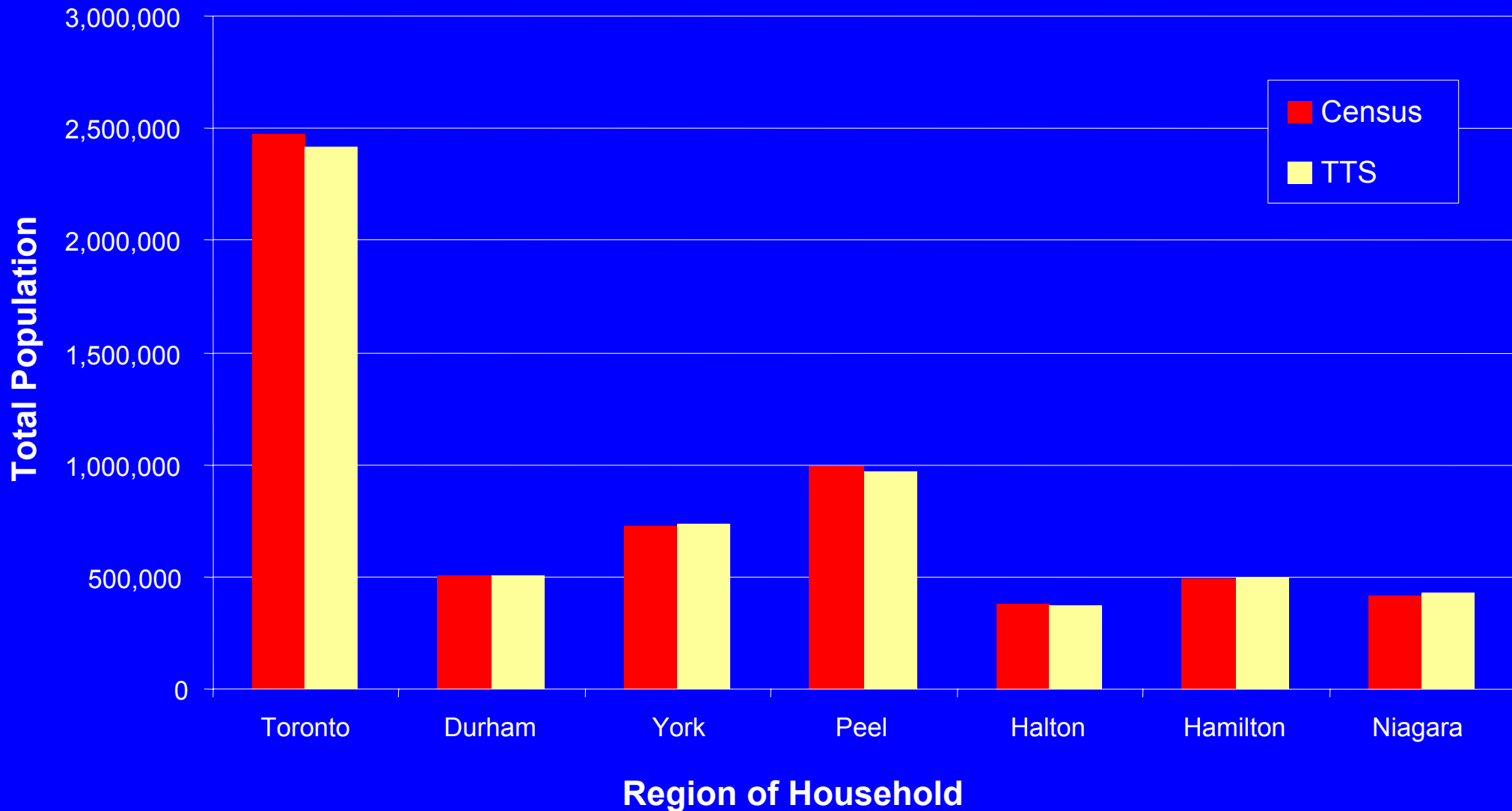

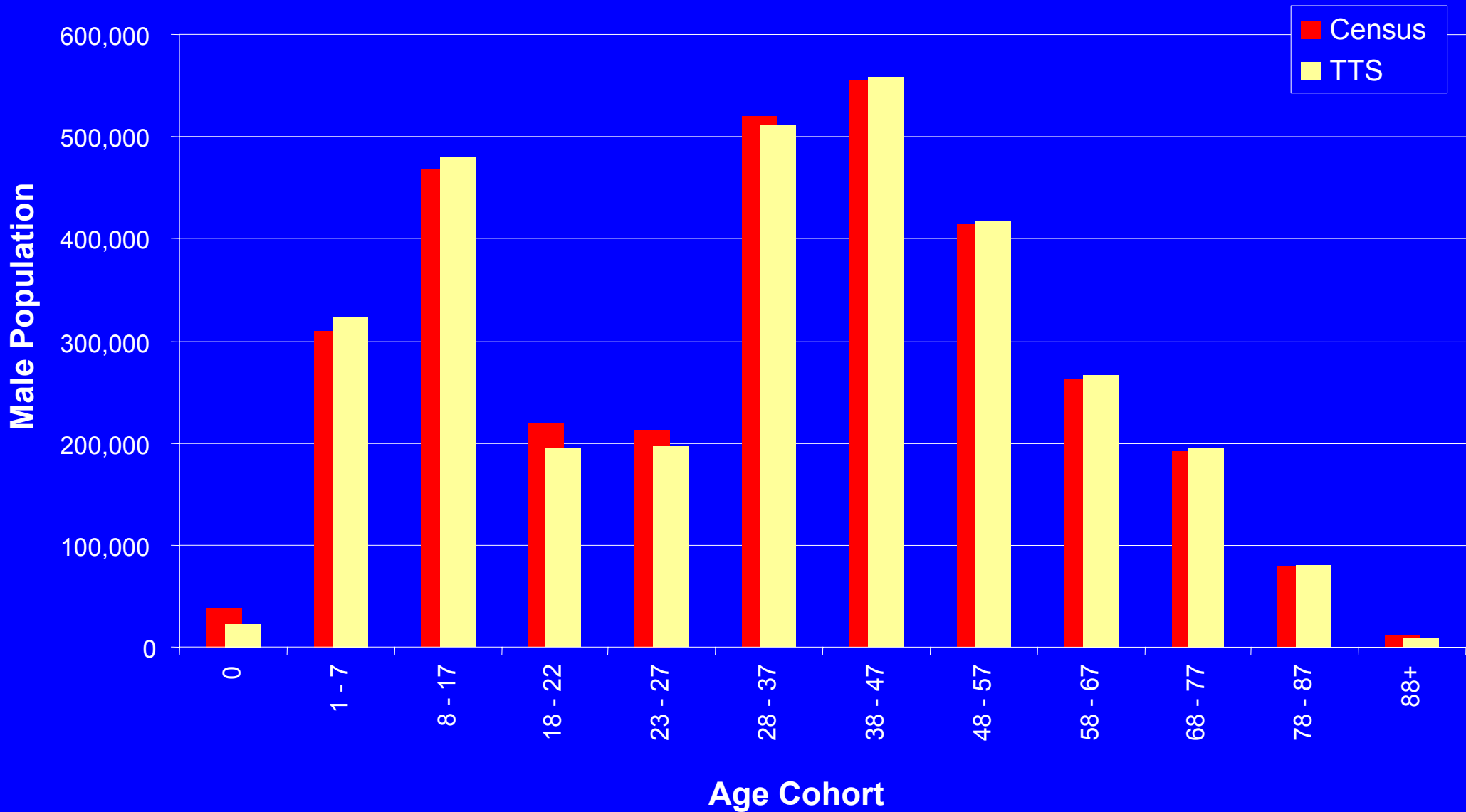
Age Distribution



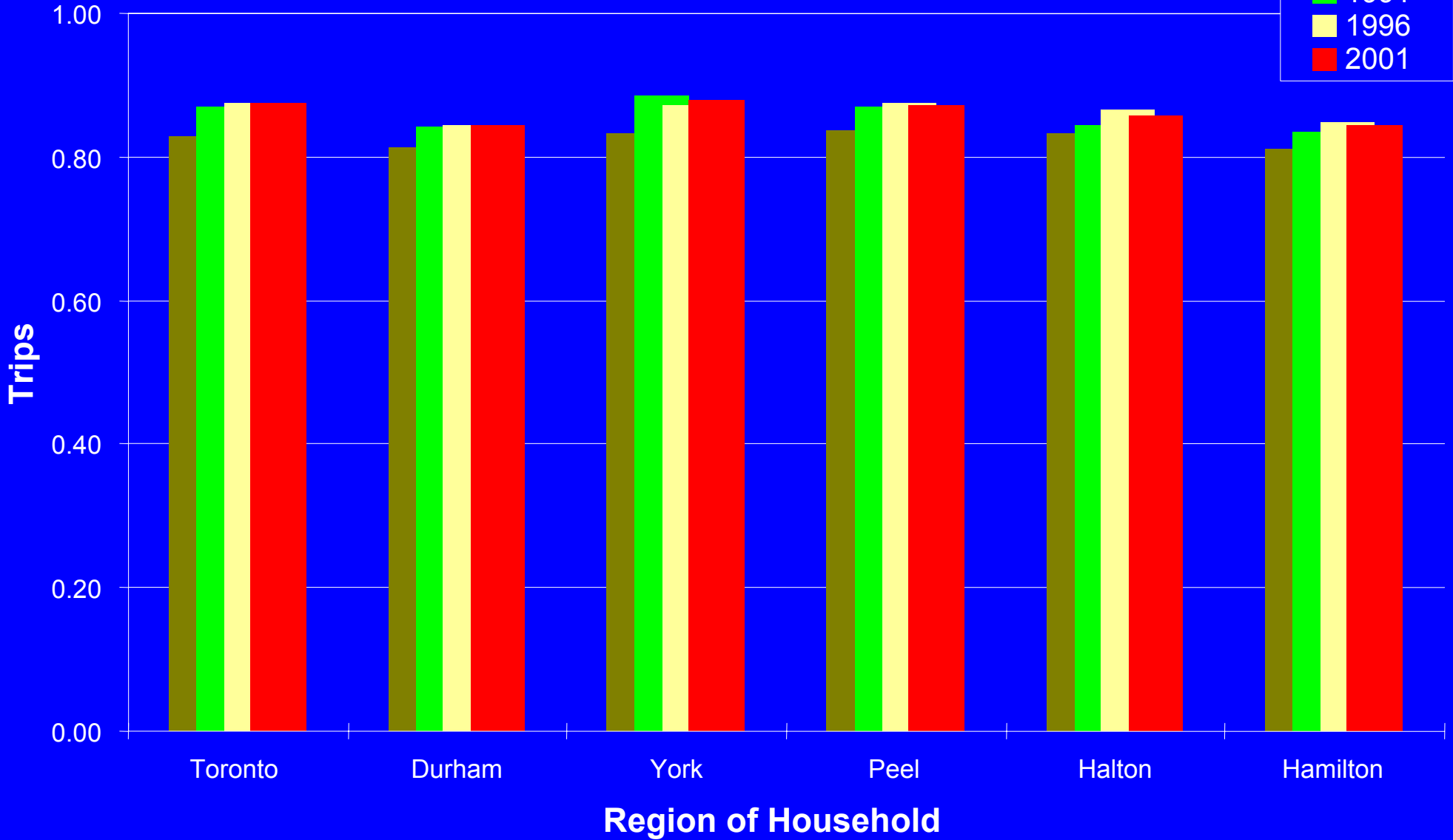

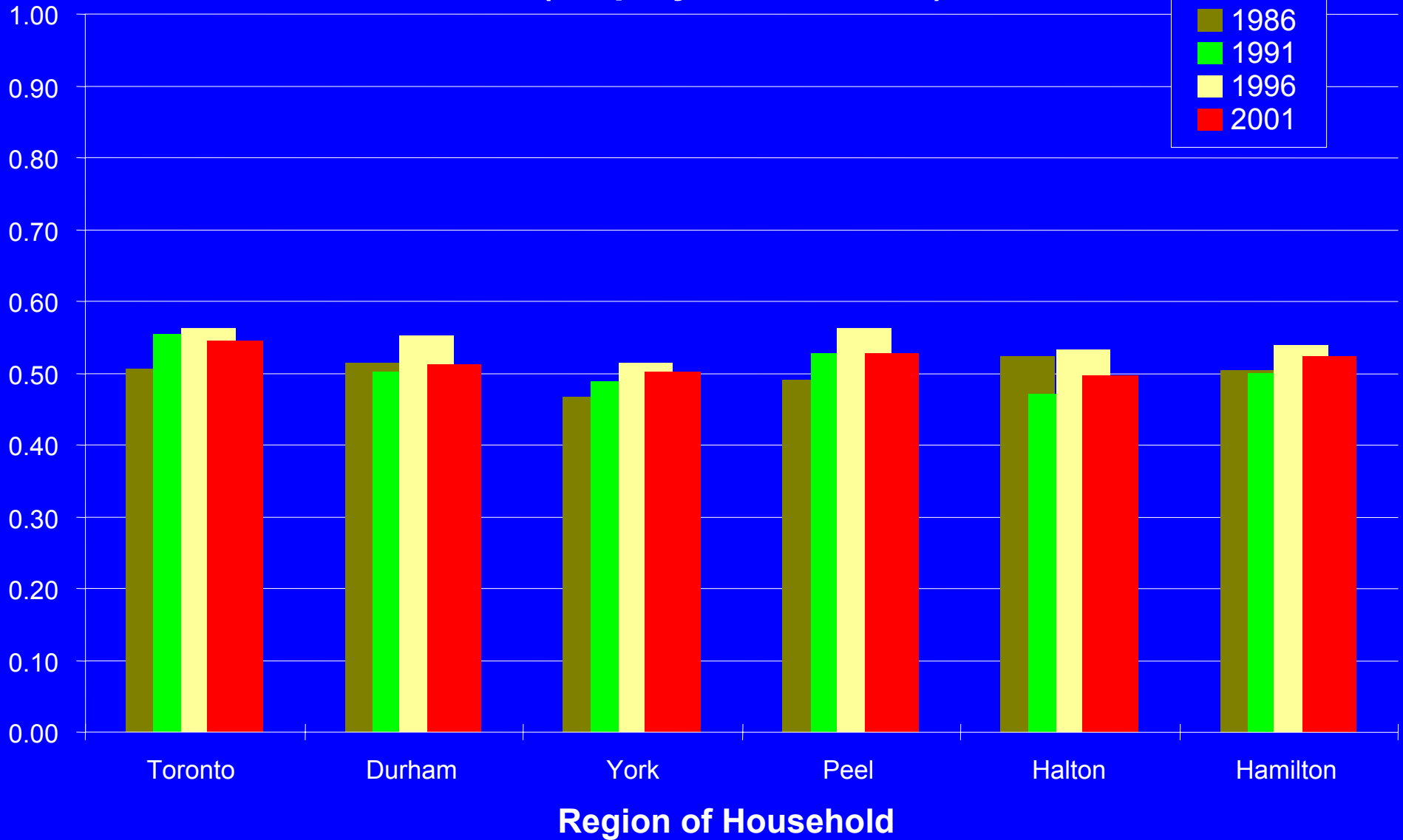
Daily Trips To Work per Person (Employed Full-Time)



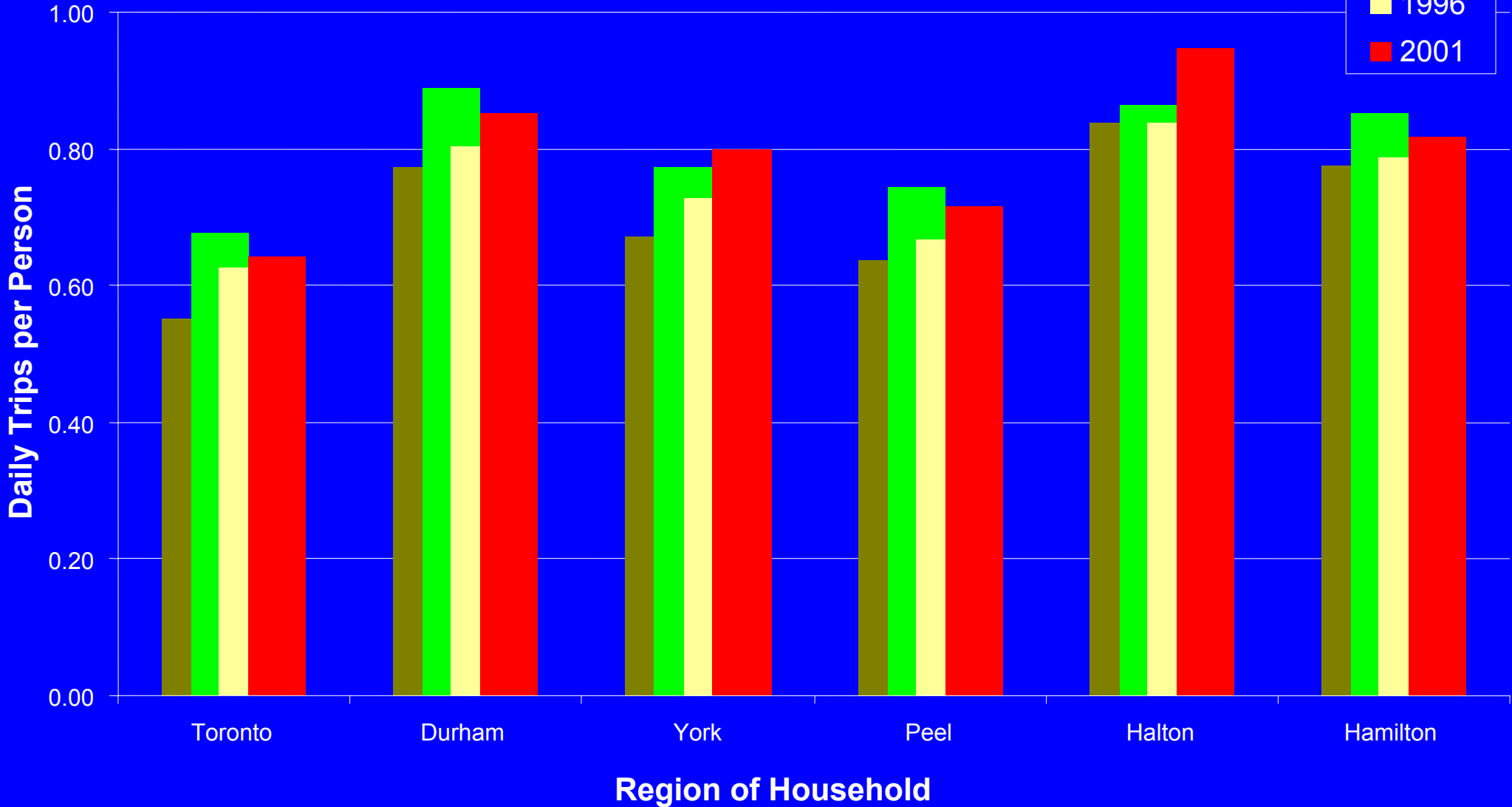
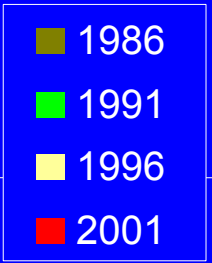

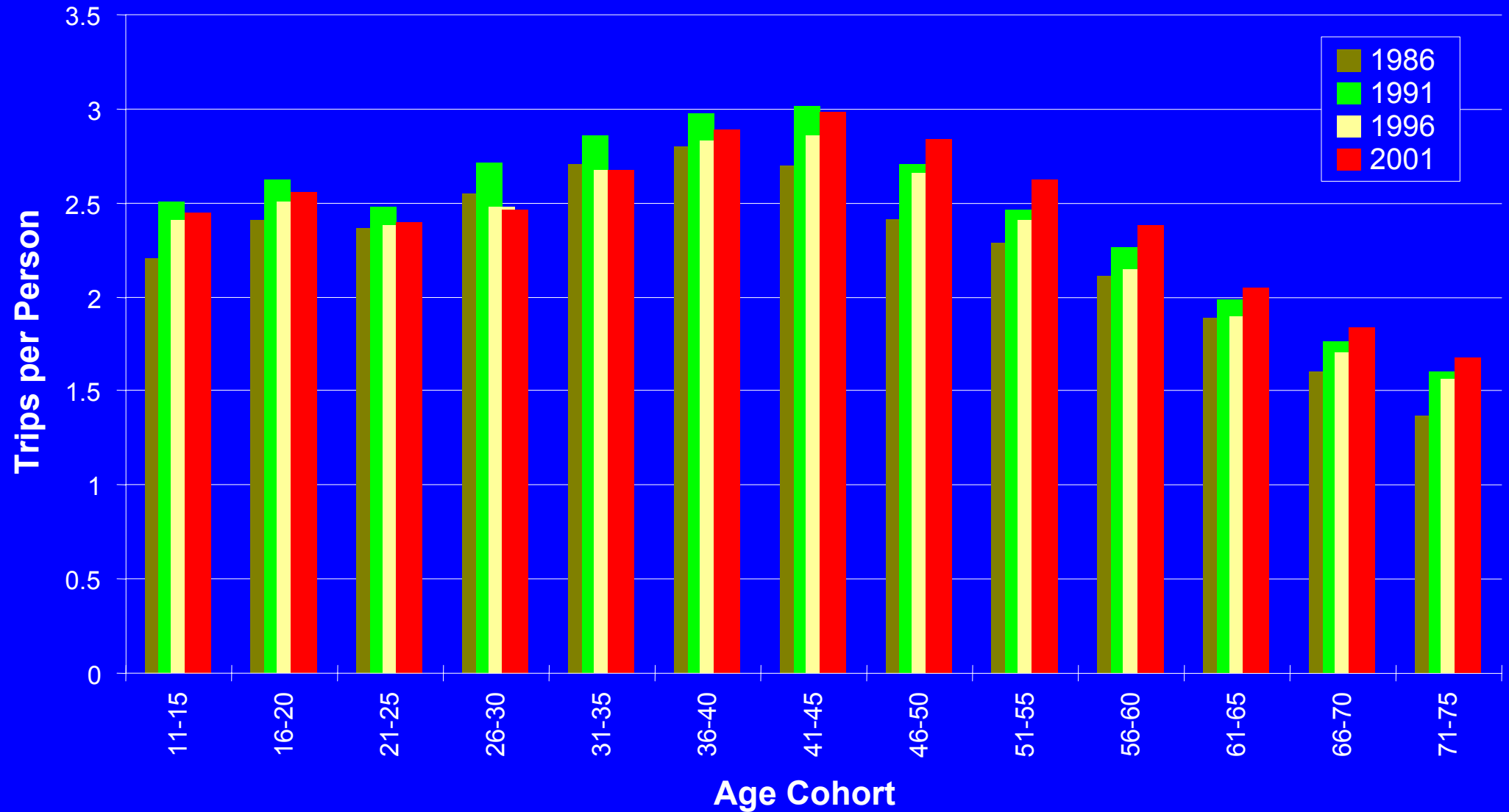

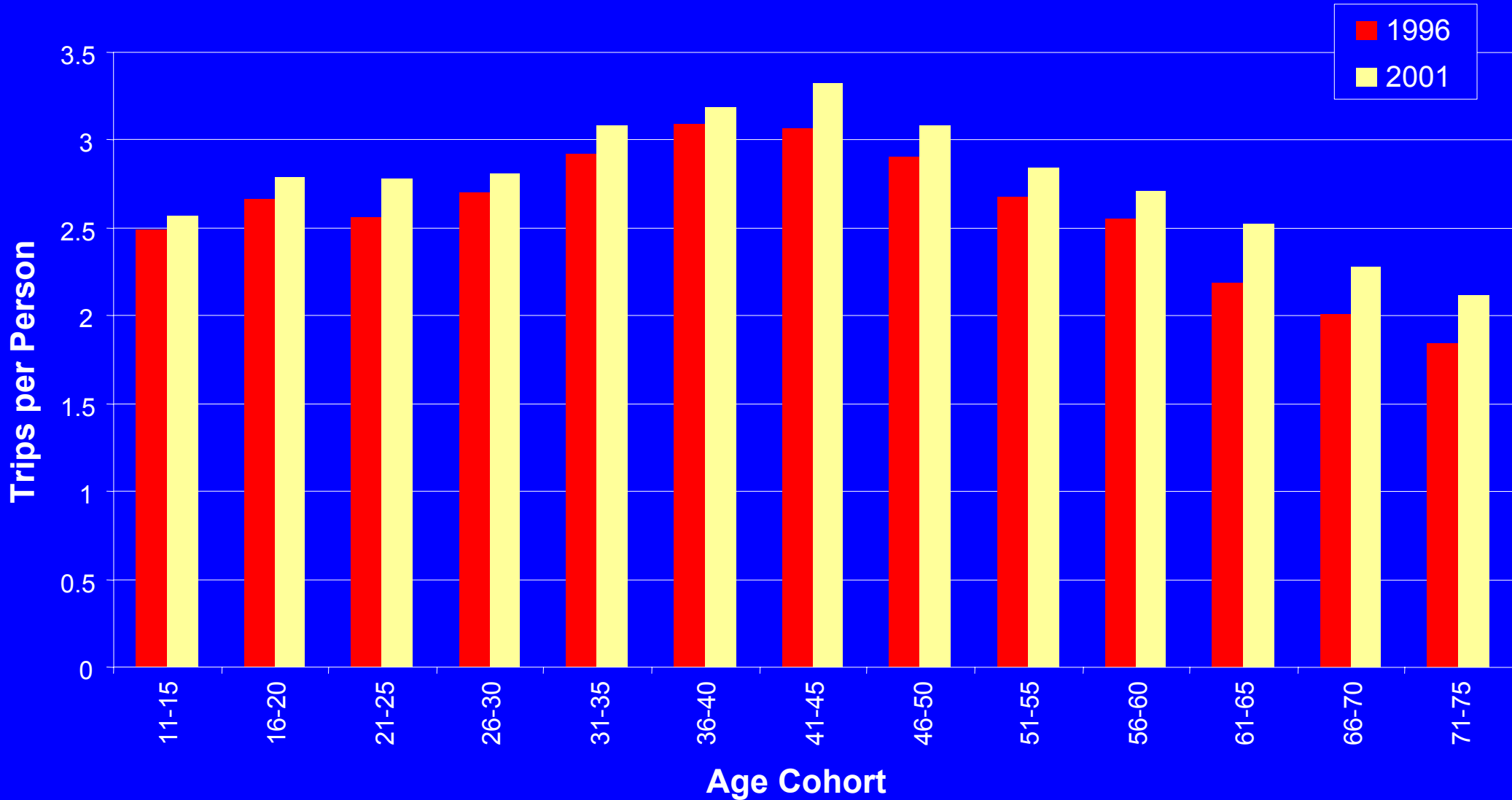

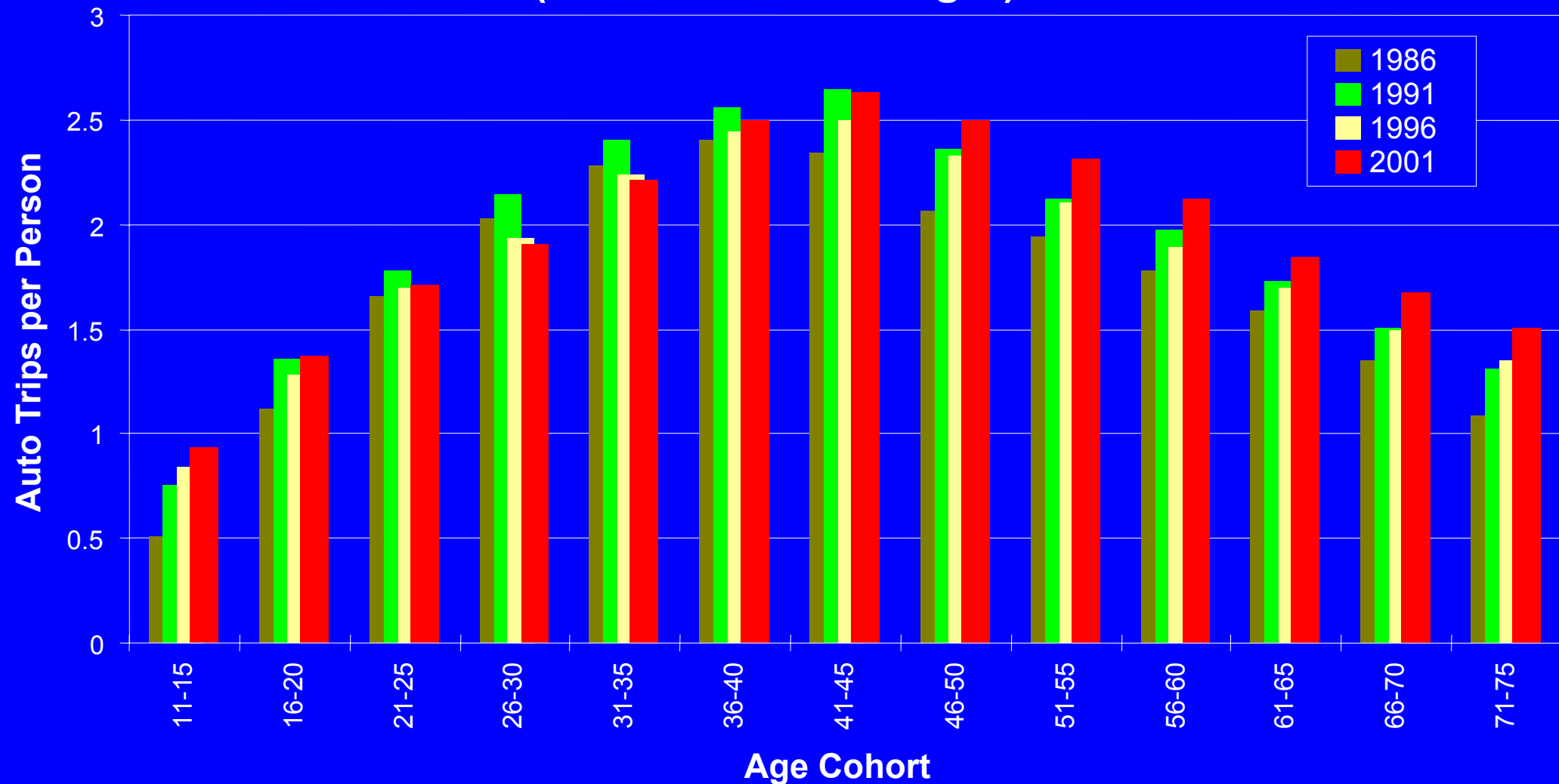
GTA Residents Total Trip Rate



Non-GTA Residents Total Trip Rate

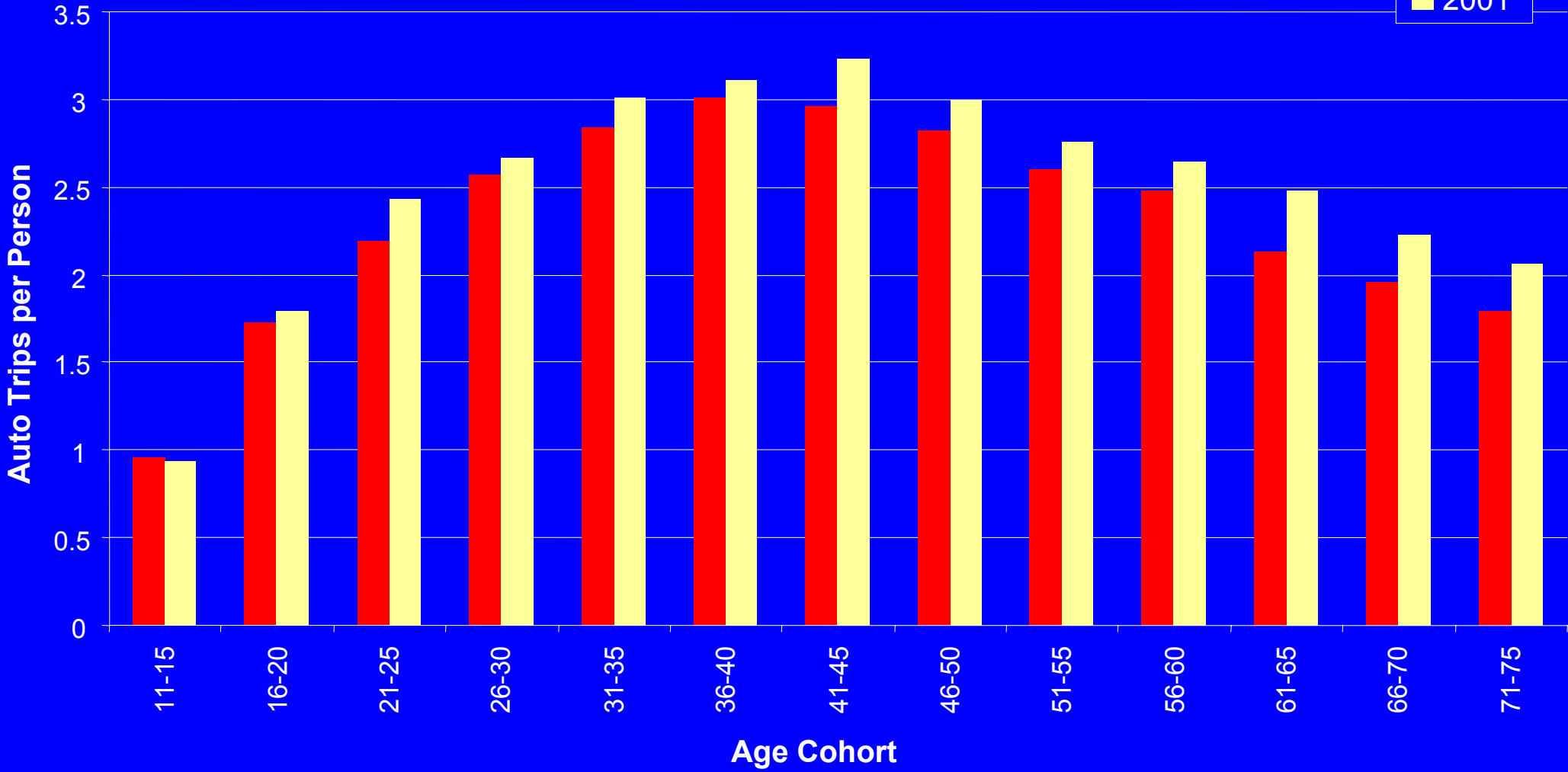


GTA Residents Daily Auto Trip Rate (Driver and Passenger)

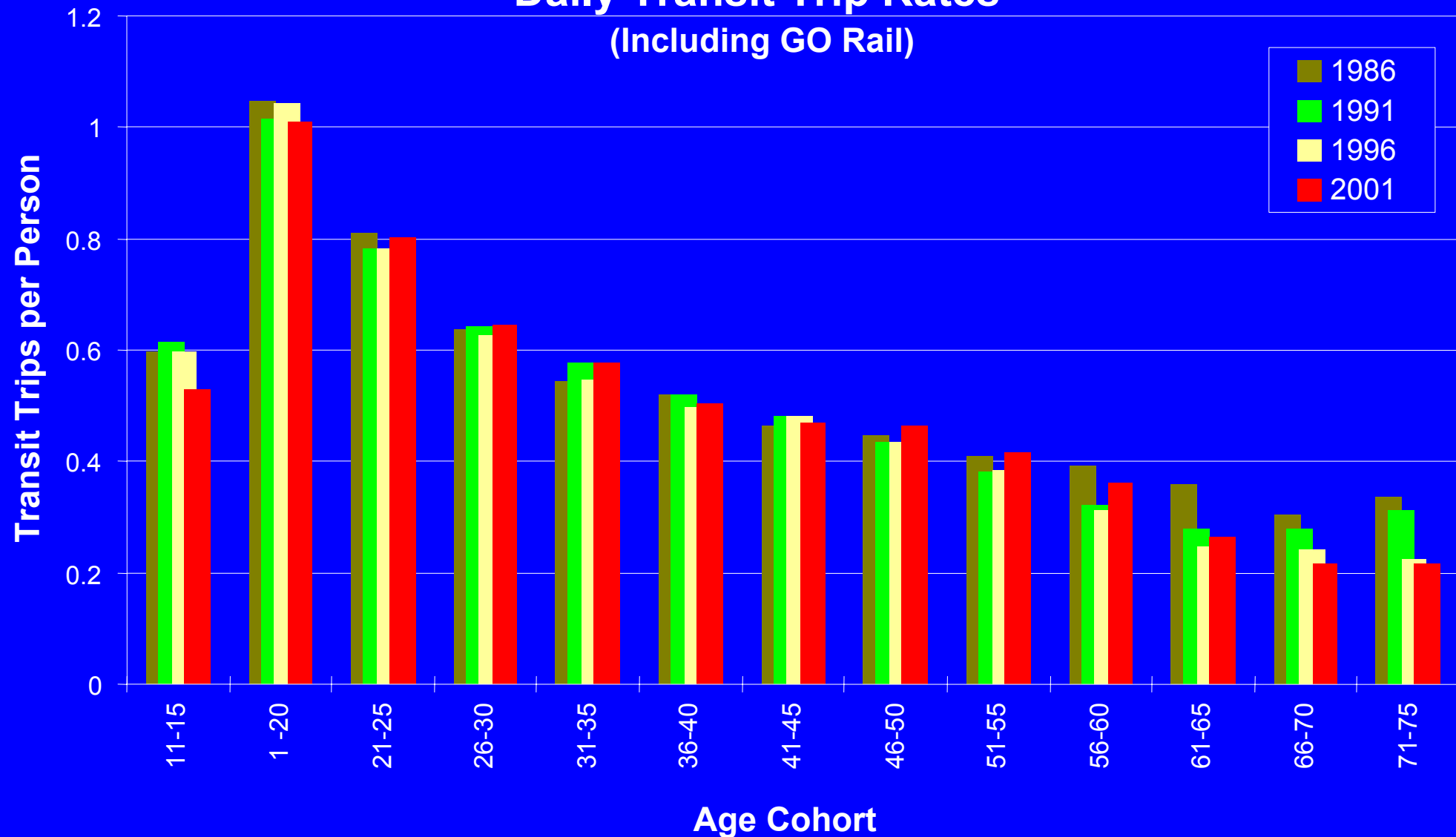


Non-GTA Residents Auto Trip Rate (Driver and Passenger)

Toronto Residents Daily Transit Trip Rates (Including GO Rail)

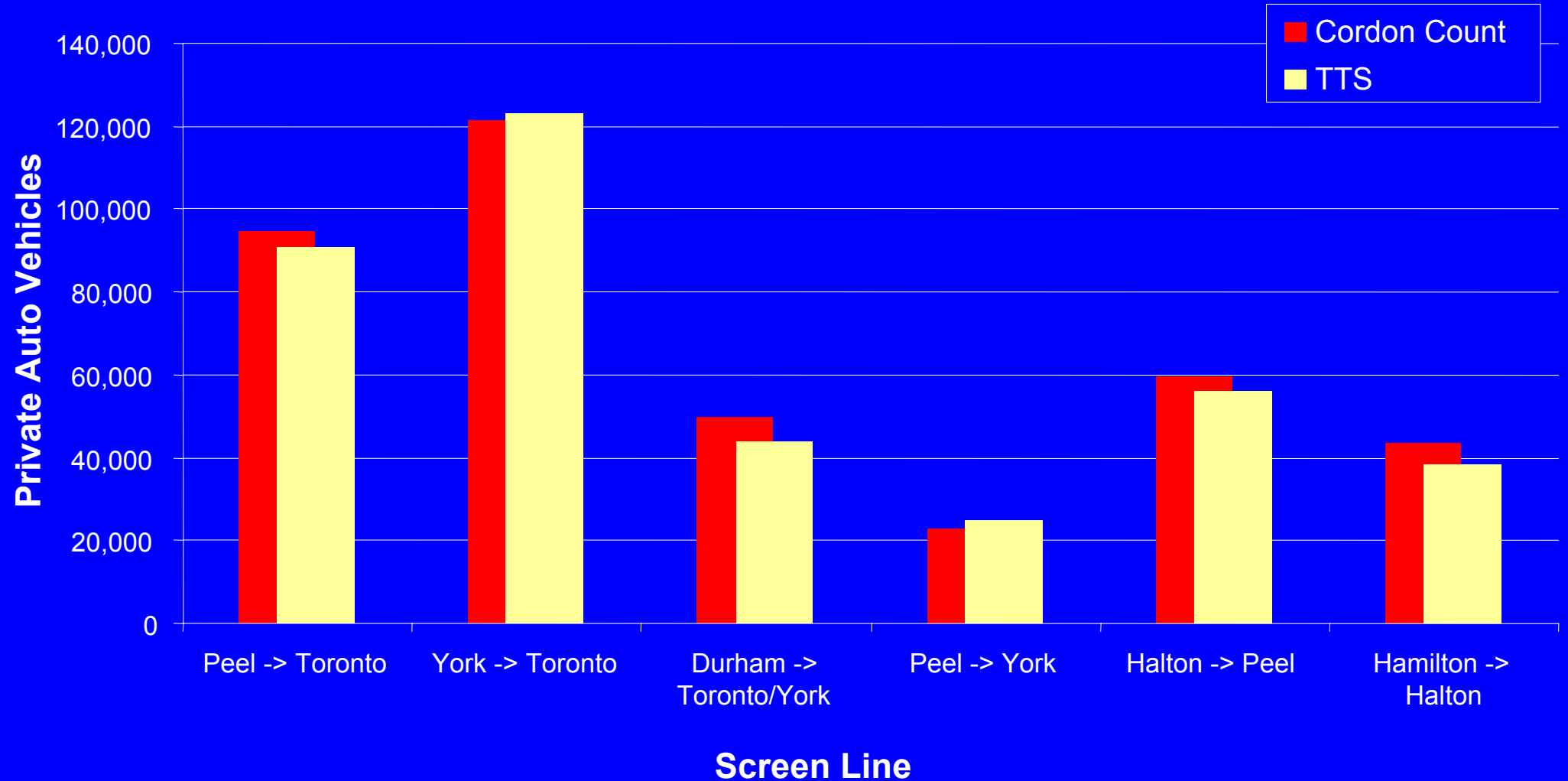

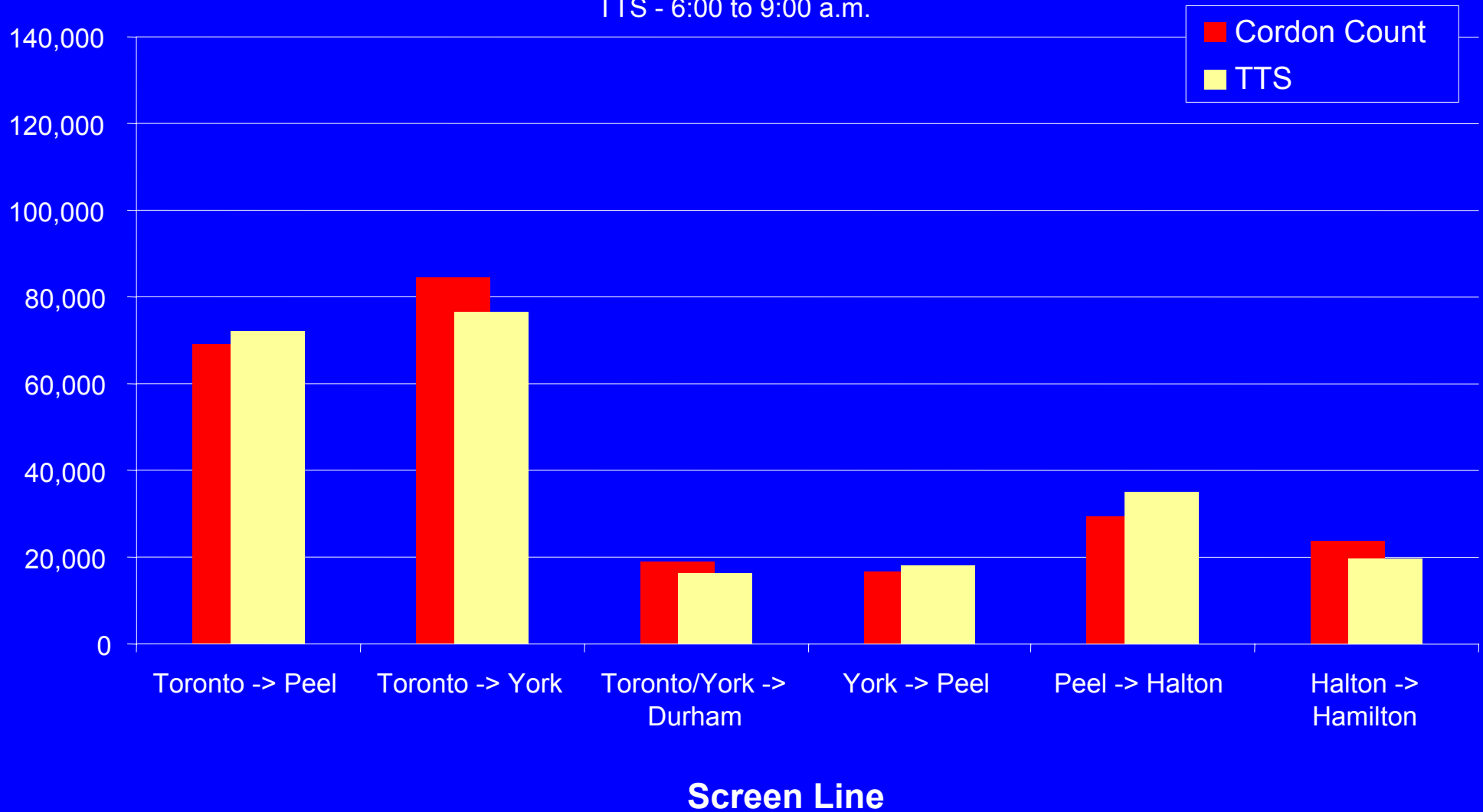


Outbound Away From Toronto

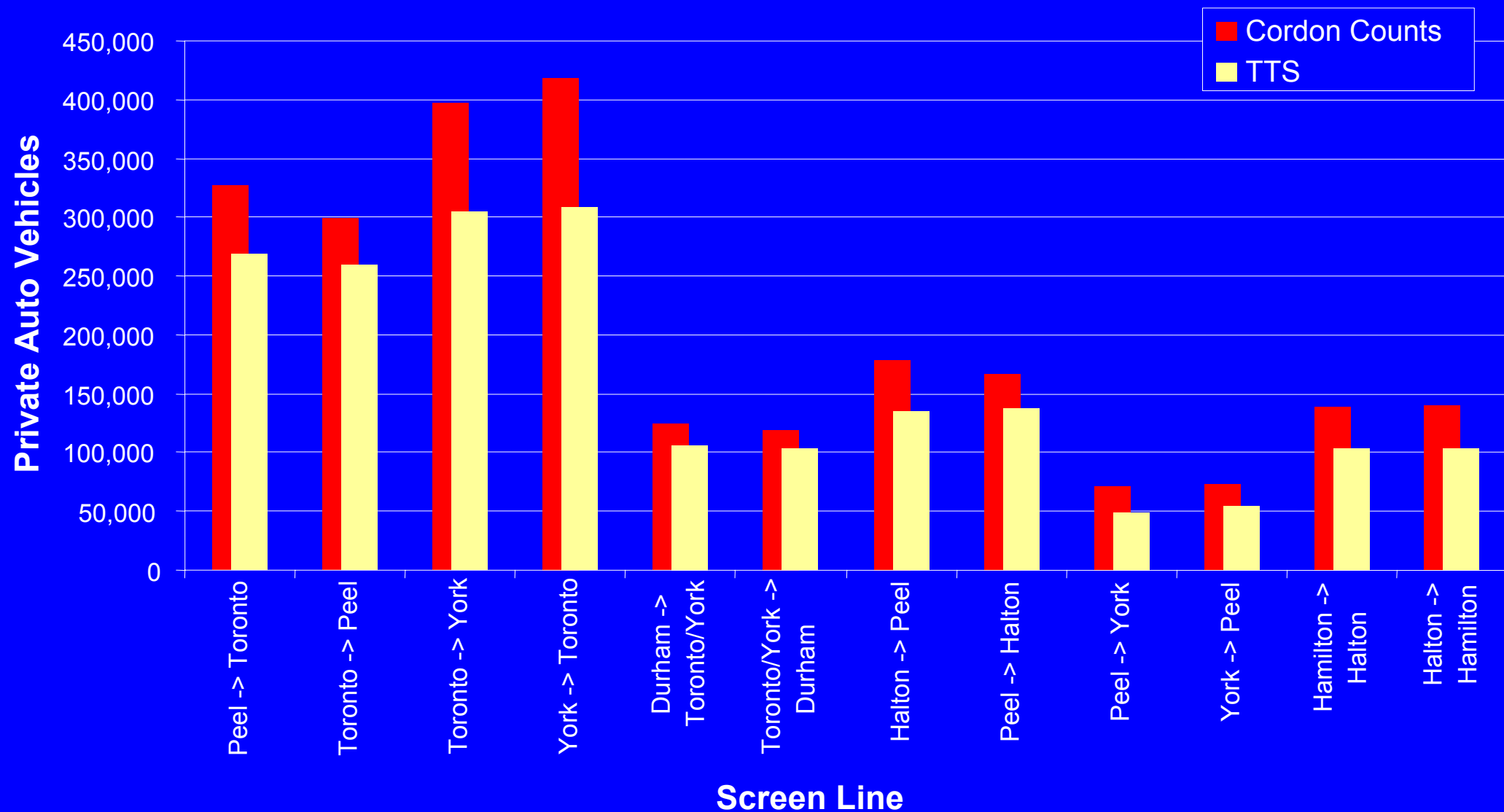

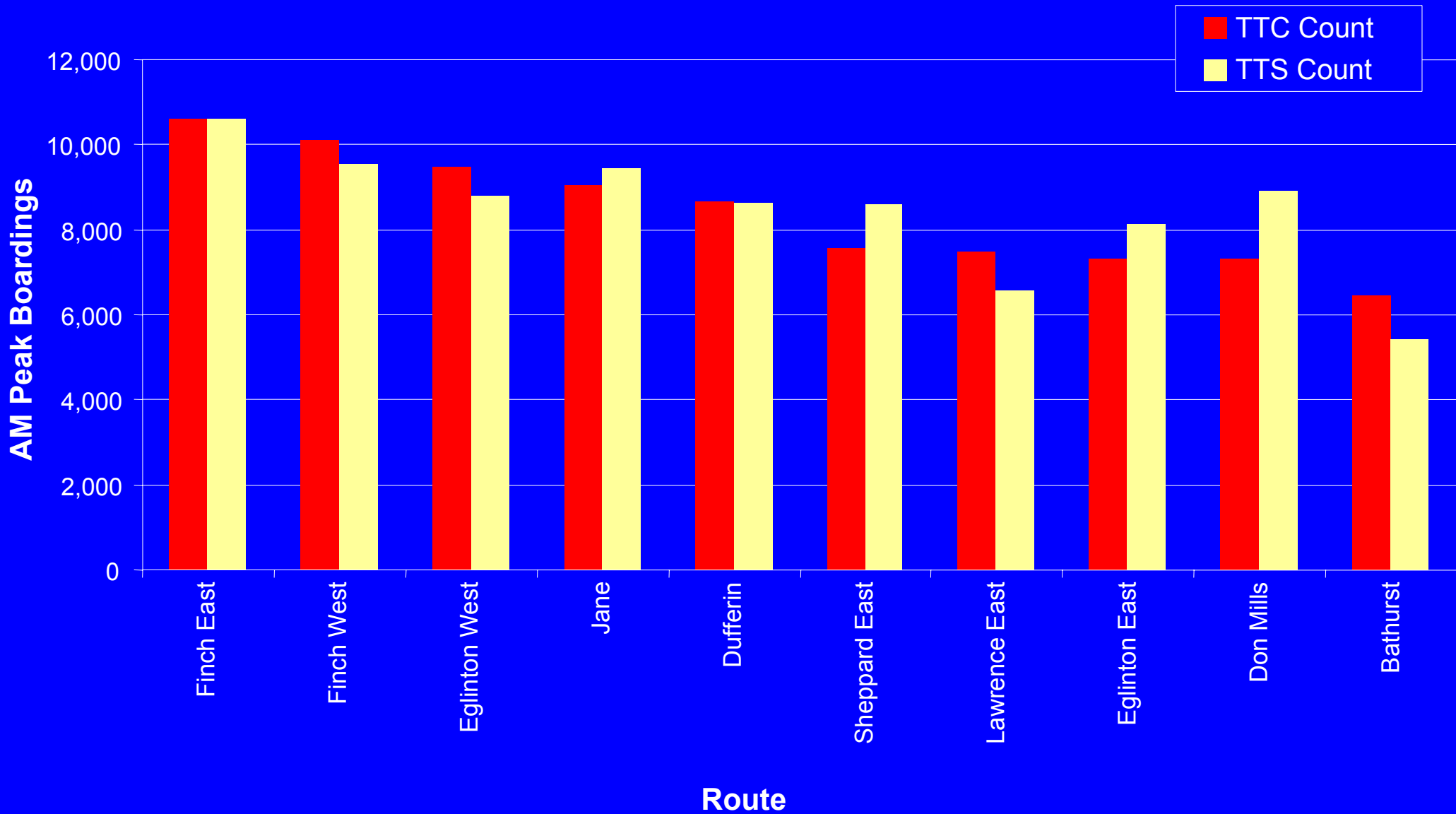


13 Hour Cordon Counts

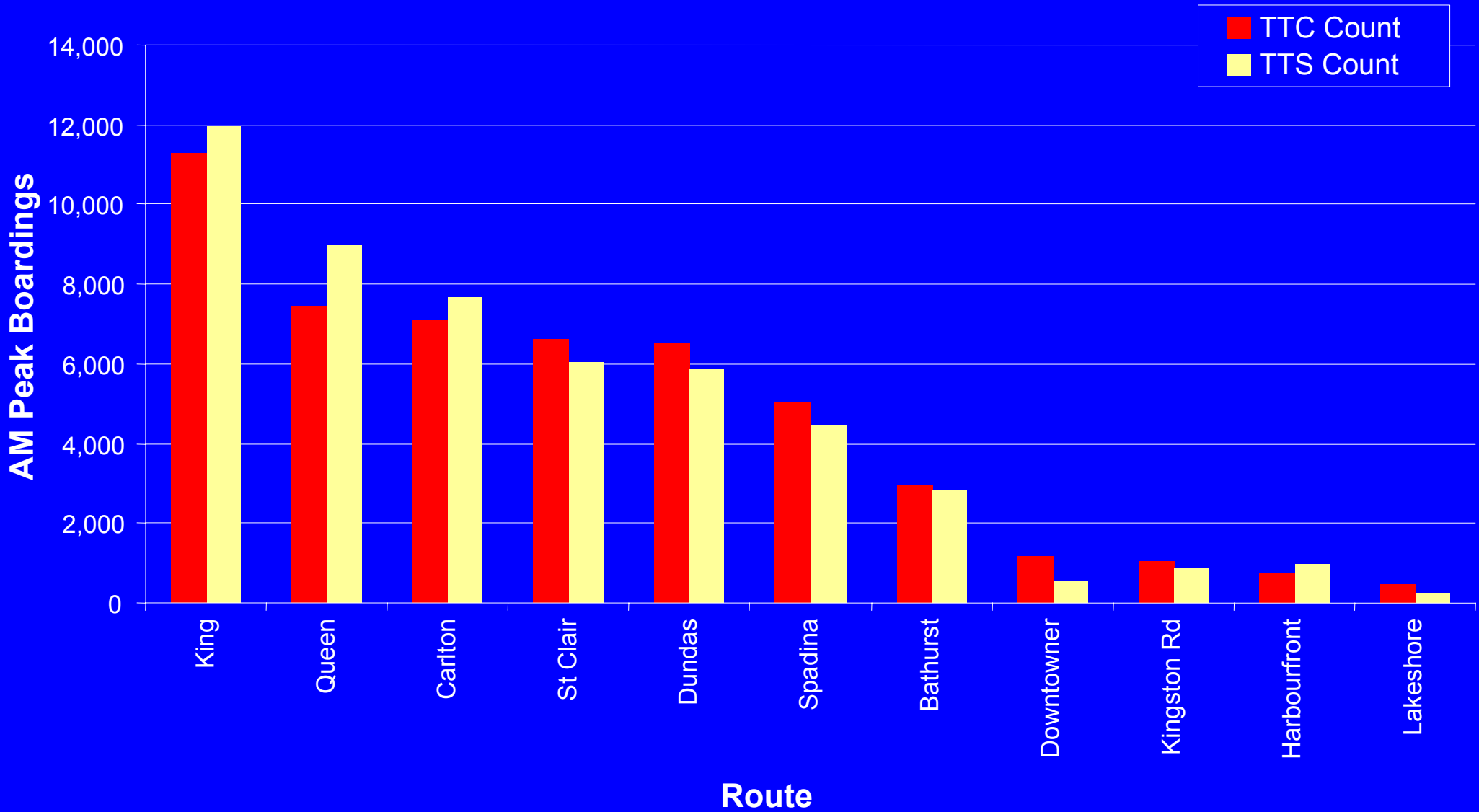

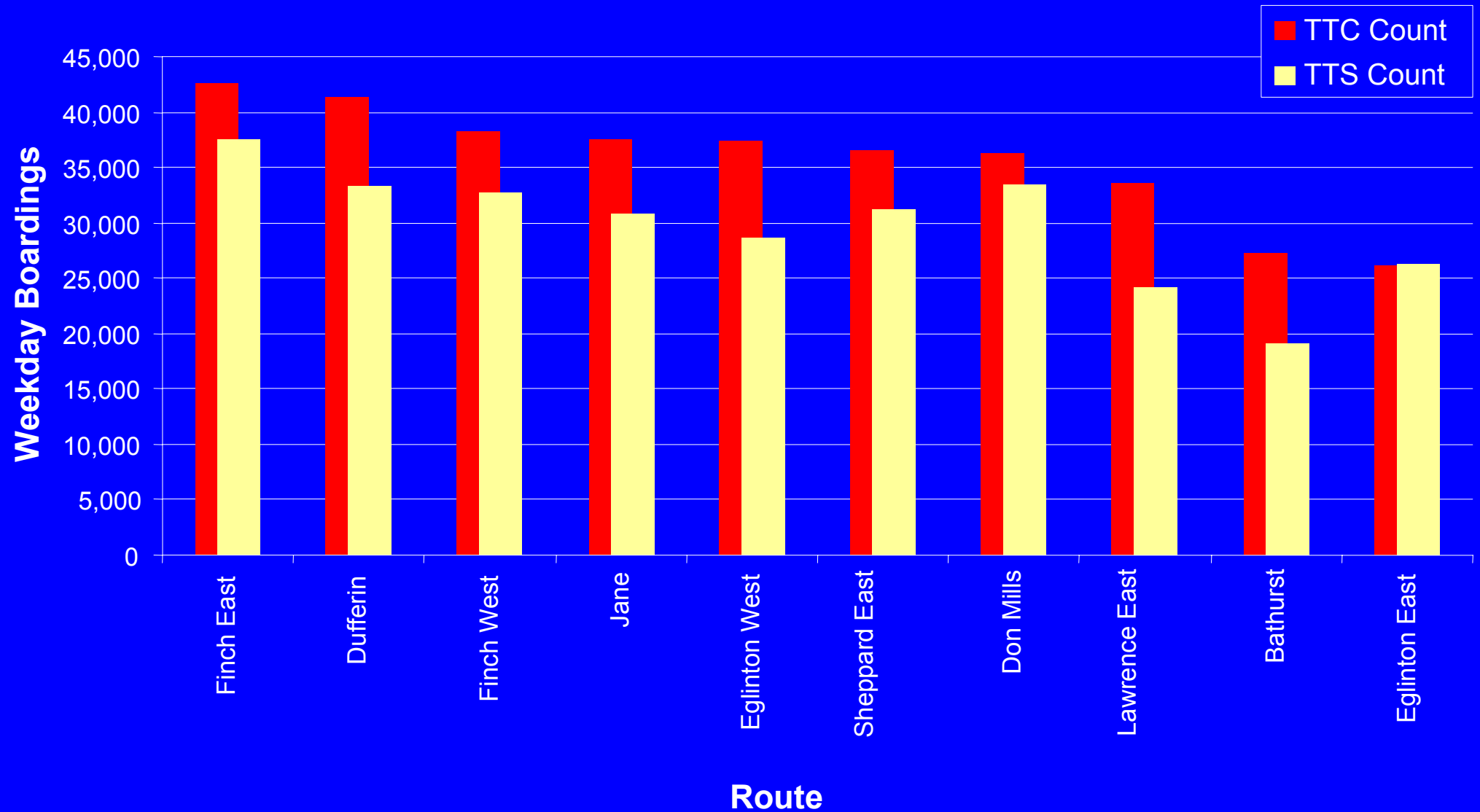
TTC - 10 Busiest Bus Routes



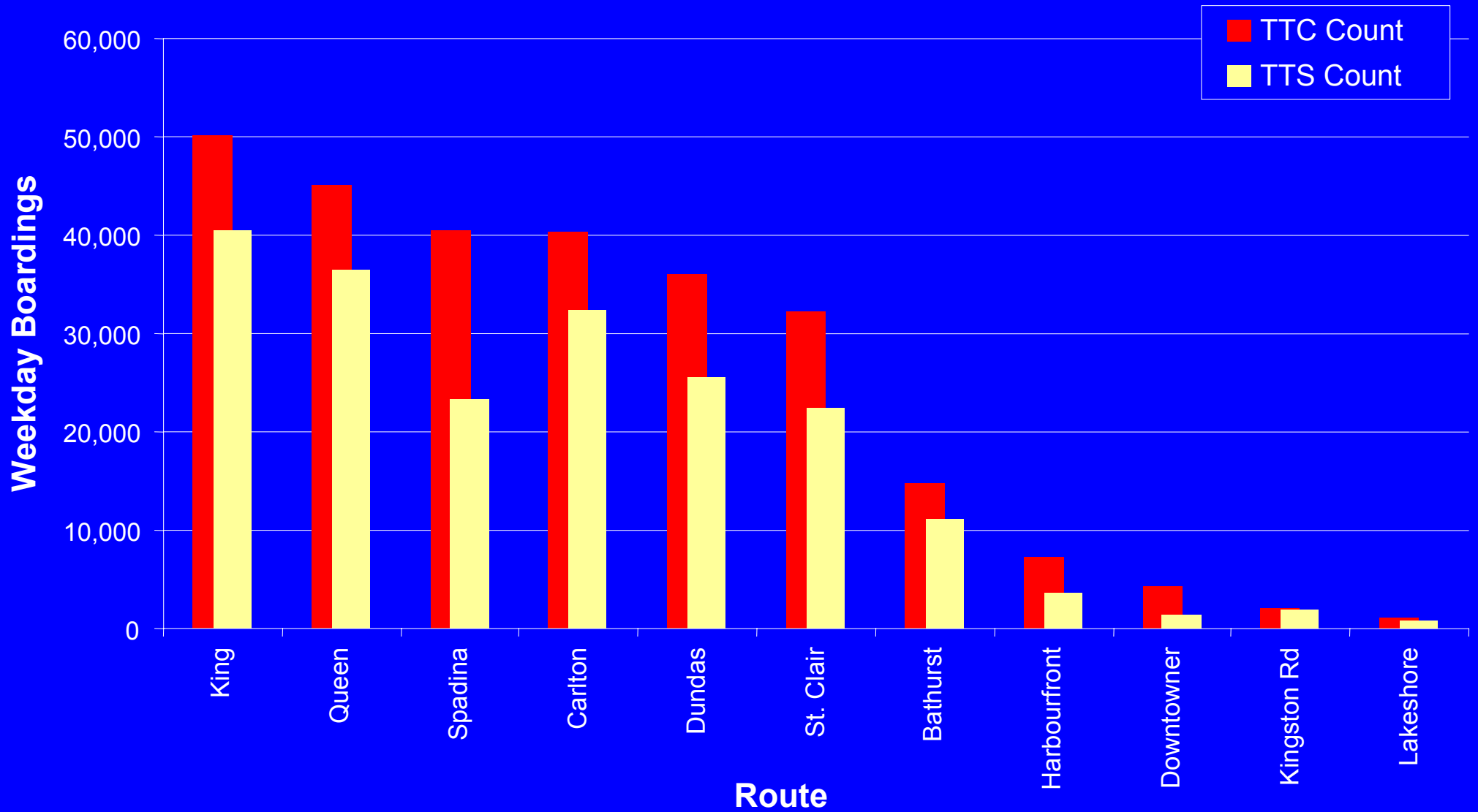

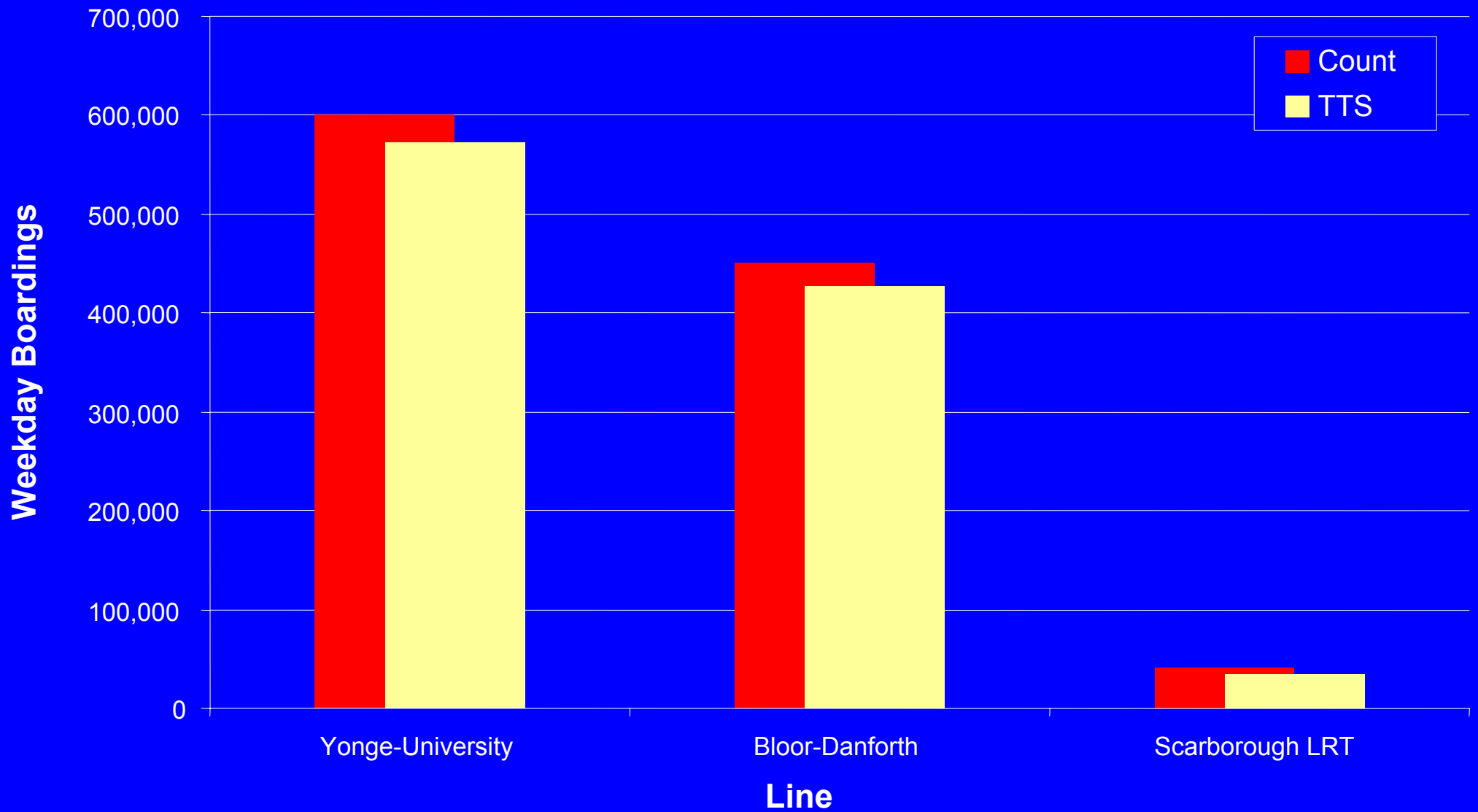

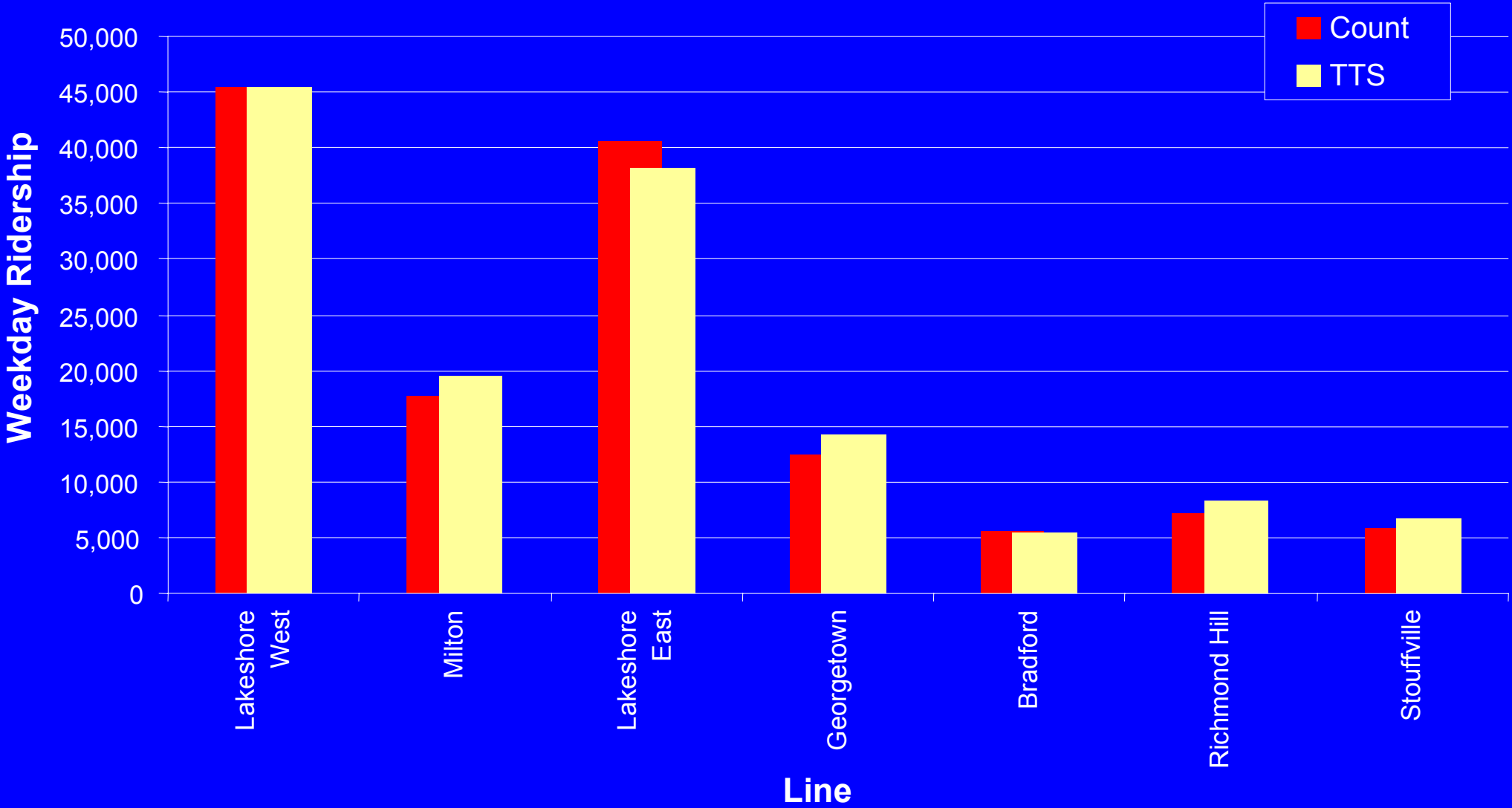

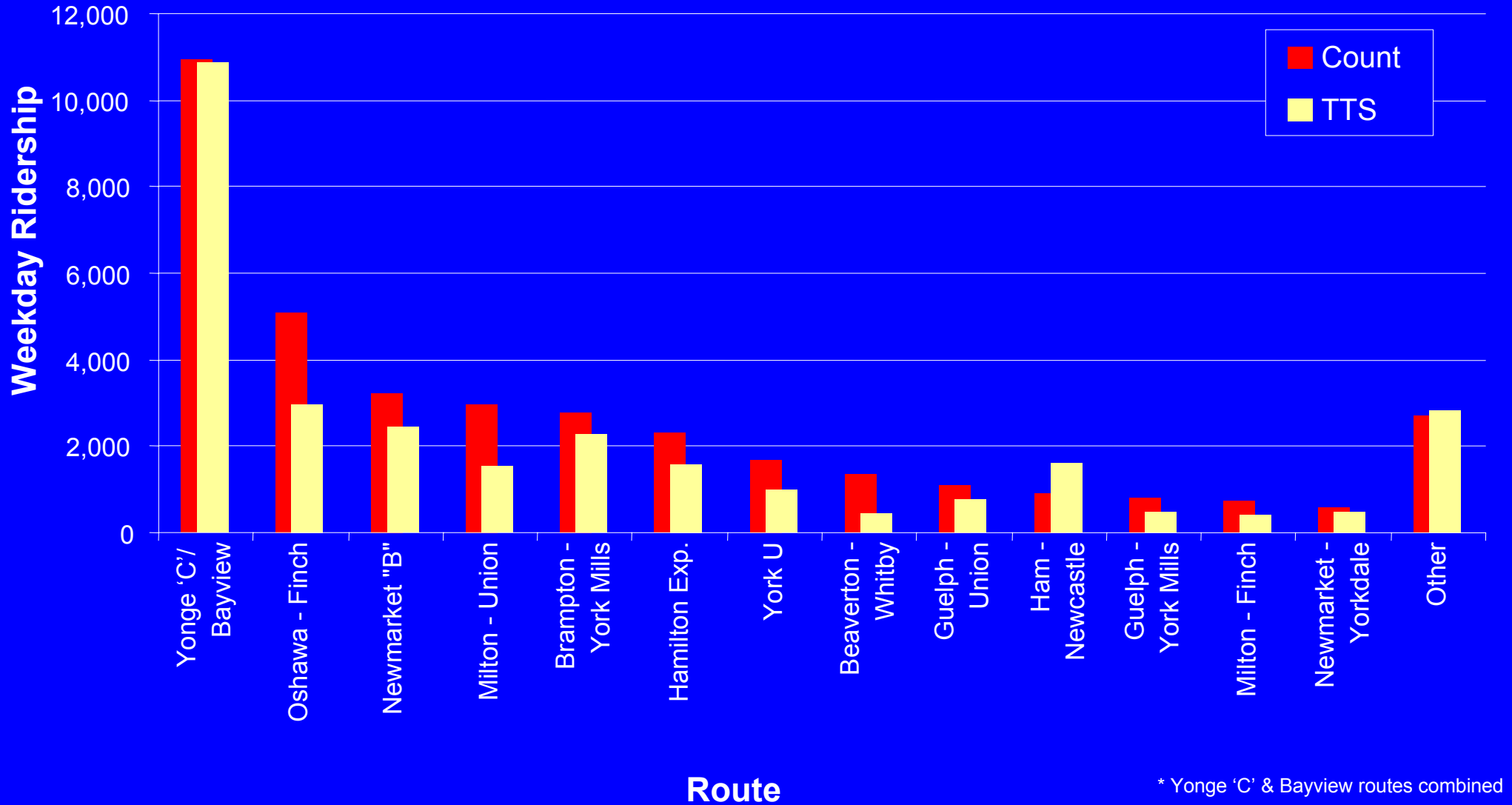
TTC Subway Ridership



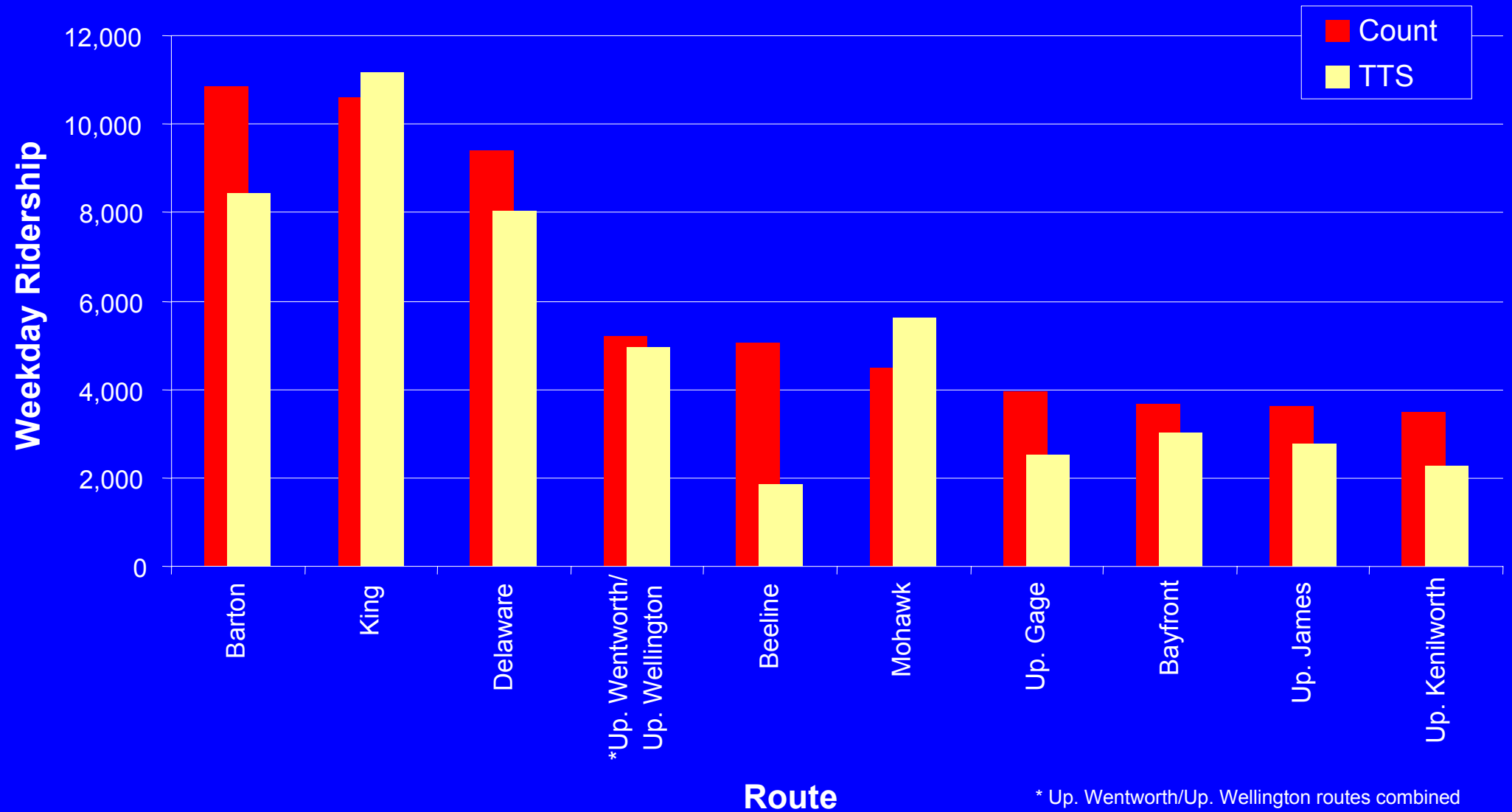

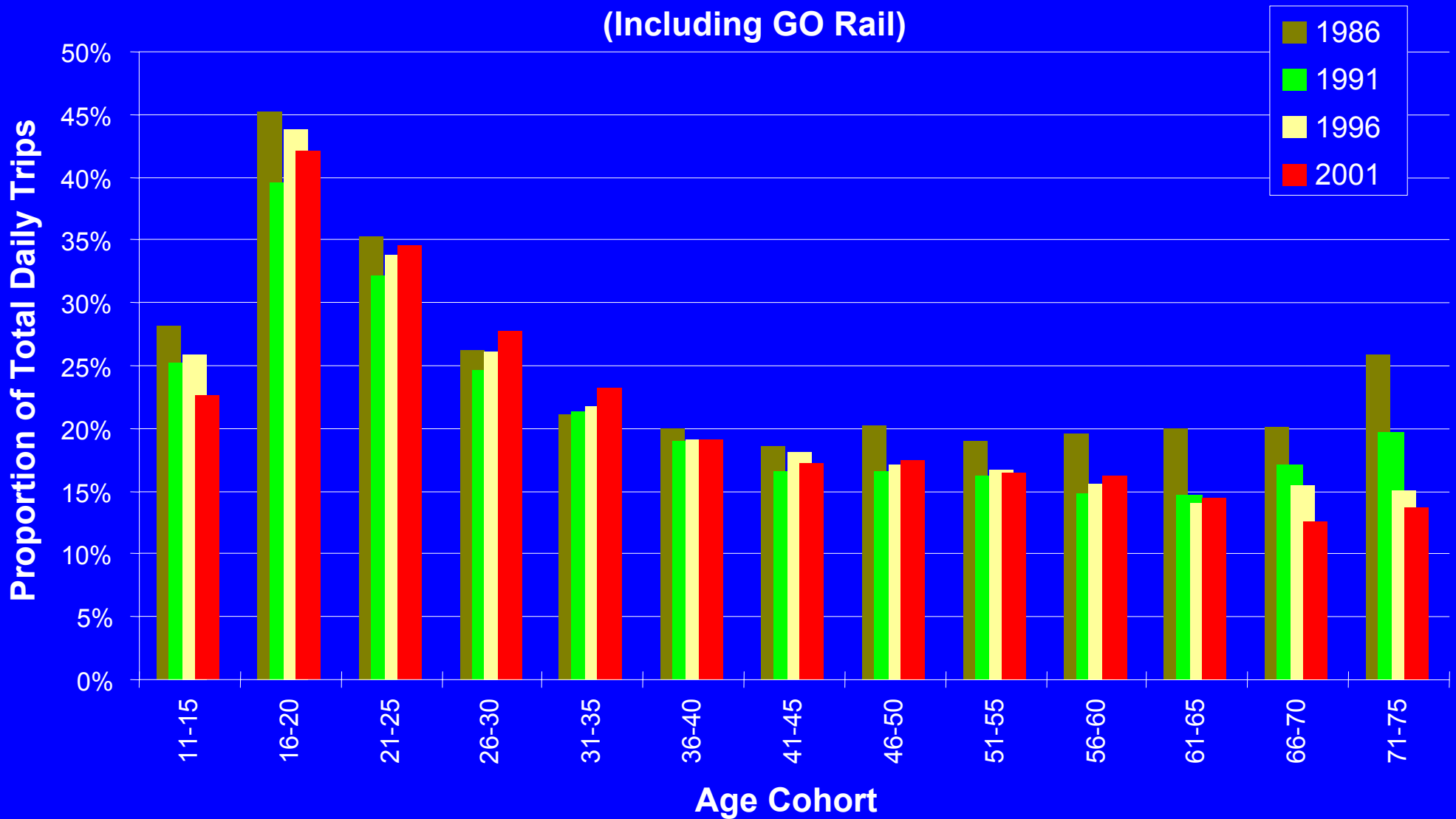
Mississauga Transit - 10 Busiest Routes

- Household, Person, Trip and Transit Supplement

Standard Aggregations

- Traffic Zones, Municipalities and Regions

Data Retrieval System

- Password protected secure internet site
- Web browser access with interactive menu system
- Allows up to three dimensional cross-tabulations on any combination of household, person or trip information
- Format of output in text with comma delimited fields
- Processing time for normal request is a few minutes
